Welcome to the Cathay Pacific Hong Kong International Races 2011 – The Turf World Championships on Sunday, 11 December.

The four Group 1 races, now with an increase in prize money to HK\$20 million for the Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Mile to bring it to parity with the Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Cup, boast total purses of HK\$68 million (US\$8.7 million). Twenty two G1 winners from nine countries will contest the four championship events.

In the **FORM GUIDE** of each race, the **PERFORMANCE ANALYSIS** table provides you with a bird-eye's view of the race. This at-a-glance guide gives you a full form summary of the horses in a simple and concise table.

Another handy tool is the **INTERNATIONAL RATINGS CHART**. In weight-for-age races like the Cathay Pacific HKIR, generally speaking, the higher a horse's rating, which is based on racing performance, the better its chance to win.

A preliminary **SPEED CHART** has been included to assist in identifying likely positions in running. Please note that this is preliminary only and the full Speed Map will be available after barrier draw in the SpeedPOWER Form Guide on www.hkjc.com/english/formguide/formguide.asp.

If you need further information and analysis, just flip over to the next section where you will find the **COMPREHENSIVE PAST PERFORMANCE** of the horses. Also included is the **FORM ANALYSIS**, which highlights the notable achievements and racing characteristics of each horse. Another feature is the **RATINGS HISTORY CHART**. This chart indicates the quality and consistency of a horse's previous 10 starts through a graphical illustration of the ratings achieved in these races.

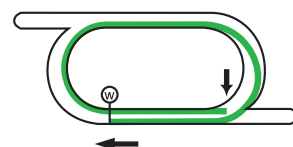

Speed Chart

With a long straight run to the first bend there is unlikely to be much early pressure and the tempo should be slow. Super Pistachio may lack brilliance but he is a regular leader and has led throughout over this trip and looks the most likely pace-setter, with Mighty High the main early-speed rival – if there is one. The race may develop into a sit-and-sprint affair where late turn-of-foot becomes all important.

There is a 300m run to the first bend and on the A course barriers are only moderately important. The tempo should be on the fast side of good as proven speedsters Pas de Trois, Curren Chan and Rocket Man vie for the forward positions. There is a 700m straight run before the first bend which means there is no need for an early scramble to find positions, which often results in a slow tempo in races over this trip. Able One and Beauty Flash are the likely pace-setters. In their two recent 1600m races this duo set very slow tempos and the same is likely here. While barriers are not very important there is a bunch of midfield runners and those drawn on the outside of the bunch may need to change tactics to get in.

Speed Chart

The first bend comes up quickly and barriers are usually important, but with a smaller than usual field and two definite leaders in Ransom Note and Durban Thunder, plus the possibility they may be pressured by Cirrus Des Aigles – who sometimes races keenly – the tempo may be strong enough to open up the field and allow most horses to drop in with cover. Statistically, 38% of 2000m races are won by pressers positioned on average 5L off the lead at the 800m pole.

Barande-Barbe, Corine
Cup – Cirrus des Aigles

Aged 51, she took out her licence in 1991 and is based at Chantilly. Until recently the best she had trained remained Carling, winner of the Gr.1 French Oaks and Prix Vermeille, but others of note have been Red Roses Story, Perfect Vintage, Jeopardy, and in 2009 her CXHK Vase runner, Cirrus des Aigles. Cirrus des Aigles has been her ambassador recently and has competed around the world, notably in the G1 CXHK Cup, following his attempt at last year's Japan Cup. The horse has shown marked improvement since his visit to Hong Kong when finishing seventh in last year's CXHK Cup, in October winning the G1 British Champion Stakes at Ascot. It is to his trainer's credit that he now arrives in Hong Kong for his third visit as the highest rated horse in the CXHKIR.


Bary, John
Mile – Jimmy Choux

Age 42, John Bary has enjoyed a meteoric rise to fame since beginning his training career in a fashion so unconventional it reads almost like fiction. A horseman from a very early age, for eight years Bary was a professional polo player of international renown, then used the money earned in that lucrative occupation to set up as a sheep farmer in his native New Zealand. In 2006 his great, great-grandfather, George Gatenby Stead, who had been leading owner in NZ 12 times around the turn of the 20th century, was inducted into New Zealand racing's Hall of Fame, an event which reminded Bary that the item on his mantelpiece gathering dust was actually a Melbourne Cup. Bary decided to switch from sheep to racehorses, and his equestrian skills brought him immediate success, most notably and most recently with 2011 NZ Derby winner Jimmy Choux, already a five time G1 winner.


Botti, Marco
Vase – Jakkalberry

Age 33, Marco Botti is a member of one of the most successful families in Italian racing. His father Alduino, to whom he served three years as assistant, was champion trainer of Italy for more than three decades. Marco rode as an amateur jockey in Italy, riding 48 winners, before continuing his training apprenticeship with Luca Cumani and Ed Dunlop at Newmarket, Saeed bin Suroor in Dubai and Bill Mott in the USA. He began training at Newmarket in 2006 and now has around 70 horses in his care. The best horses he has trained so far have been Gitano Hernando with whom he won the G1 Goodwood Handicap at Santa Anita and Excelebration, winner of the G1 Prix du Moulin at Longchamp. This year he has trained 39 winners in the UK at a strike rate of 16 per cent.


Charlton, Roger
Sprint – Bated Breath; Mile – Cityscape

Age 61, Charlton has been one of the most respected and successful trainers in the UK for the last two decades. After assisting the famous Jeremy Tree for several years he took over Tree's Beckhampton stables in 1990 and achieved extraordinary success almost immediately with Sanglamore winning the 1990 G1 Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby) and three days later Quest For Fame winning the G1 Derby at Epsom. Since then he has enjoyed steady rather than such spectacular success mainly, but not exclusively, with high class sprinters. He has won the G1 Sprint Cup at Haydock twice, with Tamarisk (1998) and Tante Rose (2004) and the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp twice with Patavellian (2003) and Avonbridge (2005). In the 2011 season he has sent out UK 43 winners at the very high strike rate of 19 per cent.


