The Trust were highly complimentary about the attitude, behaviour and engagement of the students. Well done year nine and thank you to **Mrs Kelsey** and all the staff involved.



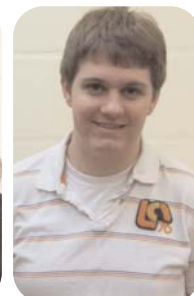

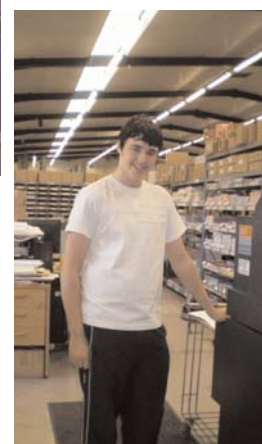

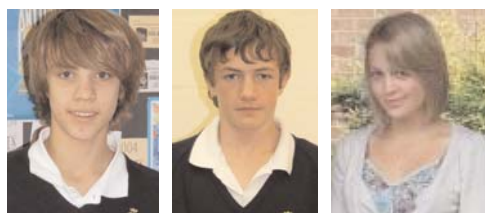
