- Spring and Fall of Every Year Since 1985
- Sample: n=600
- Margin of Error: ± 4% (95% Degree of Confidence)
- Latest Field Dates: March 14-19, 2012
 - Included 20% of the sample from cell phone-only households



2012 Spring Michigan Poll Sample Details


- Geographically stratified by voter turnout in past presidential general elections
- Past Voting Behavior: Democrats=34%, Ticket Splitters=29%, Republicans=33%
 - Self ID: Democrats=33%, Independents=40%, Republicans=25%
- Age: 18-34=19%, 35-54=41%, 55+=38%
















Most Important Problem In Michigan



Past Voting Behavior






Perceptions of Political Leadership




Governor's Job Approval






President's Job Approval






Michigan Is Better Off When Are In Control
















Battleground Issues


Emergency Financial Manager Law

As you may know, state law allows the governor to appoint emergency financial managers to take control of local governments and school districts in severe financial difficulty. These managers have the power to void union contracts and collective bargaining agreements; dissolve or merge municipalities; and mandate millage elections in order to avoid bankruptcy and maintain vital public services. Six such managers have been appointed so far --- in Flint, Benton Harbor, Ecorse, Pontiac, and the **Detroit and Highland Park school** districts. Based on its application so far, do you support or oppose this emergency financial manager law?



Right To Work Law

Right-to-work laws say that workers cannot be required to join labor unions or pay union dues in order to get or keep their jobs. Opponents of right-to-work laws claim that they do not protect workers against employers and fail to guarantee workers' rights to collective bargaining. Michigan currently does not have such a law. In general, do you support a right-to-work law for Michigan?
