## HAT WITH EAR FLAPS

Designed for Oxfam by: Tina Egleton

## Measurements

To fit small-medium (medium to large) head.

## Materials

$2 \times 50 \mathrm{~g}$ balls of double knitting yarn in one colour or equivalent amount for multicoloured option. No. 8 (4 mm) knitting needles.

## Tension

22 stitches and 30 rows to $10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ over stocking stitch, using No. 8 (4 $\mathrm{mm})$ needles.

## Abbreviations

K, knit; p, purl; st, stitch; tog, together; inc, increase (by working twice into same st); dec, decrease (by taking 2 sts tog); up1, pick up loop lying between needles and $k$ into the back of it; ss, stocking st ( $k$ on right side and $p$ on wrong side).

## Plain hat

## Right ear flap

** With No. 8 (4 mm) needles, cast on 5 sts. K 3 rows.
Increase row: K2, up1, k to last 2 sts, up1, k2.
Repeat increase row, twice more. K 1 row, then work increase row.
Repeat last 2 rows, 4 (5) times more -21 (23) sts. K 18 (20) rows.**
K 1 row, casting on 12 (13) sts at beginning of this -33 (36) sts.
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Break off yarn and leave these sts on a st-holder.

## Left ear flap

Work as right ear flap from ** to **. K 1 row, turn and cast on 12 (13) sts - 33 (36) sts.

Joining row: K across left ear flap, cast on 28 (32) sts, then $k$ across right ear flap - 94 (104) sts. K 5 rows. ***

Inc row: K6 (7), inc, [k8 (9), inc] 9 times, k6 - 104 (114) sts. Beginning with a p row, ss 29 (35) rows.

Shape top: $1^{\text {st }}$ dec row: K13 (8), k2tog, [k11 (10), k2tog] 6 (8) times, k11 (8) - 97 (105) sts. Ss 3 rows.
$2^{\text {nd }}$ dec row: K1, [k2tog, k10 (11)] 8 times. Ss 3 rows.
$3^{\text {rd }}$ dec row: K1, [k2tog, k9 (10)] 8 times. P 1 row.
$4^{\text {th }}$ row: K1, [k2tog, k8 (9)] 8 times. P 1 row.
$5^{\text {th }}$ dec row: K1, [k2tog, k7 (8)] 8 times.
Continue dec 8 sts in this way, dec 8 sts on every alternate row until 17 sts remain. Next dec row: [P2tog] 8 times, p1.

Next dec row: K1, [k2tog] 4 times - 5 sts. Ss 5 rows.
Break off yarn, leaving a long end. Thread end through remaining sts, pull up tightly and fasten off. Join back seam.

Ties (make 2): Cut yarn into eighteen 50 cm lengths. Fold 9 lengths in half and attach folded end at centre of cast on edge on each ear flap. Divide lengths into three parts and plait. Secure plaited ends and trim.

## Multi coloured hat

Work as plain hat to ***. Working in 2-row or 4-row or 6-row stripes, complete as plain hat. Using all colours, make ties as on plain hat.
