Junior:

Member of Russian National Team that won the Youth European and World Championships in

2005, in the same year was crowned Champion of Europe in the under-14 years grade, as well as winning silver and bronze as a National Team member in the European Winter and Summer Championships respectively at under-16. In 2007 was a member of the Russian Junior Fed Cup team which finished 9th in the World, her personal record was 2-2 in Singles and 2-1 in Doubles. In 2008 was a member of the Russian Students Team which took Gold in the World Student Games in Belgrade, the same year reached the Australian Open Junior Doubles semi-final and ranked in the World top-40.

Senior:

Apart from ITF professional successes has won Bronze medals in the Moscow Winter Championships (Singles and Doubles) in 2009, later winning a Gold medal in the Russian Championships. This year has won Silver medals in the Moscow Championships and Gold in the "Cup of Russia" Doubles tournament. Marta began 2011 with a bang in Bath, beating the top seed on way to capturing the AEGON Pro Series \$10k title, while in the tougher \$25k event the following week she beat 2 higher ranked players to make the main draw where she destroyed former World top-20 star Anna-Lena Groenefeld.

Personal:

Marta is completing her studies at the Moscow Institute for Sports and Fitness Studies, she is funded by a sports-academic scholarship from the Yeltsin Fund. As well as her native Russian she speaks English and Spanish, having attended the Spanish Immersion High School in Moscow. She has one older brother. She prefers playing on hardcourt surfaces, her favourite and most comfortable surface is grass.
