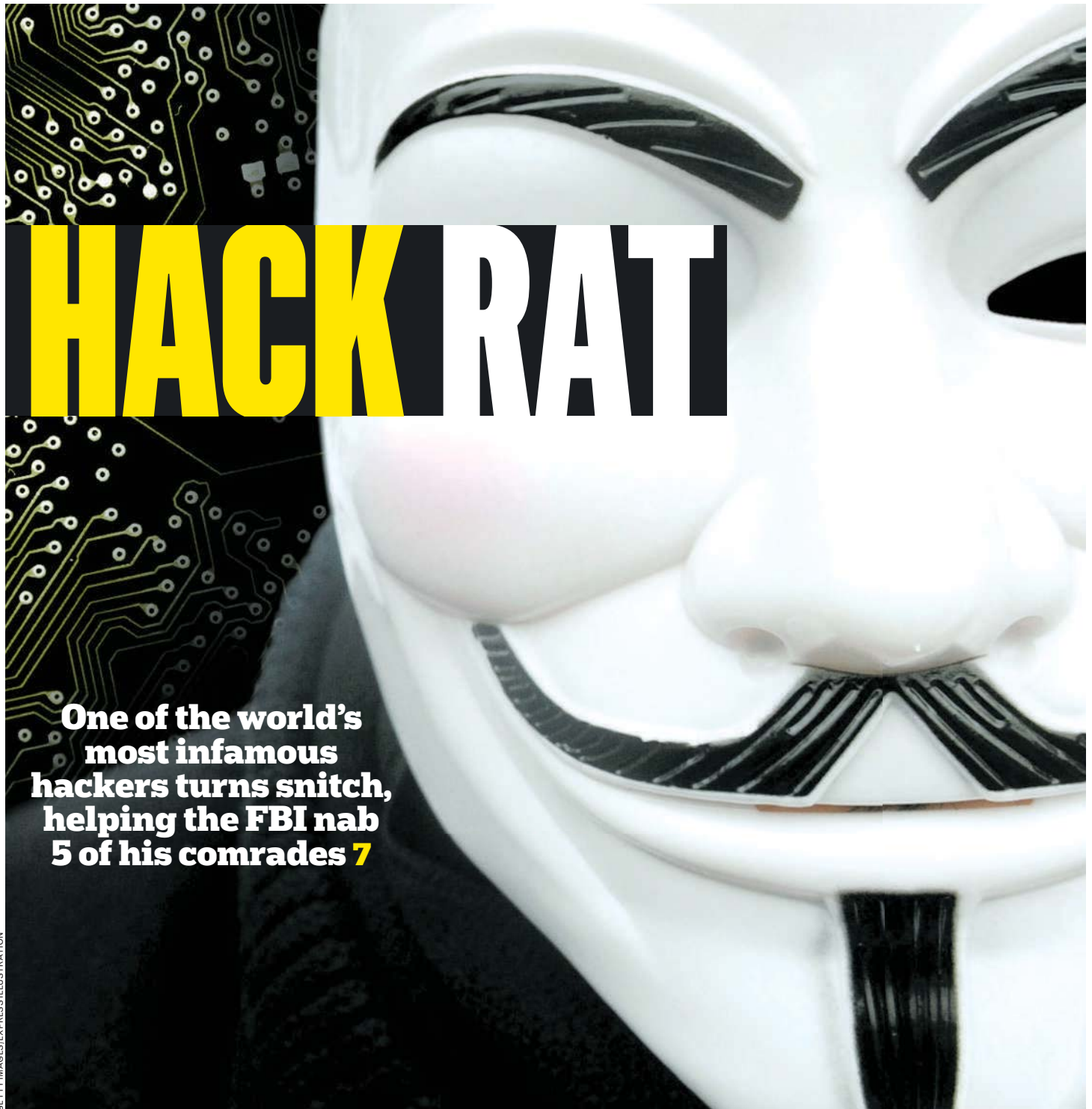

poll — a sobering reminder for the party that the extended primary season has damaged the brand. Among independent voters, who are widely seen as the critical swing voting bloc in the fall election, none of the four candidates is regarded favorably by even 40 percent of the sample.

