- 4) Synopsis should not exceed 5 pages excluding cover page. (A4 size paper, Font-Times New Roman, size - 12, line spacing - 1.5)
- 5) The Synopsis should be sent before 10/03/2011 via e-mail at : **ggsp.technofeat11@gmail.com**
- 6) DD of **Rs. 400/-** per project should be drawn in favour of "**Principal, Guru Gobind Singh Polytechnic, Nashik**" Payable at Nashik, should be sent with duly filled registration form to college address on or before 10<sup>th</sup> March 2011.
- 7) Participants have to submit one copy of project report on the day of exhibition.
- 8) Decision of judges will be final and mandatory.

A 230V AC Supply will be provided to every stall. If some special arrangement is required at a stall, the participant should arrange for it a day before the exhibition.