Collet, Rodolphe
Mile – Sahpresa

Rodolphe (Rod) Collet, age 38, is the son and former assistant of trainer Robert Collet. Renowned for his sense of humour, he trains in Chantilly where his success has come mostly with handicappers. His first Group victory came with Tigertail in the G2 Prix Minerve in 2002. She also finished second (to Rakti) in the 2003 G1 Premio Presidente della Repubblica in Rome and in the G1 EP Taylor Stakes at Woodbine, Canada. Sahpresa is so far by some way the best horse he has trained having won the G1 Sun Chariot Stakes at Newmarket for the last three years in a row. She distinguished herself by finishing third behind Beauty Flash and Royal Bench (the latter trained by his father) in the 2010 G1 CXHK Mile and has since proved herself a top class competitor at the distance in other countries. Collet is very much an internationalist with Group victories in Italy, Germany and Sweden. In June 2011 he and his father completed a quinella of note when Robert's Immortal Verse won the G1 Coronation Stakes at Royal Ascot and Rod's Nova Hawk finished second.


Cruz, Anthony
Vase – Super Pistachio; Mile – Beauty Flash; Cup – California Memory, Pure Champion

Aged 54, six times Hong Kong's champion jockey, rode 946 winners in the saddle. He first landed the HK trainer's title in 1999/2000 and regained it in 2005, setting a new record for a season's winners (91) and earnings (HK\$113m) in the process. His most famous horses have been Silent Witness, the dual Cathay Pacific HK Sprint and nine-time Gr.1 winner, and Bullish Luck, five-time Gr.1 winner and winner of the G1 Yasuda Kinen in Japan. Lucky Owners' double in the HK Mile and Mercedes-Benz HK Derby and Helene Mascot's Derby victory also stand out. In 2010-11 in which he won 72 races, including two HKG1s and the G1 CXHK Mile with Beauty Flash, for a career total of over 800, he looked sure to win another trainers' title until caught and passed almost on the line by the late burst of John Moore.


Cruz, Derek
Sprint – Joy And Fun

Aged 56, Derek Cruz, having previously ridden as a jockey, was licensed as a trainer in 1991. The first highlight of his training career came in December 2005 when Natural Blitz shocked most observers by snatching the CXHK Sprint for a first and only G1 triumph. 2009/10 was something of a breakthrough season for Cruz though as he first prepared Good Ba Ba to win a record third successive Cathay Pacific HK Mile, then won the inaugural running of the G3 Al Quoz Sprint at the Dubai World Cup meeting at Meydan with Joy And Fun. This season he has sent out nine winners for an overall total of 441.



Delzangles, Mikel

Vase – Dunaden

Age 39, Mikel Delzangles was born in Biarritz in France's Basque region. His godmother is the famed French racehorse owner, particularly of jumping horses, the Marquesa de Moratella. After working for UK based trainer Jimmy Fitzgerald he joined Alain de Royer Dupre as an assistant for ten years. He first took out a licence in his own right in 2001. His G1 victories since then have included Prix Ganay (2006 Corre Caminos), the Prix de l'Opera (2009 Shalanaya), the 2000 Guineas at Newmarket (2010) and the Prix Jacques Marois (2010) both with Makfi. But perhaps his greatest thrill so far came at Flemington, Australia last month when Dunaden, one of the horses he had 'inherited' from his friend Richard Gibson when Gibson moved to Hong Kong, won the 151st Melbourne Cup by a whisker from Red Cadeaux.



Dunlop, Edward

Vase – Red Cadeaux

Etonian Ed Dunlop, 43, is a son of champion British trainer John Dunlop and took out his trainer's licence in 1994. Ta Rib was his first Classic winner in the 1996 French 1000 Guineas and Iktamal his first Gr.1 scorer in Britain later that year. Won the Irish Oaks in 2001 with Lailani and the same race in 2004 with Ouija Board (after she won The Oaks at Epsom and before she won the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf). Ouija Board, went on to be voted European Horse of the Year in 2004 and to win the CXHK Vase in decisive fashion in 2005. Last year Snow Fairy won four G1s for him: The Oaks, the Irish Oaks and in Japan the Queen Elizabeth II Commemorative Cup, before crowning her season with victory in the G1 CXHK Cup in December 2010. This year she has retained her form, finishing a close second to So You Think in the G1 Irish Champion Stakes and third in the Arc before a repeat victory in the QEII Commemorative Cup in Kyoto, while Red Cadeaux came within an inch of victory in the G1 Melbourne Cup.



Fabre, Andre

Cup – Byword

Age 66 Andre Fabre is one of the greatest trainers in racing history, and not just in his native France. The law graduate son of a diplomat, this unusual racing character, one of whose greatest pleasures in life are the works of Marcel Proust, became one of France's leading jump jockeys, riding more than 250 winners including France's premier steeplechase, the Grand Steeplechase de Paris. As a trainer he has been even more successful, winning the national trainers' title for 19 years in succession. He has trained the winners of all his country's greatest races including the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe no less than seven times and has prepared many European and World Champions, including Trempolino, In The Wings, Zafonic, Peintre Celebre, Hurricane Run and Manduro. This year, after many attempts, he finally completed a lifelong ambition when Pour Moi triumphed in the G1 Derby at Epsom. His previous CXHKIR success came with Borgia in the 1999 Vase.



Fanshawe, James

Sprint – Society Rock

Age 49, James Fanshawe has been a leading British trainer for 20 years. His most notable successes have come with the brilliant five time G1 winning filly Soviet Song but he has also won the G1 July Cup with Frizzante (2005) and proved his versatility when sending Hors La Loi III to Cheltenham in 2002 to triumph in the Champion Hurdle. So far in 2011 he has 31 victories at a strike rate of 16 per cent, with the seasonal highlights coming from Society Rock at Royal Ascot and prolific Group winning sprinter Deacon Blues, who on 15 October took the G2 British Champion Sprint Stakes as his fifth victory in a row.