Texas Rep. Ron Paul does best with a 38 percent favorable rating and a 35 percent unfavorable rating. Former Massachusetts governor Mitt Romney, the frontrunner in the race, clocks in at a dismal 32

percent favorable score, 16 points lower than the 48 percent of independents who see him in an unfavorable light. Ditto former Pennsyl-

vania senator Rick Santorum who is viewed favorably by just three in 10 independents.

That looks positively outstanding when compared with the 21 percent of independents who view former House Speaker Newt Gingrich favorably. (Gingrich's favorability among Democrats is 11 percent with 73 percent viewing him unfavorably.)

These numbers — like all poll

numbers — are a snapshot in time. But, they reflect the fact that the recent debates within the Republican presidential primary are hurting — not helping — the GOP's chances of regaining the White House in the fall.

Dow Drops 203 Points, Interrupting 2012 Rally

New York

Stocks suffered their biggest losses in three months Tuesday, the first hiccup in a strong and steady rally to start the year. Wall Street worried about the global economy and waited while Greece pressured the last investors to sign on for its bailout.

The Dow Jones industrial average fell 203.66 points, giving up more than a quarter of its 745-point advance since Jan. 1, the best start to a year in the U.S. market since 1998.

"When things go straight up and don't ever correct or have some sort of normal pullback, as an investor, that makes me nervous," said Ed Hyland, a global investment specialist with J.P. Morgan Private Bank.

The gradual rally had been powered by optimism about the U.S. economic recovery. But investors realized that Greece's debt problems, Europe's economic problems and Israel's Iran problems were still very much their problems, too.

Backstory

The stock market's Tuesday sell-off, which spread west from Europe, also interrupted a period of unusual calm on Wall Street. Before Tuesday, the Dow had not fallen 100 points for 45-straight trading sessions, the longest streak since 2006. The decline of 203.66 points was the worst for the Dow since Nov. 23 and left the average at 12,759.15. It was only last week that the Dow closed above 13,000 for the first time since May 2008, four months before the worst of the financial crisis. (AP)

All 10 industry groups in the Standard & Poor's 500 declined. Bank stocks, which typically take a hit when there is any reason to worry about Greece, led the declines, followed by industrial and materials companies, which depend on strength in the world economy.

The Standard & Poor's 500 index fell 20.97 points. The Nasdaq composite index dropped 40.16 points. JOSHUA FREED (AP)

Financier Convicted in \$7B Fraud

Houston

Former Texas tycoon R. Allen Stanford, whose financial empire once spanned the Americas and made him fabulously wealthy, was convicted Tuesday of bilking his investors

out of more than \$7 billion through a Ponzi scheme he operated for 20 years. A day after telling U.S. District Judge David Hittner they were having trouble reaching a verdict, jurors convicted Stanford on 13 of 14 charges he faced, acquitting him on a single count of wire fraud stemming from Super Bowl tickets he allegedly used to bribe

a regulator.

Prosecutors and Stanford's family members declined to comment, but one of his investors, Cassie Wilkinson, welcomed the verdict.

"As an investor, you have to doubt whether or not you were stupid or just taken advantage of. This relieves that doubt. It's a vindication," said Wilkinson, 62, who lives in Houston.

Stanford, 61, faces up to 20 years in prison for the most serious charges against him. But if Hittner orders him to serve his sentences consecutively, Stanford could get up to 230 years in prison. Disgraced financier Bernard Madoff, by comparison, was sentenced to 150 years in prison for orchestrating the largest Ponzi scheme in history. (AP)

Nuke Talks With Iran to Resume

Obama: Diplomacy, not military action, can still resolve spat

Washington

Alarmed by rising talk of war, the United States, Europe and other world powers announced Tuesday that bargaining will begin again with Iran over its fiercely disputed nuclear efforts.

In Washington, President Obama declared he had been working to avert war with Iran during meetings with Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu this week. Israel, fearing the prospect of a nuclear Iran, has stressed a need for possible military action, but Obama said sanctions and diplomacy were already working.

Obama, at his first news conference this year, spoke for capitals around the world in warning that “bluster” and posturing to appear tough on Iran could edge the world closer to an avoidable war.

Tehran invited U.N. inspectors to see a site suspected of housing secret atomic weapons work, announcing on Tuesday it will grant long-sought access to its Parchin military complex southeast of Tehran. Still, Iran has a history of agreeing to talks or other concessions when it feels under threat, and Western leaders have grown skeptical that Iran will bargain in good faith. (AP)

erine Ashton said that the five permanent members of the U.N. Security Council — the U.S., Britain, France, Russia and China —

and Germany had agreed to a new round of nuclear talks with Iran more than a year after suspending them in frustration.

The rush to diplomacy was partly an answer to increasingly hawkish rhetoric from Israel, which is considering a military strike on Iranian nuclear facilities this spring. Obama and Western allies say such a strike would be risky and premature, and that there is still time to convince Iran that it is better off without nuclear weapons.

In Washington, Obama said he saw a “window of opportunity” to use diplomacy instead of military force to resolve the dispute.

Britain’s foreign secretary, William Hague, said the onus would “be on Iran to convince the international community that its nuclear program is exclusively peaceful.”

German Foreign Minister Guido Westerwelle called for a diplomatic solution. “A nuclear-armed Iran must be prevented,” he said.

Iran insists that its program is only for energy production and other peaceful purposes. The negotiations between Iran and the bloc would resume at a “mutually convenient time and date,” Ashton said.

With his brother Richard, Sherman composed scores for Disney films including “The Jungle Book” and “Mary Poppins,” and penned the song “It’s a Small World (After All).” (AP)

Putin Rejects Protests Over Election Victory

Vladimir Putin rejected opposition protests against his presidential election victory, and his foreign ministry ruled out any softening of Moscow’s stance on Syria, strong indications Tuesday that the Russian prime minister has no intention of easing tough policies either at home or abroad. (AP)

BENGAZI, LIBYA

Eastern Officials Declare Semiautonomous Area

Tribal leaders and militia commanders declared eastern Libya a semiautonomous state on Tuesday, a move that Mustafa Abdul-Jalil, the interim head of state, called a “dangerous” conspiracy by Arab nations to tear the country apart six months after Moammar Gadhafi’s fall. But officials from the east said it was not intended to divide Libya. (AP)

BEIRUT

Assad Vows to Fight On

Syrian President Bashar Assad defied mounting international pressure to end the year-old crackdown on an uprising against him and said Tuesday he was determined to go on fighting what he called “foreign-backed terrorism.” Meanwhile, troops shelled a village in Daraa, as the regime’s crackdown turned to southern Daraa province, where the uprising began a year ago. (AP)

Karzai Backs Strict Guidelines for Women

Move is a step back for Afghanistan, rights activists say

Kabul, Afghanistan

Afghanistan's president on Tuesday endorsed a "code of conduct" issued by an influential council of clerics that activists say represents a giant step backward for women's rights in the country.

President Hamid Karzai's

remarks backing the Ulema Council's document, which allows husbands to beat wives under certain circumstances and encourages segregation of the sexes, is seen as part of his outreach to insurgents.

Both the U.S. and Karzai hope that the Taliban can be brought into negotiations to end the country's decade-long war. But activists say they're worried that gains made by women since 2001 may be lost in the process.

Among the "code of conduct"

Backstory

When the Taliban ruled Afghanistan prior to the 2001 U.S. invasion, girls were banned from going to school, and women had to wear burqas that covered them from head to toe. Women also were not allowed to leave their homes without a male relative as an escort. But the Afghan constitution as it now stands provides equal rights for men and women. (AP)

rules: Women should not travel without a male guardian or mingle with strange men in such places as markets or offices.

Women's activists say that Karzai's endorsement means that existing or planned laws aimed at protecting women's rights may be sacrificed for peace negotiations.

"It sends a really frightening message that women can expect to get sold out in this process," said Heather Barr of New York-based Human Rights Watch. (AP)

A Leak of Their Own

Thanks to a hacker turned snitch, the FBI charges 5 others with online crimes

New York

The shadowy underworld of Internet hackers was rocked by news Tuesday that one of the world's most-wanted and most-feared computer vandals has been an FBI informant for months and helped authorities build a case against five alleged comrades.

The FBI said it captured the legendary hacker known as "Sabu" last June, and he turned out to be Hector Xavier Monsegur, 28, a self-taught computer programmer.

