



THE VYVYAN or VIVIAN Family (BARONS SWANSEA) of Cornwall and Singleton Abbey, Swansea I

(SIR) RICHARD HUSSEY VIVIAN, born Truro 28 Jul 1775; married (1) 14 Sept 1804 Truro to Eliza, daughter of Phillip Champion de Crespigny of Hintlesham Hall (she was born 1784; died Clifton 13 Jul 1831); Lt Col in 12th Dragoons & Commander of the Forces in Ireland; PC in Ireland; MP for Truro; KCB; KCH; KMT; KSW; DCL; created a Baronet 19 Jan 1828 and subsequently 1st Baron Vivian; (see Pedigree for the BARONS VIVIAN for descent of title); had issue:
