that enabled her to provide for and successfully parent her family despite challenging health issues. CHOISS stands for Community Housing Options at Independent Sites, a Serra Project program designed to allow destitute individuals dealing with HIV/AIDS and a secondary diagnosis to live on their

own, mapping out an individualized service plan of short and long-term objectives with the ongoing help of staff and a case manager. Her children proudly watched as she spoke at the podium.