Fownes, Caspar

Vase – Super Satin, Thumbs Up; Sprint – Green Birdie, Lucky Nine; Mile – Fair Trade

Aged 44, he assisted his trainer father Lawrie for several seasons before taking over the mantle in 2003/04. Eclipsed his father's best season stats in his rookie year with 44 winners, and in 2006/07 won his first trainers' premiership. His most famous victory that year was with The Duke in the G1 Cathay Pacific HK Mile of 2006. He has a particularly good strike-rate with his runners at Happy Valley where on 20 June 2010 he sent out six winners in a single day, equalling the record in Hong Kong's professional racing era. Won his second premiership in 2008/09 and finished second in the table in 2009/10, the season in which, with Super Satin, he enjoyed his first HKG1 Mercedes-Benz Hong Kong Derby success, and followed up with victory for Green Birdie in the G1 KrisFlyer International Sprint in Singapore. He trained 56 winners in 2010-11, a season in which his best victory was probably Lucky Nine's in the HKG1 Mercedes-Benz Hong Kong Classic Mile, and has added a further 13 this season for a current Hong Kong career total of 450.



Hammond, John

Vase – Sarah Lynx

Age 51, Englishman John Hammond began training at Chantilly just over 20 years ago and quickly rose to prominence, first with the G1 Prix du Jockey Club triumph of subsequent European Champion and 1991 Arc winner Suave Dancer, and then with a succession of G1 winners, culminating in an even greater Arc winner in Montjeu who went on as a four-year-old to become the easiest winner of the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Stakes since Ribot and Nijinsky. Hammond's other major victories in Europe include Prix Vermeille with Sweet Stream, Sprint Cup with Cherokee Rose and Nuclear Debate. This is not Hammond's first visit to Hong Kong, however, as back in 1994 he had won the Hong Kong Vase with Red Bishop. His top sprinter Nuclear Debate also took part in the Hong Kong Sprint three times in 1999-2001.



Hannon, Richard

Mile – Dubawi Gold

Richard Hannon, now aged 66, has long been one of the major forces in British training from his base at East Everleigh Stables, in Marlborough. Three-time champion trainer, he has built something of a racing dynasty. His son Richard Jnr. is currently his assistant trainer, and his son-in-law Richard Hughes is the stable jockey. Hannon himself took out his licence in 1970. Since establishing G1 credentials with 2000 Guineas winners Mon Fils, Don't Forget Me and Tirol he has trained over 100 winners per season on a regular basis, often nudging 200. Although recognised as a specialist with two-year-olds his 2011 standard bearer was undoubtedly the now-retired Canford Cliffs, champion older miler of Europe and the horse who broke the great Goldikova's G1 winning spree in the Queen Anne Stakes at Royal Ascot in 2011. Canford Cliffs was unbeaten in his previous five outings before defeat by Frankel in the eagerly awaited G1 Sussex Stakes. This season Hannon has trained 214 UK winners, surpassing even last season's total of 210.



Head, Frederic

Vase – Silver Pond; Mile – Rajsaman

Aged 64, one of the greatest jockeys in French racing history, Freddie Head was champion jockey six times and won the Prix De l'Arc de Triomphe on four occasions. He retired in 1997 and was perhaps best known in the latter stages of his career for his association with the brilliant mare Miesque, twice heroine of the Breeders' Cup Mile. His father Alec was a successful trainer, as is his sister, Criquette. He had an amazing 2008, winning nine G 1 races, including three apiece for his champion sprinter Marchand D'Or, and Breeders' Cup Mile heroine, Goldikova. It is the now-retired Goldikova who has won him most fame in recent years as the winner of a record 14 G1s in Europe and America, and the first and only horse to have won three Breeders' Cup races in succession. His 2011 G1 victories include the Prix d'Ispahan and the Prix Rothschild, both with Goldikova, Prix Vermeille with Galikova, and the Prix Maurice de Gheest with Moonlight Cloud.



Hickst, Waldemar

Cup – Zazou

Age 47, German-based Waldemar Hickst was a jockey with 237 victories to his name before turning to training in 2004. He quickly established himself as one of the country's leading trainers and is currently contending with Andreas Wohler for the German trainers' championship which will be decided at the end of December. His first G1 and Classic winner came in 2005 when Almerita won the German Oaks at Dusseldorf. He has added two Classics since then, both German Guineas with Kali and former champion two-year-old Precious Boy respectively. Hong Kong Cup contender Zazou, whom he took over from Mario Hofer, became his second G 1 winner with his success in Rome.



Hills, Charles

Vase – Redwood; Cup – Ransom Note

Age 33, Charles Hills only took over the mantle of his father Barry, one of the great figures of British racing, this year, and so has a relatively unspectacular curriculum vitae of his own so far. No doubt this will soon be corrected, as the brother of jockeys Richard and Michael and trainer John has a remarkable pedigree behind him as well as the history of a stable which has sent out winners of almost every great race in the British calendar as well as the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe with Rheingold.



Ho, Peter

Vase – Mr Medici

Aged 51, Ho graduated from the ranks of assistant trainer to take out his own licence in 1997/98. His biggest success arrived when he sent out Packing Winner to claim the HKG1 Citi Champions & Chater Cup in 2008. His best horse since has been Mr Medici, winner of the 2010 HKG1 Standard Chartered Champions & Chater Cup, who also earned himself the Champion Stayer title for the 2009/10 season. Mr Medici went on to run with credit in both the Caulfield and Melbourne Cups. Packing Winner now retired ran a typically game third in the G1 2010 CXHK Cup won by Snow Fairy. Ho finished last season with a total of 26 winners, and he added 11 more winners at the start of the current season, bringing his overall total to 368.



Ikee, Yasutoshi

Vase – Trailblazer

Age 41, Ikee first took out his trainer's licence in 2003 and has since established himself as one of his country's most successful trainers, with G1 victories in the Satsuki Sho (Japanese 2000 Guineas), Japanese Derby, Japanese St Leger and Autumn Tenno Sho. This season has been his most successful ever as he trains the Triple Crown winning 3yo champion Orfevre, as well as Autumn Tenno Sho winner Tosen Jordan. In 2011 he has so far a total of 45 victories bringing his career total to 273.



