## statement of methodology

Strategies 360 conducted a telephone survey of 500 voters in the state of Washington who indicated it was likely they would vote in the November 2012 General Election. 400 of these interviews were determined to be likely to vote in the November 2011 General Election. Interviews were conducted September 11 - September 14, 2011 by American Directions Group of Spokane, Washington, a market research firm specializing in telephone survey interviewing. Respondents were randomly selected from a list of Washington voters, purchased from Voter Contact Services, who registered after the 2010 General Election or voted in either the 2008 or 2010 General Elections.

The margin of error for a survey of 500 interviews is $\pm 4.4 \%$ at the $95 \%$ confidence level. The margin of error for the 400 interview subsample of likely 2011 voters is $\pm 4.9 \%$ at the $95 \%$ confidence level. The margin of error is higher for other subsamples. Other sources of error not accounted for by the stated statistical margin of error include, but are not limited to, question wording, question order, and refusal to be interviewed.

## BANNER DEFINITIONS

PARTY SELF ID (DEM/LEAN) - All respondents who indicated they consider themselves to be a Democrat or an Independent who leans more towards the Democratic Party than the Republican Party.

PARTY SELF ID (GOP/LEAN) - All respondents who indicated they consider themselves to be a Republican or an Independent who leans more towards the Republican Party than the Democratic Party.

PARTY SELF ID (INDY) - All respondents who indicated they consider themselves to be an independent and do not lean towards the Democratic or Republican parties.

REGION (KING CNTY) - All respondents who are registered to vote in King County.

REGION (NORTH PUGET) - All respondents who are registered to vote in Island, San Juan, Skagit, Snohomish, and Whatcom Counties.

REGION (WEST WASH) - All respondents who are registered to vote in Clallam, Clark, Cowlitz, Grays Harbor, Jefferson, Kitsar, Lewis, Mason, Pacific, Pierce, Skamania, Thurston, \& Wahkiakum Counties.

REGION (EAST WASH) - All respondents who are registered to vote in Adams, Asotin, Benton, Chelan, Columbia, Douglas, Ferry, Franklin, Garfield, Grant, Kittitas, Klickitat, Lincoln, Okanogan, Pend Oreille, Spokane, Stevens, Walla Walla, Whitman, and Yakima Counties
