

Minnesota RollerGirls, L.L.C. was established August 31, 2004 and is skater owned and operated.

The Minnesota RollerGirls have been playing in regional and national bouts and tournaments since February 2006.

The Minnesota RollerGirls is part of the Women's Flat Track Derby Association (WFTDA).

The Minnesota RollerGirls league is comprised of 80 women divided in four teams: Atomic Bombshells, Dagger Dolls, Garda Belts and Rockits.

Every Minnesota RollerGirls bout has a sell-out, capacity crowd of just over 4,000 at Legendary Roy Wilkins Auditorium in St. Paul, MN.

Proceeds from every bout go towards local charities in the Twin Cities area.

The Minnesota RollerGirls was founded by Mary Donnelly – a.k.a. Head Trauma – who read about the Texas roller derby league in *Jane Magazine*.

Mary Donnelly's sisters – Bridget Donnelly a.k.a. Rolls Wilder and Molly Donnelly a.k.a. Flogging Molly – became co-founders after the three traveled to watch the Texas league in the summer of 2004.

The Minnesota RollerGirls skate on quad speed skates and are required to wear a protective helmet, mouth guard and knee, elbow and wrist pads.

The Minnesota RollerGirls outer track is 90' from tip to tip and 63'6" from side to side and takes 520 feet of rope light on the inner and outer tracks.

Live music is provided at Minnesota RollerGirls events and bouts by Minnesota-based bands and DJs. A few that have played for the Minnesota RollerGirls include: Alpenrose, Spitting Cobras, Landing Gear, Blame, Anchorhead, Zibra Zibra, Dance Band, and E. L. No.
