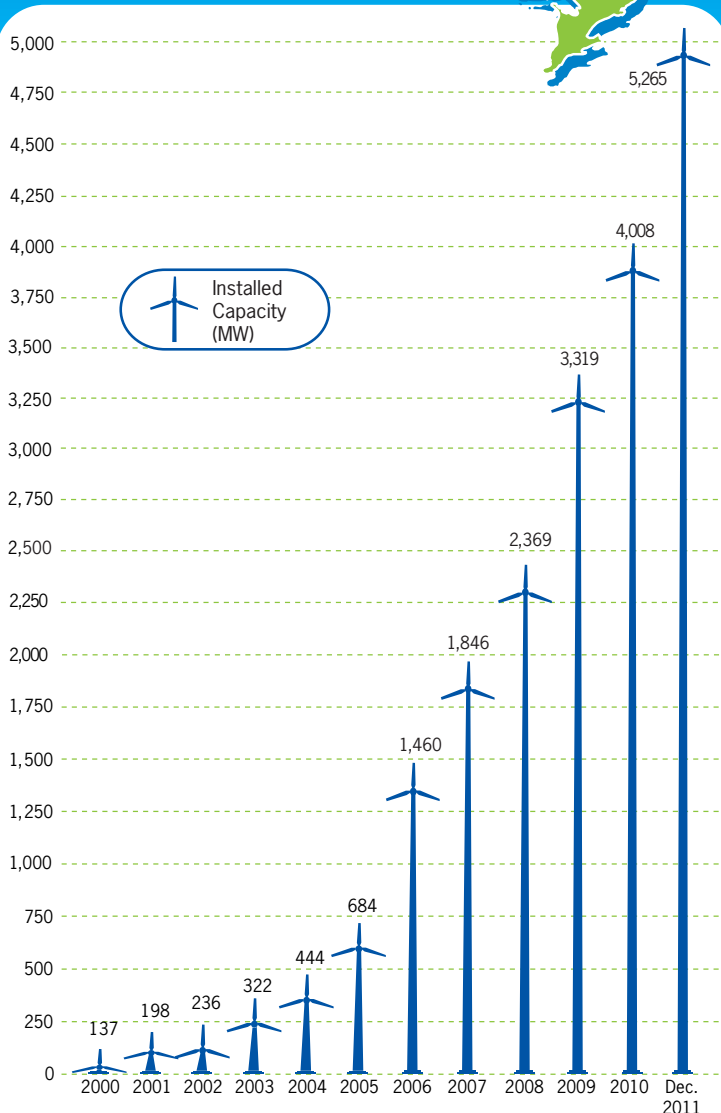
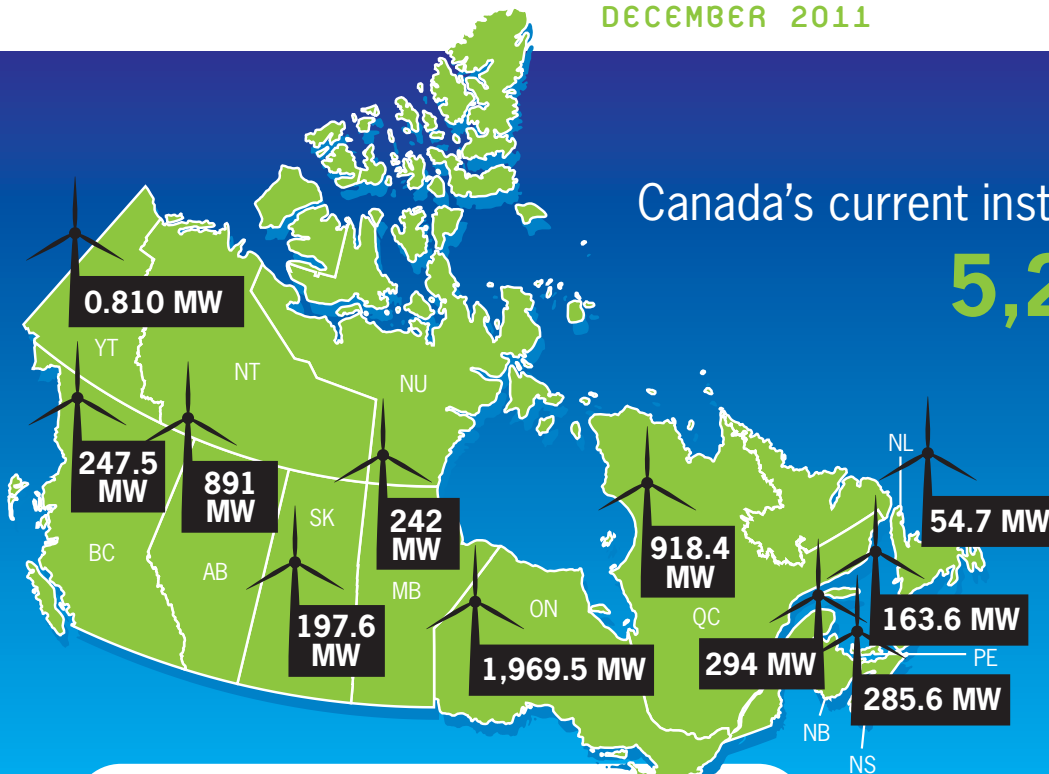

Canada's current installed capacity:

5,265 MW



Across Canada, electricity generated from wind is already powering over 1.5 million homes and businesses in a clean, reliable and efficient manner. With Canada's unparalleled wind resource, there are still opportunities to do more to maximize the economic, industrial development, and environmental benefits associated with wind energy for Canada.

- 1,267MW of new installed capacity in 2011 – representing almost \$3.1 billion in investment and 13,000 person-years of employment
- New wind farms in British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba, Ontario, Quebec, New Brunswick and Nova Scotia
- 2012 is projected to be a record year for wind in Canada with more than 1,500MW likely to be installed