Kunieda, Sakae

Mile – Apapane

Based at Miho Training Centre, Sakae Kuneida first took out a trainer's licence in 1989 and recorded his first victory in March of the following year. Since then he has made significant progress and is now one of Japan's leading trainers with a career total of 562 victories of which 34 have come this season. His best horses have been Black Hawk (G1 Sprinters Stakes 1999), Maturida Gogh (G1 Arima Kinen 2007), Pink Cameo (G1 NHK Mile 2007) and Apapane, Fillies Triple Crown winner 2010 who earlier this year defeated Buena Vista in the G1 Victoria Mile.



Lynam, Edward

Sprint – Sole Power

Age 49, Edward Lynam first took out a trainer's licence in Ireland in 1984 but for some time has divided his energies between running a building business and preparing winners. He learnt many of his training skills from the great Jim Bolger. The first major winner he trained was Tantum Ergo who won a G3 at the now defunct Phoenix Park. But Hong Kong fans will remember him as the trainer of Duff, winner of the G2 Park Stakes at Doncaster in 2009, who then ran in the Hong Kong Mile in 2009. His greatest victory to date has been Sole Power's 100/1 triumph over Starspangledbanner in the G1 Nunthorpe Stakes in 2010.



Millard, Anthony

Cup – Ambitious Dragon

Aged 50, Millard was a multiple champion trainer in South Africa. He trained 39 Group 1 winners in his first nine years of training before relocating to Hong Kong. He trained three Horses of the Year there in Empress Club, Jet Master and Surfing Home as well as numerous other champions, and he has won every major race in South Africa. He made an immediate impact locally, winning the 2000 Hong Kong Derby in his first season with Keen Winner. But his most spectacular success in Hong Kong came last season thanks largely to the triumphs of Mercedes-Benz Hong Kong Derby winner, APQEII Cup winner and 2010-2011 Horse of the Year Ambitious Dragon. Also took Hong Kong's star mare Sweet Sanette to Royal Ascot where she finished third in the G1 King's Stand Stakes. Ended the 2010-11 HK season with 37 winners for an overall total of 345.



Moore, John

*Vase – Mighty High; Sprint – Admiration;
Mile – Able One, Destined For Glory, Xtension; Cup – Irian, Jacobee*

Aged 61, Moore has been involved in HK racing since the professional era began in 1971. He began training in 1985, before which he held the position of assistant trainer to his late famous father, George. In 2007 he prepared an international G1 double thanks to Viva Pataca in the Audemars Piguet QEII Cup and Able One in the Champions Mile, and in a feat perhaps unprecedented in the sport won the same two races with the same two horses three years later. Moore, who has made no secret of the fact that earnings rather than sheer weight of winners are his priority, has been leader in prize-money won for the past six seasons, thanks in part to the now retired Viva Pataca, the leading prize money winner in Hong Kong racing history. He is also the first trainer ever to send out 1,000 winners in Hong Kong. In 2010-2011 he regained the Trainers' Championship he last held in 1994-5 by winning four of the last six races of the season, finally getting the better of an epic battle with Tony Cruz.



Mundry, Torsten

Cup – Durban Thunder

Before switching to training less than three years ago, 40-year-old Torsten Mundry was a jockey for almost 20 years, winning 1,184 races in total, 69 of them coming during stints in Hong Kong and Macau. His greatest success in the saddle came on Lavirco in the 1996 German Derby. His first G1 success as a trainer came in 2010 when Enora won the German Oaks. His second came with his Hong Kong Cup contender Durban Thunder in the Grosser Dallmayr Preis at Munich in July. He has already scored 14 'black type' victories: seven at Group level and seven Listed. His stable's chief patron is Gregor Baum, breeder of 2011 Arc winner, Danedream.



Royer-Dupre, Alain de

Vase – Vadamar

Aged 67, trains about 100 horses, principally for the Aga Khan, at Chantilly. In 2008 he ended Andre Fabre's 21-year reign as France's champion trainer, thanks largely to Zarkava, the European Horse of the Year who swept the Fillies' Triple Crown and the Arc in an unbeaten career yielding five Gr.1 wins. De Royer-Dupre has won over 50 Gr.1 races in France with Dalakhani, winner of the French Derby and Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in 2003, another luminary. De Royer-Dupre also numbers the Breeders' Cup Turf (Lashkari 1984) and the Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Cup (Pride in 2006) among 12 international triumphs. A regular visitor to Hong Kong, he won the 2009 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Vase with Daryakana. In November 2010 he enjoyed one of his greatest triumphs when Americain won 150th running of G1 Melbourne Cup. This year he won two more G1s including the French Derby with Reliable Man, and Grand Prix de Saint Cloud with Sarafina.



Sameshima, Ippo

Sprint – Pas de Trois

Age 57 Ippo Sameshima who first took out a licence in 1999 and recorded his first winner on 6 May 2000, is based at Ritto Training Centre. He now has a career total of 309 victories of which 27 have come this year. His 2011 wins include the G2 Meguro Kinen, the G3 Hakodate Kinen and the G3 Sekiya Kinen. Apart from CXHK Sprint representative Pas de Trois, his best horses so far have been Silk Famous (a three time Group winner between 2004 and 2006) and King Top Gun, winner of the Meguro Kinen and Hakodate Kinen this year.



Shaw, Patrick

Sprint – Rocket Man

Shaw started out as stable employee in 1988 before being upgraded to a professional trainer's licence by the Jockey Club of Southern Africa in 1990. He was consistently amongst the top 10 trainers in South Africa and counts his success with Teal in the 1995 Durban July as his biggest claim to fame. He relocated to Singapore in 2001 and immediately came to prominence in 2002 when Palace Line won the International G 3 Singapore Classic and the Singapore Guineas. More Group wins have followed including the 2006 Singapore Gold Cup and Singapore Guineas with Mr Line and the Emirates Singapore Derby with Our Falstaff. He has also won the Kranji Mile twice, with Blizz Bless in 2003 and Setembro Chove in 2007. Shaw will always be associated with Rocket Man, the best horse to have graced Singaporean racing so far. Now officially the world's best male sprinter, Rocket Man ended a frustrating sequence of big race near-misses that included the 2010 CXHK Sprint when winning the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen in 2011, then followed up with victory at home in the G1 KrisFlyer International Sprint.



