*Missouri Vineyards* and *Brioche Dorée Café* are located in the Main Terminal, pre-security on the ticketing level. They are ideal concepts to welcome travelers, meters/greeters and other visitors at the airport.

"The side by side proximity of these concepts is a bonus. We've used the French history of St. Louis and long-standing wine production in this region to create a true sense of place at the airport," said HMSHost Vice President of Business Development, Stephen Douglas. "HMSHost and our partners, D&D Concessions, are pleased to open these new brands to enhance the airport experience and welcome travelers to Lambert-St. Louis International Airport."

Founded by two Frenchmen—Pierre LaClede and August Chouteau—St. Louis and its surrounding region have produced wine from America's heartland for more than 160 years. In the 1960s, several original area wineries reopened and today, Missouri's wine industry is thriving. Now, *Missouri Vineyards* offers travelers the luxury of a wine tasting opportunity at the airport. Local boutique vineyards and award-winning varietals such as Cynthiana and Norton anchor the selection list. The menu includes small bites such as Smoked Salmon, Jumbo Shrimp Skewer and Cheese & Fruit Plates. Delicious soups, salads, and sandwiches, such as Lime Chicken Brie, Asian Fusion Salmon and Sliders 3 Way—all designed to complement the featured wines. Every Thursday of the month, Missouri Vineyards will offer wine tastings.

Right next door to the wine bar, **Brioche Dorée Café** offers an upscale, quick and casual authentic venue set in a country French atmosphere that features the aroma of fresh bread and pastry in the oven. Guests may enjoy an array of hand made sandwiches, healthy garden salads, artisan breads, gourmet pastries and custom roasted coffees.

"These are exciting times for the HMSHost D&D Concessions, LLC Partnership. We have the opportunity to share Director Hrabko's vision of creating a new airport experience for our travelers and promoting our great city by bringing local food and flavor to travelers," said Darryl Jones Managing Partner of D&D Concessions, LLC.