His exploits made him a hero to some in cyberspace until he made a rookie mistake — he posted something online without cloaking his IP address, or computer identity — and someone tipped off the FBI.

Soon after his arrest, he pleaded guilty and began spilling secrets, leading to charges Tuesday against five people in Europe and the U.S. for conspiracy to commit computer hacking, and preventing more than 300 attacks along the way, authorities said.

Law enforcement officials said it marked the first time core members of the loosely organized worldwide hacking group Anonymous have been identified and charged in the U.S.

Investigators said Monsegur and the other defendants were all associated with the group, and some were also part of the elite spin-off organization that Monsegur formed last May, Lulz Security or LulzSec.

Who is 'Sabu'?

Hector Xavier Monsegur, 28, is an unemployed, self-taught computer programmer with no college education and is a welfare recipient in New York. He took his Internet name from Sabu the Elephant Boy, a pro-wrestler in the 1980s and 1990s who espoused anti-government, anti-capitalist ideologies, Fox News said. (EXPRESS/AP)

"Lulz" is Internet slang for "laughs."

The defendants were accused in court papers of hacking into corporations and government agencies around the world, including the U.S. Senate; filching confidential information; defacing websites; and temporarily putting victims out of business. Officials said their crimes affected more than 1 million people.

Prosecutors said that among other things, the hackers, with Monsegur as their ringleader, disrupted websites belonging to Visa, Mastercard and Paypal in 2010 and 2011 because the companies refused to accept donations to WikiLeaks, the organization that spilled a trove of U.S. military and diplomatic secrets.

But it was the arrest of Monsegur that sent shock waves through the Anonymous movement, where many described him as one of the group's most skilled hackers.

Monsegur pleaded guilty in August to charges that included conspiracy to commit hacking, admitting he obtained dozens of credit card numbers online and gave them to others or used them to pay his bills.

His deal with prosecutors requires his full cooperation and testimony at any trial. In return, he gets leniency from a potential prison sentence of more than 120 years. He is free on \$50,000 bail.

Barrett Brown, a former journalist who became closely associated with Anonymous, said Sabu's cooperation with the FBI could do serious damage to Anonymous.

"He was an admired Anon," Brown said. "He's been a leader. People came to him with information. God knows what else he told them." LARRY NEUMEISTER AND RAPHAEL SATTER (AP)

The international hacking group LulzSec existed for 50 days in 2011. Targets of the group known for its high-profile attacks, sarcasm and mustached, top-hatted logo included entertainment companies, and state and federal agencies.

MAY 2011

LulzSec arrives on Twitter and leaks what it says is a database of contestants on the show "The X Factor."

MAY 30

LulzSec breaks into the website of PBS and posts a fake story saying rappers Tupac Shakur and Biggie Smalls are alive.

JUNE 2

The hackers attack Sony Pictures Entertainment, posting the usernames, passwords, email addresses and phone numbers of tens of thousands of people.

JUNE 10

LulzSec leaks what it says is a database of email addresses and passwords of pornography website users.

JUNE 13

LulzSec says it has stolen information from 200,000 video game users. The hackers also attack the U.S. Senate website.

JUNE 20

The group claims responsibility for taking down the website of the U.K.'s Serious Organized Crime Agency. Game company Sega is hit with an attack that breaches 1.3 million users' information.

JUNE 25

LulzSec says it is quitting its attacks in its final release of hacked data. (THE WASHINGTON POST)

