[HARRY WIDENER] Male, 27. Harvard graduate and heir to one of the wealthiest fortunes in Philadelphia, Harry is a noted RARE BOOK COLLECTOR and business man returning home aboard the Titanic with his parents. He is UNASSUMING BUT GOOD-LOOKING, INTELLIGENT, and SOMEWHAT SHY preferring the company of a good book. EFFORTLESSLY CHARMING: Think ROBERT REDFORD in "BAREFOOT IN THE PARK". He is UNCOMFORTABLE with the CLASS SYSTEM. Aboard the ship, he finds himself deeply attracted to GEORGIANA, the REBELLIOUS and FIERCELY INDEPENDENT daughter of an English Earl. Normally these two would be the wrong fit, but there is something that can't help but draw these two together. When the ship begins sinking, he acts COURAGEOUSLY, with DECISIVENESS and ACTION. [ROCCO JENSON] Mid 20s, tough, sarcastic, Rocco works at the body shop which specializes in customized, tricked out cars (like those used for drug / arms dealers).
