Sir Anthony was educated at Eton and the Royal Military Academy Sandhurst being commissioned into the 4th/7th Royal Dragoon Guards in 1956. An abbreviated service history includes: Regimental service as part of the British Army of the Rhine (BAOR) 1956-58; Aide-de-Camp to Commander 1st British Corps 1958-60; Adjutant 1962-65; Staff College 1967; Ministry of Defence 1968-70; Regimental service 1970-72; Brigade Major 1972-73; Directing Staff - Staff College 1973-76; Commanding Officer 4th/7th Dragoon Guards BAOR 1976-78; Headquarters BAOR 1978-80; Commander 7th Armoured Brigade 1980-82. Sir Anthony then held a number of positions within the Ministry of Defence, retiring from service as the Deputy Chief of Defence Staffs (Systems) in 1992.