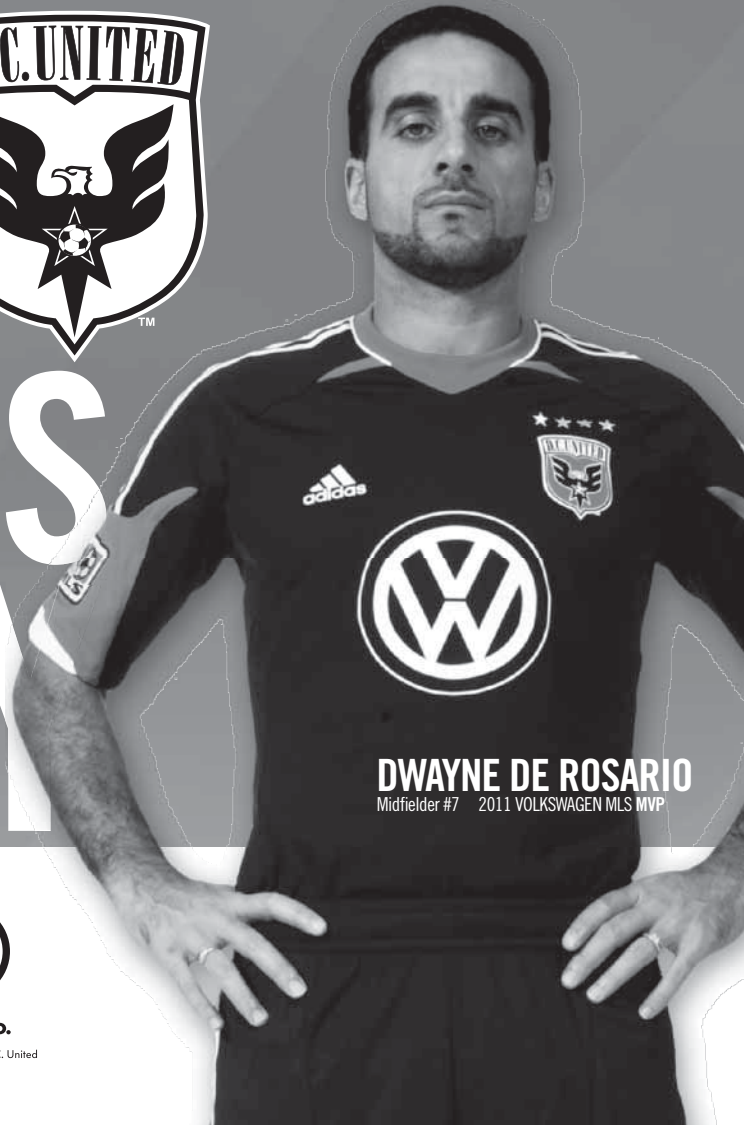
The five safest stations were Arlington Cemetery, Clarendon, Eisenhower Avenue, Farragut West and Virginia Sq.-GMU. The report is scheduled to be presented to Metro board members on Thursday. Metro overall had a 16 percent decline in serious incidents in 2011 compared with a six-year high recorded in 2010. (AP)

The Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority released the new figure Tuesday, as it prepares to issue a request for proposals on bids to build the second part of the 23-mile stretch of new Metrorail line.

The first phase of the project is under construction and will run

from Tysons Corner to Reston. It is expected to be finished in August 2013 but could be as much as \$150 million over budget.

engineers to make better estimates, MWA officials said.

The new, \$2.7 billion cost assumes that Loudoun and Fairfax counties will pay for construction of five parking garages and the Route 28 station. If the two counties don't pay for that portion, the cost of the project would rise to \$3.1 billion.

D.C. OKs Bill to Ease Gay Divorce

Washington

D.C. Council members have given final approval to a bill to make it easier for gay and lesbian couples who marry in Washington to get divorced if they so choose.

The bill, which was approved on Tuesday, would allow gay couples who get married in the District of Columbia to get divorced even if they aren't living in the city — provided they live somewhere that would not recognize their divorce. Under current law, one member of the divorcing couple has to live in the District for six months before opening divorce proceedings.

The District began issuing mar-

riage licenses to same-sex couples in March 2010.

The bill now goes to Mayor Vin-

cent Gray for his signature.

The council also gave preliminary approval to a bill that would roll back some rules for possessing a gun in the District of Columbia.

The changes in the bill include eliminating a vision test as well as ballistics testing and a ban on some types of ammunition.

Rules about gun ownership in Washington are still being adjusted as a result of the 2008 Supreme Court decision that ended a 32-year-old handgun ban in the nation's capital.

The bill approved Tuesday does not change registration requirements. It will get a final vote before being sent to the mayor. (AP)

Officials Unveil Md. 'Doomsday' Budget Plan

Annapolis, Md.

Maryland analysts have outlined nearly \$800 million in additional cuts to fill budget gaps in case lawmakers can't agree on new taxes or savings.