Shum, Danny

Sprint – Little Bridge

Aged 51, rode 24 HK winners between 1977 and 1983. He learned the training ropes as former multiple HK champion Ivan Allan's assistant, before setting out on his own in 2003/04 when he began brightly with 34 winners. He did better to run third in the Trainers' Premiership in his second term with HKGr.1 Mercedes-Benz HK Classic Mile victor Scintillation outstanding. The same horse won him the HKGr.1 Centenary Sprint Cup in 2006 and 2007. Trained 19 winners in 2010/11, in which multiple winner Little Bridge was his stable star. Has made a very good start to this season with 15 victories as at 28 November..

**Size, John***Sprint – Entrapment, Rich Unicorn; Mile – Flying Blue, Sichuan Success*

Aged 57, John Size was a top trainer in Sydney before his arrival in Hong Kong in 2001 with a reputation for improving and rekindling the spark in his horses. He broke the mould by winning the trainers' premiership in his very first season, adding five more titles in 2003, 2004, 2006, 2008 and 2010. He has trained the winners of two Horse of the Year titles, the multiple HKGr.1 scorers Electronic Unicorn and Grand Delight. He also won the Audemars Piguet QE II Cup in 2004 with longshot River Dancer, the same year he secured two Triple Crown legs via Super Kid. He won the 2009 Champions Mile with Sight Winner. In 2009/10 he trained Brave Kid to equal the then record of six wins in a season and Entrapment who finally broke that record with seven victories in just five months. In 2010-2011 he finished third in the Trainers' Championship adding another 64 winners (625). This season he has scored a further 19 winners to bring his Hong Kong career total to 644 as of 28 November.

**Suroor, Saeed bin***Vase – Campanologist*

Saeed bin Suroor, 45, took out his trainer's licence in 1994 and joined Sheikh Mohammed's mighty Godolphin operation a year later. He has been champion trainer in Britain four times and has prepared over 150 Gr.1 winners worldwide. Dubai Millennium is widely regarded as the best he has trained. In Hong Kong he has won the QEII Cup with Overbury in 1996, the CXHK Cup in 2000 and 2007 with Fantastic Light and Ramonti and the CXHK Mile in 2004 with Firebreak. On 12 December 2010 he added a CXHK Vase when Mastery scored a comfortable victory.

**Woods, Sean***Cup – King Dancer*

Aged 46, Woods is a former jumps jockey turned trainer. He trained successfully in England before decamping to Hong Kong in 2002/03 and has enjoyed consistent success since. Trained 18 winners in 2010/11, Woods added another four winners this season which puts his HK overall to 223 as at 28 November. His best horse currently is probably King Dancer, winner of the 2010 HKG2 Mercedes-Benz HK Derby Trial who gave Woods his first Group success in Hong Kong.

**Yasuda, Takayuki***Sprint – Curren Chan*

Age 58, Takayuki Yasuda who took out his licence in 1994 and registered his first victory on March 25 of the following year. has enjoyed a highly successful 2011 with victories in the G1 Sprinters Stakes (Curren Chan), the G1 February Stakes and the NAR's JPN G1 Mile Championship Nambu Hai (both Transcend). His best horses currently are Transcend, who finished runner-up to Victoire Pisa in the G1 Dubai World Cup, and CXHK Sprint contender Curren Chan. He has a career total of 431 victories of which 39 have come this year.

**Yip, Dennis***Mile – Fat Choy Oohlala*

Aged 44, Yip was licensed as a jockey in Hong Kong between 1984 and 1993. He rode a total of 59 winners before moving on to learn the training game overseas and then acting as assistant to multiple champion trainer, Brian Kan. In 2002/03 he became a licensed trainer in his own right. Yip trained over 30 winners in each of his nine-year training career and landed 41 winners in 2010/11. Overall total reached 374 as at 28 November.

**Yiu, Ricky***Sprint – Sacred Kingdom*

Aged 54, Yiu rode 15 winners between 1974 and 1981 and was first licensed as a trainer in 1995/96. One of his greatest early moments came with Fairy King Prawn's success in the inaugural Hong Kong Sprint of 1999. In recent seasons he has performed impressively with one of the best win strike-rates in town, with his former world champion sprinter, Sacred Kingdom leading the way. Sacred Kingdom repeated his 2007 G1 CXHK Sprint victory in 2009, following a triumph overseas in Singapore's G1 KrisFlyer International Sprint in May of the same year. Even in 2010-2011, with age perhaps catching up with him the 2009-2010 Horse of the Year won the Champion Sprinter title for the fourth year in succession. Yiu's greatest achievement last season was Ultra Fantasy's triumph in the Sprinters' Stakes at Nakayama as, with Alex Lai on board, the pair became the first Hong Kong Chinese trainer-jockey partnership to triumph in an overseas G1. Yiu had trained 470 Hong Kong winners so far, of which 15 came in current season.



Ando, Katsumi

Vase – Trailblazer; Sprint – Pas de Trois

Aged 51, Ando started his riding career in the regional association NAR (National Association of Racing) in Japan back in 1976, and is one of the most successful regional jockeys to have joined JRA's jockey ranks in recent years. He has ridden more than 4,000 winners in both his NAR and JRA career, which include no less than 29 G1 titles and great partnerships with top gallopers such as Buena Vista, Daiwa Scarlet and Daiwa Major. His latest G1 success came with Marcellina in the Oka Sho (Japanese 1000 Guineas) at Hanshin Racecourse in April.



