WEEKLY HONORS

BIG EAST Player of the Week

KEVIN JONES, West Virginia, F, Sr.

Jones led the Mountaineers to a 2-0 week by averaging 20.0 points and 13.5 rebounds. His week started with 22 points and 16 boards in a 92-75 win against DePaul. Jones followed that effort with 18 points and 11 rebounds in a 50-44 road victory at USF. He has 20 double-doubles this season. Jones completed conference regular-season play first in the BIG EAST in scoring with a 19.0 average and first in rebounding with a 10.9 mark.



BIG EAST Rookie of the Week

LADONTAE HENTON, Providence, F, Fr.

Henton registered a pair of 18-point efforts in a 1-1 week for the Friars. He had 18 points and seven rebounds in a 72-70 victory against Connecticut. He was 5-of-10 from 3-point range against the Huskies. In a 75-69 loss at Notre Dame, he posted 18 points and 12 rebounds. For the season, Henton is averaging 14.3 points and 8.6 boards.



BIG EAST Honor Roll

JaQuon Parker, Cincinnati, G, Jr.

Scored a career-high 28 points in a 72-61 win over Marquette and registered 11 points in a 72-68 victory at Villanova.

Cleveland Melvin, DePaul, F, So.

Averaged 17.5 points and 8.5 rebounds, shooting 55.6 percent from the field in a 1-1 week. Had 21 points and eight rebounds against West Virginia and 14 points and nine boards against Seton Hall.

Jae Crowder, Marquette, F, Sr.

Averaged 21.5 points and 13.0 rebounds in a 1-1 week. He had 17 points and 12 boards in an 83-69 win over Georgetown. In a 72-61 loss at Cincinnati, he finished with 26 points and 14 boards.

Dane Miller, Rutgers, F, Sr.

Averaged 13.0 points and 9.5 rebounds in a 1-1 week while shooting 71.4 percent from the floor. Scored the deciding basket in a 61-58 win against St. John's.

Brandon Triche, Syracuse, G, Jr.

Had 18 points, four rebounds and four assists in a 58-49 win against Louisville that gave the Orange a 17-1 BIG EAST record.

Cincinnati committed only six turnovers.

The victory coupled with losses by USF and Georgetown puts the Bearcats as the No. 4 seed in The BIG EAST Championship. The previous highest seed for the Bearcats was No. 7 last year.

The 12-6 BIG EAST record is also a high mark for UC in the league. The Bearcats were 11-7 last year.

The Bearcats have won seven of their last nine games. UC has won 17 of its last 24 BIG EAST games.

The Huskies will be the No. 9 seed at The BIG EAST Championship. Last year, the UConn was the ninth seed and won the title. Like last year, its first-round opponent will be No. 16 seed DePaul.

In his final home game, Jeremiah Kelly posted 15 points and 10 assists with only one turnover in 30 minutes.

Cleveland Melvin helped with 14 points and nine rebounds.

The Blue Demons will be the No. 16 seed at The BIG EAST Championship.

Louisville has won at least 22 games for 10 straight seasons. The Cardinals have won at least 19 games in 39 of the last 43 years.

The Orange have won or shared 10 BIG EAST regular-season titles. That ties Connecticut for the most regular-season crowns.

Only Connecticut (in 1995-96) had finished 17-1 in BIG EAST play. No league team has ever gone undefeated.