Warren Deschenaux, director of the state's Office of Policy Analysis, presented a variety of cuts Tuesday that would affect education, health, environmental programs and state agencies. It's being described as a "doomsday" budget plan. Maryland is trying to reduce an ongoing structural budget deficit of about \$1.1 billion by half. (AP)

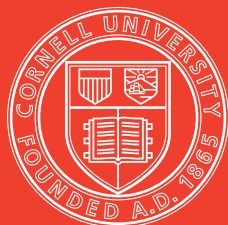

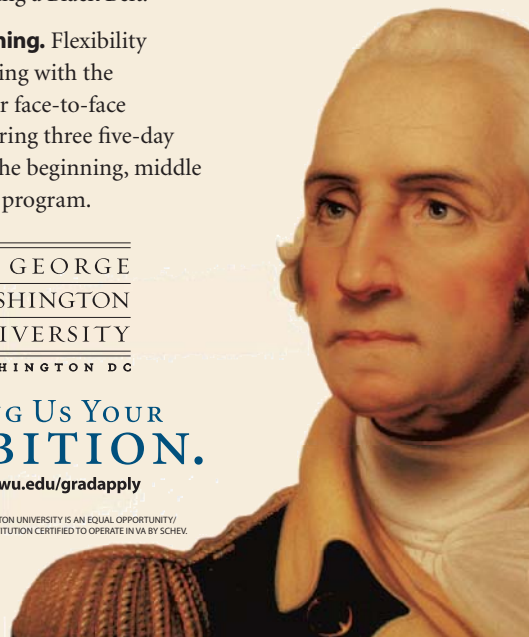

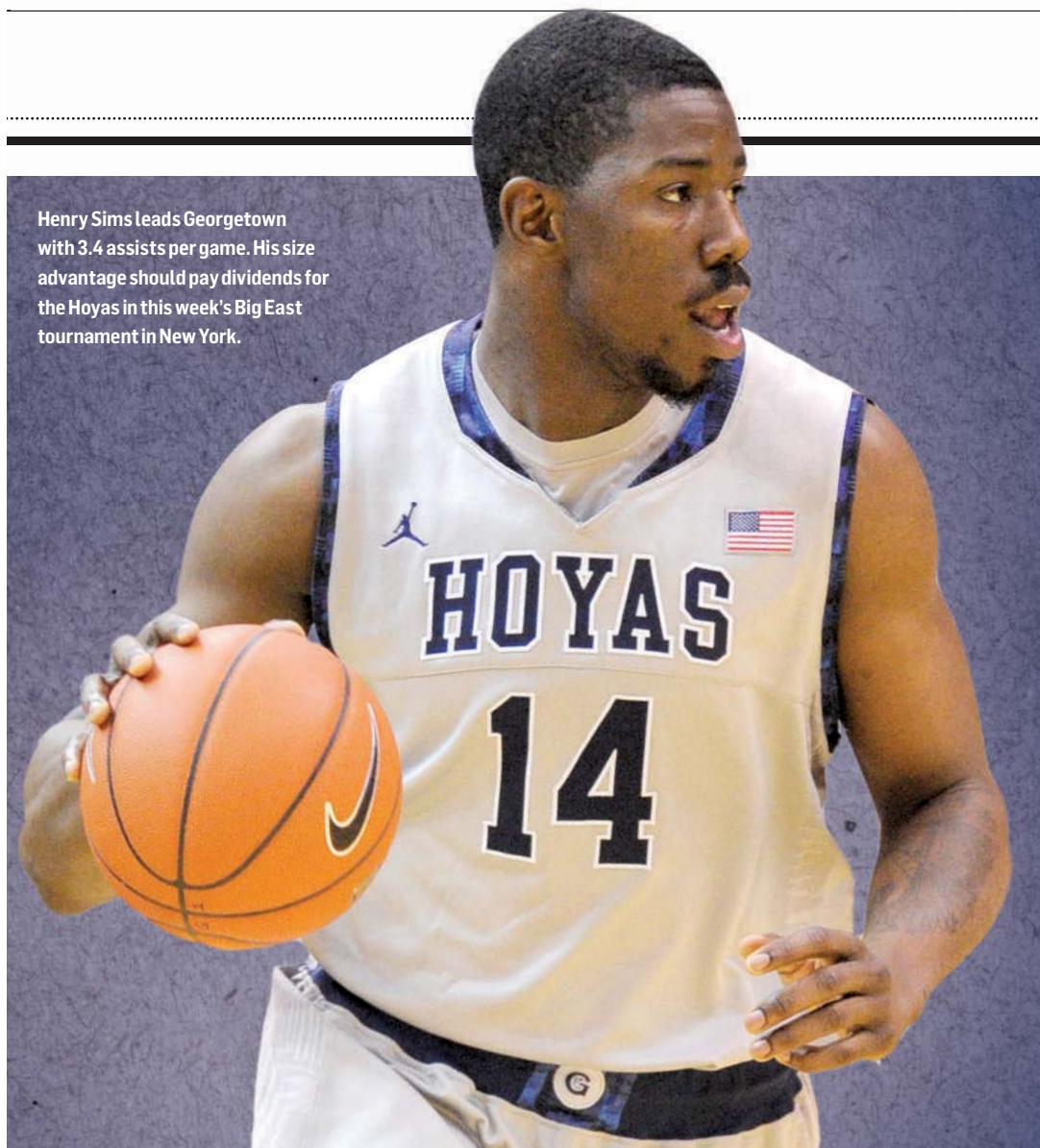

Georgetown builds its offense around its senior center's ability to pass

Hoyas Hoops

If college basketball were poker, Georgetown would be one of those teams that opponents dread seeing on the other side of the table.

No matter what hand their foes are holding, the Hoyas typically have an answer — whether it's their depth, length, versatility or schemes. It's that versatility, created by a uniquely skilled roster, that the No. 13 Hoyas (22-7, 12-6 in the Big East) hope to ride deep into this week's Big East tournament.

Having earned a first-round



bye, fifth-seeded Georgetown will face Pittsburgh, which defeated St. John's on Tuesday, in Wednesday's second round.

"They were more talented last year, but it's a much better team this year," South Florida coach Stan Heath said after Georgetown's 30-point smackdown over his Bulls on Feb. 4. "Their length bothers you. They have a lot of different weapons."

"That's a unique team that he's the leading assist guy. I've never really seen anything like it, but they really play well off him."

While senior Jason Clark and junior Hollis Thompson are Georgetown's top scorers, 6-foot-10 center Henry Sims is an ace up the team's sleeve.

Sims' size and position on the floor have made him a key cog in the offense. The senior, who improved from 3.6 points per game

