Course of work: After receiving my M.A degree I have been working continuously in the Section of Logic, Institute of Philosophy and Sociology at Polish Academy of Sciences, headed by R. Wojcicki. I was employed there as an assistant since January 2, 1984 and as an adiunkt since December 13, 1989. On August 1, 1997 I received there a permanent research position of docent (Associate Professor). Due to the fact that from 1995 Torun become my permanent place of stay, I closely cooperate with Department of Logic and Semiotics, Nicolaus Copernicus University in Torun. Since 1996 I have been working there as an adiunkt and since 2006 as professor.

My research until becoming Ph.D. degree have been held in the main stream of ideas coming from the heritage of Lvov-Warsaw School of Logic determined by achievement of papers by Tarski, Lukasiewicz, Lindenbaum and Wajsberg in the subject of sentential logic and the theory of consequence operation (extensively elaborated by Rasiowa, Sikorski, Los, Suszko and Wojcicki). A special attention has been there paid on algebraic methods of logic.

My current research interests are concentrated on cognitive problems of the borderline of logic,

computer sciences and social psychology. The most important among them are research on logical systems for Artificial Intelligence and Logical Pragmatics, in particular: nonmonotonic logic, semantic investigations on preferential and cumulative models, logical theory of argumentation and persuasion, theory of speech acts.

Main subjects of research (from current to former):

A. logical foundations of computer sciences, nonmonotonic logics, cognitive logic: logical theory of argumentation and persuasion, speech acts theory.

B. logic of quantum mechanics, intensional logics.

C. algebraic logic, theory of logical consequence.

Main projects (accomplished or still under realization)

Studia Logica. This is the most important of all of my scientific activities. Studia Logica and International Journal for Symbolic Logic is one of the most acknowledged logical journals. It appears 9 times per year and is published by Springer. Since 1996 I am responsible for the day-by-day activities of the journal and since 2006 I am an Editor-in-Chief of Studia Logica. All the editorial works are decentralized. Seven internationally acknowledged logicians from USA, Italy New Zealand, Japan, Australia and Poland undertake the procedure of evaluation of papers submitted to the Journal on his hands. I act as one of the editors, but my main activity is to coordinate the work of the whole editorial board. Studia Logica lead an active editorial policy initiating special monothematic issues concerning especially interesting very actual matters. Initiating monothematic issues and coordinating of all the work concerning them are the most important and hardest of my duties. Till the present time, under my redaction appeared more than 50 volumes of the journal, among them 20 had monothematic character.