Beadman, Darren

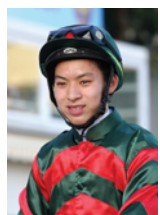
Aged 46, Beadman is the youngest rider to be inducted into the Australian Racing Hall of Fame and the first to do so while still riding. He won the Golden Slipper as a teenager and he has twice lifted Melbourne Cups on Kingston Rule and Saintly. He repeatedly broke his own records in eight Sydney jockeys' premierships (his current standard is 164). He landed the Hong Kong International Bowl in 1996 and 1997 on Monopolize and Catalan Opening and in 2008/09 he won the CXHK Sprint on Inspiration for retaining trainer John Moore. Very much a big race specialist, he has won a total of 266 HK winners as at 27 November.



Branca, Fabio

Vase – Jakkalberry

Fabio Branca, aged 27, has enjoyed a fantastic 2011. Italy's former Champion Jockey, a native of Nuovo now resident in Pisa, won the G2 Derby Italiano for the first time in May aboard Crackerjack King and subsequently clinched the second of two career G1 successes in October when he galvanized Quiza Quiza Quiza to a last-gasp win in the Longines Lydia Tesio. His initial career G1 triumph was secured in June, 2010, when Crackerjack King's half-brother Jakkalberry took the Gran Premio di Milano.



Chadwick, Matthew

Aged 21, Matthew Chadwick remains very much the wunderkind of HK racing. Champion apprentice in Hong Kong in 2008/09, he has already ridden more than 140 winners in Hong Kong, including 43 of them last term. He rode his first Group winner on Egyptian Ra in the HKG3 National Day Cup in October 2009. But the finest moment of his career so far came when landing the HKG1 Citibank Hong Kong Gold Cup on the Tony Cruz-trained California Memory in February 2011.



Clark, Tim

Aged 25, the former Sydney champion apprentice won his first career G1 with Typhoon Zed in The Galaxy at Royal Randwick in 2008. He also has successful partnership with top runners such as Hot Danish, Sacred Choice and Atomic Force. Riding in a short stint in HK for the first time this season, Clark has so far notched up eight winners (as at 27 November), but it was deemed to be considerable success as the winners include a Group race double aboard Jacobee in the HKG3 Sa Sa Ladies' Purse, and Destined For Glory in the G2 CX Jockey Club Mile.



Dettori, Lanfranco

Vase – Campanologist

Lanfranco "Frankie" Dettori is one of the sport's all-time great jockeys. He was British Champion Apprentice in 1989 and he continued his early success in 1990 to become the first teenager since the great Lester Piggott to ride over 100 winners in a British season. His three UK Champion Jockey titles came in 1994, 1995 and 2004, and his victory aboard Dabirsim in the G1 Qatar Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere at Longchamp in October, 2011 was his 500th win in Group race competition. His impressive tally of more than 200 G1 wins includes 14 in British Classics, among them the 2007 Epsom Derby on Authorized. Dettori famously won all seven races on the card at Ascot in September 1996, a feat that has become known as "Frankie's Magnificent Seven" and further propelled him to superstar status. He was appointed as the retained rider for Godolphin in 1993. His excellent worldwide record includes three wins in each of the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, Japan Cup and Dubai World Cup, 10 Breeders' Cup race victories and six wins in Cathay Pacific Hong Kong International Races. Dettori won the CXIJC twice in 1999 and 2001 and this will be his sixth appearance in the CXIJC and his first since 2003.



Doleuze, Olivier

Aged 39. Former champion apprentice in France, Olivier Doleuze rode mostly for Criquelette Head-Maarek in his homeland where he enjoyed Classic wins on Green Tune and Egyptband. He enjoyed his best Hong Kong season in 2006/07 when he rode 67 winners, the highlight being his victory on The Duke in the Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Mile, a race he won again in 2007 and 2009 on Good Ba Ba. He has ridden a total of 387 winners in HK as at 27 November.



Drowne, Steve

Sprint – Bated Breath; Mile – Cityscape

Steve Drowne, 40, is a respected member of the jockeys' room in Britain and rode his first winner in September, 1990. He is associated with trainer Roger Charlton, for whom he partnered the half-brothers, Patavellian and Avonbridge, to G1 glory in the 2003 and 2005 renewals of the Prix de l'Abbaye. The first of his five career G1 victories came in 2001 atop Queen's Logic in the Cheveley Park Stakes, while his most recent was on Sakhee's Secret in the 2007 July Cup. He has ridden Bated Breath to second place in both the G1 July Cup and G1 Haydock Sprint Cup this year.



Ebina, Masayoshi

Mile – Apapane

Aged 42, Ebina was JRA's Champion Jockey in 2001 and has ridden more than 2,000 winners in Japan. These include 22 winners at G1 level, among them his emphatic successes with prolific filly Apapane in winning the Fillies' Triple Crown title in 2010. Ebina has also enjoyed considerable success at the international level, including in Hong Kong as he won Hong Kong Invitation Cup aboard Fujiyama Kenzan in 1995. He also partnered Japan Cup winner El Condor Pasa to win the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud in 1999, and the colt ran 2nd to Montjeu in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in the same year.



Guyon, Maxime

Cup – Byword

Aged 22. Starting his riding career in May 2005 under the guidance of leading French trainer Andre Fabre, Maxime Guyon quickly established himself as one of his country's leading jockeys. Fabre, who is not careless with his praise, has said he believes his protégé has the innate talent to become one of the best jockeys of all time. After gaining his senior licence in January 2008, Guyon's career blossomed with G1 victories in quick succession on Cavalryman (Grand Prix de Paris), Shalanaya (Prix de l'Opera), Cutlass Bay (Prix Ganay), Lope de Vega (French Derby & French 2000 Guineas) and Byword (Prince of Wales's Stakes). In Hong Kong he made an immediate impact in a short stint with 15 victories that won him second place in the Most Popular Jockey of the Year last season, striking up a superb rapport with Horse of the Year Ambitious Dragon on whom he achieved the rare distinction of winning the HKG1 Mercedes-Benz Hong Kong Derby at his first attempt. This year he has added another five G1s at home: the Prix de Diane (French Oaks) on Golden Lilac, the Prix Jean Prat on Mutual Trust, the Juddmonte Grand Prix de Paris on Meandre, the Darley Prix Jean Romanet on Announce and the Prix Royal-Oak on Be Fabulous. This will be Guyon's first CXIJC.



