IOWA STATE POSTGAME NOTES

TEAM NOTES

- * Tonight's meeting was the 3rd in series history. Kentucky now leads 3-0
- * Iowa State is now 1-17 against Associated Press No. 1-ranked teams
- * The Cyclones are now 0-3 vs. No. 1-seeded teams in the NCAA Championship. All games have been played in the No. 1 seed's home state
- * Had four players (Palo, Gibson, Allen, Christopherson) go 100 percent from the free-throw line tonight
- * The Cyclones made a season-low three 3-point attempts
- * Iowa State shot 45-54 from the free-throw line in its last three games
- * Conceded a season-high 87 points.
- * Allowed Kentucky to shoot 55.4 percent from the field, the second-highest output by an opponent this year (60 percent at Baylor)

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

Royce White

- * Made his first four shots and scored nine of the Cyclones' first 11 points
- * Fouled out for the first time in his career
- * Scored 23 points, two off his career mark
- * One rebound shy of his 12th career double-double
- * Had a team-high four assists

Scott Christopherson

- * Finished the season shooting 90.3 percent (93-103) from the free-throw line
- * Became only the fourth player in Big 12 history to finish the season shooting 90-percent or higher from the line
- * Trails only Jake Sullivan's 93.3 percent (83-89) season free-throw mark in Cyclone history
- * Finished his career with an 86.2-percent mark from the line, second in Cyclone history behind only Sullivan (89.6)
- * Finished his Cyclone career as Iowa State's all-time leader in 3-point shooting percentage at 44.3 (198-447)
- * Shot 8-8 from the free-throw line at this year's NCAA Championship

Chris Allen

- * Tallied 16 points, averaged 18 points at this year's NCAA Championship
- * Shot 8-8 from the free-throw line at this year's NCAA Championship

Percy Gibson

- * Scored nine points on 3-4 of shooting in his NCAA Championship debut
- * Shot 3-3 from the line

Bubu Palo

- * Fouled out for the first time this season and the third time in his career
- * Went 2-2 from the free-throw line

Fred Hoiberg

- * Received first technical foul of his coaching career
