May I first welcome you all to another season of Grade Cricket.

The WA District Cricket Council (Inc.) has undergone major changes and this season we have moved to a new format which separates the One Day League games from the two day games. The emphasis is to provide more games in the longer format so that we can better prepare our players for playing the long form of the game, as well as to give them a better chance to improve their standards ready for higher forms of cricket.

We have undertaken to review and change, where necessary, the District Cricket Rules and emphasising the need to play more overs and good cricket. We have streamlined the reporting process of player infringements and taken away the prosecuting role from the umpires and transferred it to a Disciplinary Committee.

The appointment of four Cricket Observers who will have the task of providing reports on good players from the District level to the Warriors Match committee will be a positive step in linking the next tier of players playing District Cricket with the Selectors.

These are among only a few changes that we have undertaken. I am sure there will be a few shortcomings in the Rules and we will endeavour to correct these as they come to hand.

I want to thank all the Clubs for their co-operation in getting all these changes in place and I sincerely hope they are for the betterment of the Game of Cricket.

Good luck to all of you and please make sure that you enjoy your Cricket. It is a game we all love.

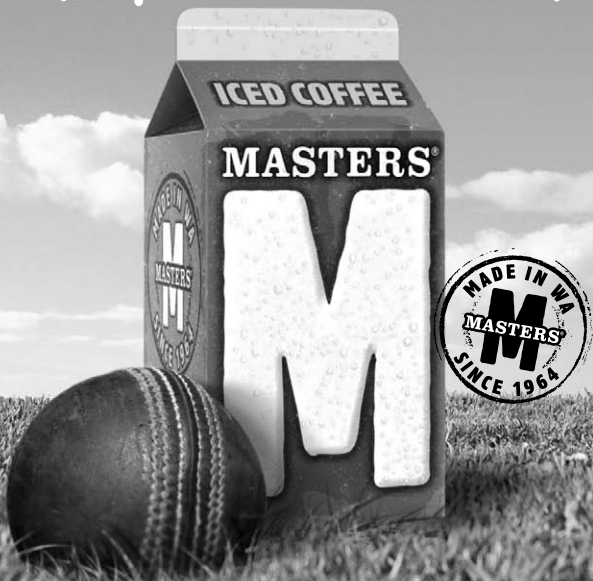

## WACA JUNIOR COMPETITIONS - PLAYING CONDITIONS SYNOPSIS

### UNDER 17 & UNDER 15

#### TWO DAY MATCHES

- 60 overs to be bowled. If they are bowled before time, stumps will be drawn and the innings compulsorily closed. 60 overs to be bowled on Day 2.
- Target overs not bowled on time: Target overs not bowled on time - finish the over in progress and then stumps will be drawn. Penalties apply if warranted. The number of overs bowled on Day 1 becomes the number of overs to be bowled on Day 2.
- Side batting first dismissed: Side batting first is dismissed - if time permits, the team batting second must start their innings. This side is entitled to receive 60 overs of Day 2 in addition to what they faced on Day 1.
- Delay or interruption to play: If there is a delay or interruption to play - target overs reduced. The reduced total is now the number of overs that both sides will face. If the reduced number of overs have been completed with time remaining on Day 1 stumps will be drawn and the same number of overs will be bowled on Day 2.

#### DAY TWO SCENARIOS

- Target overs not bowled on time: Play continues until NO LATER THAN 12.10pm and then stumps must be drawn at this time. Penalties will apply if warranted.
- Delay or interruption (overs reduced): If reduced number of overs are bowled before time then play continues.
- Delay or interruption (overs reduced): If the side batting second is NOT dismissed and they have not reached the score of the side batting first, then the match will be declared a draw.

- Days 1 and 2 - delay or interruption exceeds 60 minutes: Ordinary conditions.
- Day 1 is washed out without any play: Day 2 becomes a one-day match.
- One five minute on field break and one 15 minute off-field tea break shall be taken.

- First Innings: Compulsory declaration after 30 overs or at 10.15am - WHICHEVER OCCURS FIRST.
- Second Innings: If 30 overs were not bowled by 10.15am, the side batting second will receive the same number of overs as the side batting first.
- First Innings - Team batting first dismissed: If the side batting first is dismissed prior to facing 30 overs, the side batting second faces a minimum of 30 overs and the innings will continue beyond that point if time permits.

Two 5-minute drinks breaks shall be taken.

### UNDER 14 & UNDER 13

Under 14 matches consist of 45 overs per side or equal number of overs if 45 overs is not bowled in time to the side batting first.

Under 13 matches consist of 40 overs per side or equal number if 40 is not bowled to the side batting first.

If the side batting first is dismissed, then the side batting second faces no more than the allocated 45/40 overs.

If 14 overs is delivered to the side batting second, a result will be determined on the day.

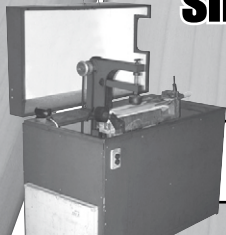