Hills, Michael

Cup – Ransom Note

Michael Hills, 48, is the son of famous retired trainer Barry and identical twin brother of fellow jockey Richard. In fact so difficult is it for outsiders to tell the difference between the pair that the brothers often find themselves being congratulated on each other's rides. His youngest brother, Charlie, took over their father's stables earlier this year. Michael was champion apprentice in 1983 and since then has been one of Britain's leading riders winning 29 G1s including the Derby, the King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Stakes and the Gold Cup at Ascot. His most recent G1 came in September 2010, on his father's Redwood in the Northern Dancer Turf Stakes in Canada.



Hughes, Richard

Mile – Dubawi Gold

Richard Hughes is the son of former jump race jockey, now a trainer, Dessie Hughes. Now 38 and with 26 G1 wins to his name, he won his first pony race in Ireland aged eight and began riding as an apprentice when only 15. He is the son-in-law of trainer Richard Hannon, for whom he is the principal rider. Hughes and Hannon have enjoyed a golden period over the past three years thanks to G1 winners Paco Boy, Dick Turpin and the ace miler Canford Cliffs. Hughes was retained rider to Prince Khalid Abdulla from 2001 until November, 2007, and rode star G1 winners such as Oasis Dream, Observatory, Nebraska Tornado and American Post.



Ikezoe, Kenichi

Sprint – Curren Chan

Aged 32, Ikezoe was the Champion Apprentice Jockey in Japan in 1998. He has ridden more than 750 winners, including no less than 16 victories at G1 level. He has enjoyed the most successful season of his career so far in 2011, as he famously partnered the 3yo colt Orfevre to victory in the Japanese Triple Crown – the 7th horse in Japanese racing history to achieve this feat. He also landed two other G1 successes in the past two months, with Curren Chan in the Sprinters Stakes in October and Eishin Apollon in the Mile Championship in November.



Jarnet, Thierry

Mile – Rajsaman

At age 44 and with four Jockey Championships (1992-1995) behind him, Thierry Jarnet is one of France's most senior riders. Apprenticed to Patrick Rago, his first win came at Cagnes-sur-Mer in 1985. His impressive big-race haul includes the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe on Subotica (1992) and Carnegie (1994), as well as Pennekamp's brilliant G1 English 2,000 Guineas win in 1994. He won the 2002 Hong Kong Vase on Ange Gabriel and has been in the G1 spotlight in 2011 thanks to Tin Horse's win in the Poule d'Essai des Poulains and Moonlight Cloud's impressive triumph in the Prix Maurice de Gheest.



Latham, Keagan

Sprint – Sole Power

Born in Durban, South Africa but based in Ireland, 22-year-old Keagan Latham had never sat on a horse or even watched a race on TV before joining the Racing Academy in his hometown. After a two-year apprenticeship with Mike de Kock, a spell riding for Herman Brown and a winter in Dubai, the rider moved to Ger Lyons' stable in County Meath where, since arriving in 2008, he has forged a reputation as a young jockey to watch. He enjoyed the biggest success of his career in May when Sole Power sprinted to glory in the G2 Temple Stakes at Haydock Park.



Lemaire, Christophe

Vase – Vadamar; Mile – Sahpresa

Aged 32, Christophe Lemaire is a jockey with a true international pedigree. His father was a leading jump jockey, which enabled Christophe to take an unconventional route into racing, completing his baccalaureate with high marks and beginning his riding career as a "gentleman amateur". Since then he has distinguished himself in many countries, specialising, it seems, in overthrowing famous horses. His brilliance was instrumental in enabling Heart's Cry to interrupt Deep Impact's winning streak in the G1 Arima Kinen in Japan in 2005. He won the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud on Pride in 2006, who defeated Arc winner Hurricane Run, and won the G1 CXHK Cup on the same horse, beating Admire Moon the same year. In 2009 he won the G1 Japan Cup on Vodka. His English victories include Classics as well as the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes at Newmarket on Starcraft in 2005. Last year he won the G1 2000 Guineas in England on Makfi and, back home in France, where he is retained jockey for the Aga Khan, the G1 Prix de Diane on Sarafina. His supreme moment of 2011 so far and another demonstration of his big race knack, has been his 1 November victory by the narrowest margin in the history of the race on the French-trained Dunaden in the 151st G1 Melbourne Cup. This will be Lemaire's fourth appearance in the CXIJC. He finished second in 2008 and was one of the three dead heaters for first place in 2009.



Murtagh, John

Sprint – Society Rock

Aged 41, John Murtagh was crowned Champion Jockey of Ireland for the fifth time in November. He was the stable jockey to John Oxx from 1992 – 2003, during which time he rode 18 G1 winners for the Aga Khan. Murtagh was the number one jockey to the Ballydoyle/Coolmore operation between 2008 and 2010. From 2007 to 2010 he rode an incredible 47 G1 winners mostly for Ballydoyle maestro Aidan O'Brien. Murtagh is generally reckoned, at least in Europe, to be one of the best big race jockeys in the world. His G1 victories in 2010 included the Tattersall's Gold Cup and Coronation Cup on Fame And Glory, the Juddmonte International Stakes on Rip Van Winkle, and the Golden Jubilee Stakes and July Cup on Starspangledbanner. This year Murtagh more than justified his decision to leave Ballydoyle and rejoin Oxx by not only winning the Irish Champion Jockey title again but adding more G1s on Lightning Pearl in the Cheveley Park Stakes, Jukebox Jury in the Irish St Leger and, with a widely acclaimed ride, Dancing Rain in the Oaks at Epsom. This will be Murtagh's third CXIJC. He was one of the three, with C Lemaire and R Moore, who dead heated for the title in 2009.



