


## Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

<u>Architectural</u>: 1917/1918. Surviving rifle range was originally one of eight similar structures, all of which were aligned along the west bank of the River Pinn. It consists of the brick butt with brick buttresses at 11ft centres (9-bays) and the firing shelter at 25 yards distance.

<u>Historical</u>: Associated with the Battle of Britain and the military history of Uxbridge.
