- (6) A slice of the BIG Periodic Table Cake!

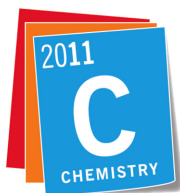
The day will run from 11:00 AM - 3:00 PM, food from 11:00 AM - 2:00 PM.