Peslier, Olivier

Cup – Zazou

Aged 38, Peslier has been French champion jockey four times. He holds a record number of seven CXHKIR wins - Partipral (Vase '95), Docksider (Mile '99), Borgia & Doctor Dino (Vase '99, '07, '08), Hat Trick (Mile '05) and Vision D'Etat (Cup '09). He won three Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe from 1996 to 1998 and has twice won the Japan Cup among over 100 wins at Gr.1 level worldwide. Peslier has twice won the CXIJC, in 1998 and 2006. In recent years, Peslier has enjoyed a prosperous partnership with "super mare" Goldikova, having ridden her to 14 G1 successes including a record third consecutive victory in the Breeders' Cup Mile in 2010. This year has brought five G1 wins for Peslier, including the Prix d'Ispahan and Prix Rothschild aboard Goldikova.



Prebble, Brett

Mile – Fair Trade

Aged 34, Prebble is a former champion apprentice and twice champion jockey in Melbourne. He has been second in the HK jockeys' championship for the past six years and he holds a Hong Kong record of riding six winners in one meeting at Happy Valley on 20 June 2010. Having built successful partnerships with top HK runners such as Cape Of Good Hope, Bullish Luck, and Sacred Kingdom, he has twice won the Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Sprint with Absolute Champion in 2006 and Sacred Kingdom in 2009.



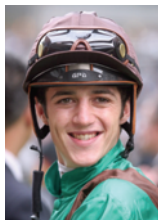
Purton, Zac

Aged 28, Purton won the Brisbane jockeys' premiership as an apprentice in 2003 and, seeking a fresh challenge, later moved to Sydney where he came second only to perennial champion, Darren Beadman. This season is his 5th full term and his biggest HK win came in the HKG1 Stewards' Cup on Fellowship in 2010. His total HK winners now stands at 185 on 27 November.

Mile – Jimmy Choux



Soumillon, Christophe

Cup – Cirrus des Aigles

With almost 70 G1 wins under his belt, Belgian rider Christophe Soumillon, 30, is one of the sports finest and most colourful talents. France's Champion Apprentice in 1999, he teamed up with the Aga Khan in late 2001 and that association saw him partner the great filly Zarkava to seven straight wins, culminating with the 2008 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. His several Hong Kong G1 successes include Viva Pataca's 2006 Hong Kong Derby and Good Ba Ba's 2008 CX Hong Kong Mile. Now a freelance, France's three-time Champion Jockey (2003, 2005, 2006) captured one of Japan's premier races in 2010, the Tenno Sho (Autumn), aboard Buena Vista. In October, Soumillon rode Cirrus Des Aigles to win the G1 QIPCO Champion Stakes at Ascot and jetted across the Atlantic to partner Sarah Lynx to victory in the following day's G1 Canadian International Stakes.



Starke, Andrasch

Cup – Durban Thunder

Aged 37, Andrasch Starke began race-riding as an amateur at the age of 15. He has now been champion jockey of Germany five times while building an international reputation, having competed successfully in Canada, Dubai, France, Italy, Singapore and the USA, as well as in Hong Kong, where he has twice won the Cathay Pacific International Jockeys' Championship in 2000 & 2005. He has partnered some of Germany's best horses, including Caitano, Elle Danzig, Quijano, Samum, Schiaparelli and Ungaro, and has won every one of his country's G1s, including the Grosser Preis von Baden three times and the Deutsches Derby and Preis de Diana (German Oaks) five times each. Outside Germany his victories include the Gran Premio del Jockey Club (twice), the Oaks D'Italia, the Gran Premio de Milano, and the Singapore Airlines International Cup on Epalo in 2004, the year in which that horse won the World Racing Championship. The summit of his career so far though came this October when he rode the German filly Danedream to a stunning five-length triumph in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. This will be Starke's eighth CXIJC.



Vorster, Barend

Sprint – Rocket Man

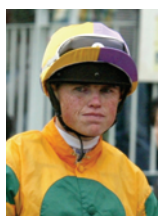
South African-born rider Barend Vorster heads to Hong Kong for the first time to partner Singapore flyer Rocket Man in the G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Sprint. Vorster has a perfect record of six wins from six starts on Patrick Shaw's charge, including a G1 triumph in May's Lion City Cup at Kranji, but he has never before partnered the six-year-old overseas. Singapore's Champion Jockey in 2004, Vorster is stable jockey to Shaw after a long association as the trainer's second rider behind Robbie Fradd.



Whyte, Douglas

Cup – Ambitious Dragon

Douglas Whyte, 40, has been champion jockey in Hong Kong for the last 11 seasons. He is the only jockey ever to reach 1,000 winners in Hong Kong, and now holds the record for HK career wins in 1,345 as at 27 November 2011. On 1 October, with his success aboard Entrapment in the HKG3 Sha Tin Sprint Trophy, Whyte passed the HK\$1 billion mark in prize money won in Hong Kong. Has won several HKG1s on luminaries such as Indigenous, London News, Oriental Express, Packing Winner and Armada, and in 2010 filled what had been virtually the only remaining space in an illustrious Hong Kong CV by winning the Mercedes-Benz Hong Kong Derby on Super Satin. His previous and only CXHKIR success was with former HK Horse of the Year Indigenous in the 1998 Vase.



Williams, Craig

Vase - Dunaden

Born into an Australian racing family Craig Williams, 34, rode his first winner at the age of 16 and his first G1 seven years later in the Australian Oaks. He rode in Britain in 2000 and 2001 partnering 70 winners among them the G1 winning Tobougg. He then moved to Hong Kong and scored over 100 victories here before returning to Australia in 2005 where he has won multiple championships and major races including the Cox Plate and the Golden Slipper. In recent years he has further widened his international scope by riding regularly, and again with G1 success, in Japan. He has had an extraordinary past few months that have led to him being described as 'the hottest jockey in Australia', winning a G1 in Western Australia and probably being prevented only by suspension, which saw him lose the Melbourne Cup mount on Dunaden, from becoming the first man in history to ride the winners of the G1 Caulfield Cup, the G1 Cox Plate and the G1 Melbourne Cup in one year. In addition he failed narrowly to get his mount Tosen Jordan home from gate 16 in the Japan Cup on 27 November.