last season to this year's 11.1 average, is as much a threat with his passing as he is with his scoring. Many have referred to Sims — who averages a team-high 3.4 assists per game — as Georgetown's point guard on a roster that doesn't really have one.

Marquette coach Buzz Williams, whose No. 9 Golden Eagles earned a season-split with the Hoyas with an 83-69 win on Saturday, drew a favorable comparison between Sims and former Georgetown big man Greg Monroe, who was known as a great passer.

"In our preparation, I thought he was the key to their game," Williams said of Sims. "Everything runs through him, regardless of whether he catches it on the block or whether he catches it at the elbow."

With Clark and Thompson showing their range from outside, Sims gives the Hoyas a full house with his presence and versatility in the paint.

"That's what we need him to do," Georgetown coach John Thompson III said. "The balance between when is it his turn to score and when is it his turn to get his teammates the shot, for most of the year, with a few glaring exceptions, he's been very good at that balance." KRISTINA LUCIDO

If another podcast is created today, it's not going to impede the enjoyment of your favorite podcast tomorrow. But if, suddenly, comedians stopped making podcasts, it'd be a sign to me that the medium is dying — not thriving.

With her latest movie, 'Friends With Kids,' Jennifer Westfeldt again skirts convention

Personalities

"First of all, I'm an Aquarius."

Jennifer Westfeldt is only half-joking in explaining how she came to be a combatant of convention. In the past 10 years, she has written and starred in three films, each of which takes the anxiety of a particular passage of adulthood — dating, marrying, parenting — and comically, candidly pursues them from an untraditional perspective.

In 2002's "Kissing Jessica Stein," the film that catapulted Westfeldt to chic indie status, her character tires of men who call themselves "self-defecating" and gives lesbianism a shot.

Five years later, in "Ira & Abby," she played a twice-divorced woman who abandons the considered courtship that led only to heartbreak and gets hitched on a hunch.

And now, after another five years, Westfeldt is back with "Friends With Kids," which opens Friday, and she's directing for the first time, too.

Westfeldt plays Julie, a 30-something New Yorker who has a child with a platonic friend, Jason (Adam Scott), in hopes of maintaining a romantic single life and foregoing the trappings of married parenthood.

"Friends With Kids" may sound like a facile premise, but the title has a double meaning. As much as the film is about a pair of friends having a baby, it's about the experience of seeing your close friends marry, move and lose their old identities.

"If someone says something's impossible, I'm always, like, 'Really?'" Westfeldt admits. "I don't just follow or believe things that are dictated. I'm always wondering why it has to be that way."

Westfeldt, 42, doesn't look like a rebel. She's a smiley, earnest, down-to-earth, fashionable Upper-West-Sider who chats cheerfully while brushing back her long blond hair.

"She's an open book," says Jon Hamm, her boyfriend of 12 years and a co-star of "Friends With Kids." "There's not a lot of subterfuge or deflection in her, probably to her detriment. ... She is the most open-hearted, sweetest, most loving person that I know. And I think that's pretty obvious in the work that she does." JAKE COYLE (AP)

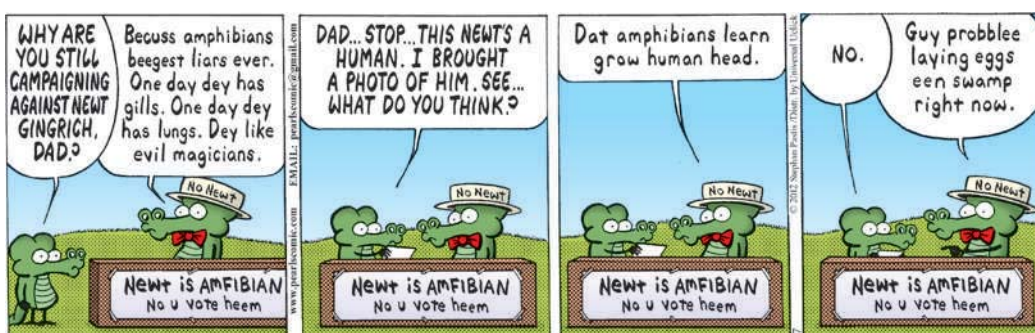

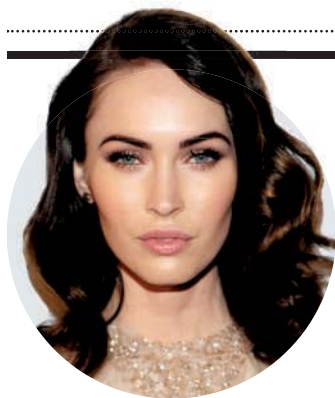

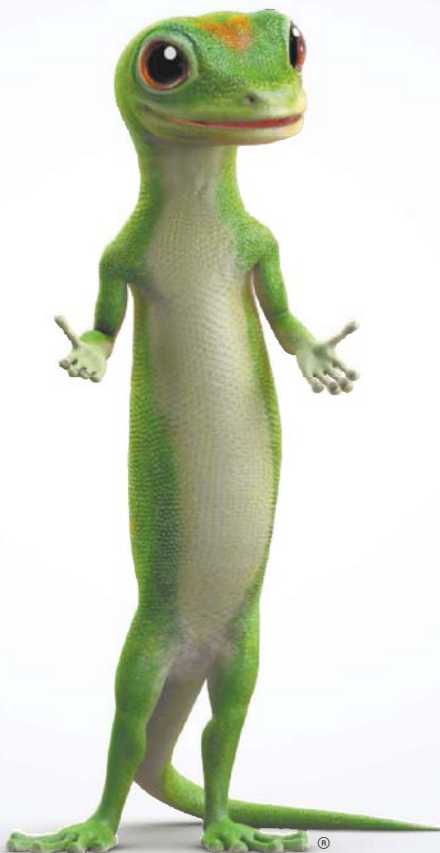
