## Gauge

7 sts $=1 "$ in stockinette st

## Materials

Yarn approximately 50 yds fingering/sock weight yarn (Taj Mahal or similar)

Needles US \#2 dpns (or size needed for gauge)

## Abbreviations

$\mathbf{C O}=$ Cast On; $\mathbf{S T}=\operatorname{Stitch}(\mathrm{es}) ; \mathbf{K}=$ Knit; $\mathbf{P}=$ Purl; $\mathbf{Y O}=$ Yarn Over; $\mathbf{K 2 t o g}=$ Knit 2 Together; $\mathbf{S S K}=$ Slip-Slip-Knit (slip 2 sts knitwise, return to left needle, and knit them together through the back); $\mathbf{S l}=$ Slip the indicated number of stitches (purlwise, unless otherwise noted, e.g. working an SSK); DPN = Double Pointed Needles.

## Instructions

## Cuff

Cast on 32 sts using long-tail cast on (or any elastic cast on); distribute 8 sts per ndl; \& join into rnd, placing marker for beginning of rnd.

Work 22 rnds of K2P2 ribbing (starting with K1, p2, and ending with K1 - so that the first and last st on every needle is knit).

## Turned Heel

K8 (to end of needle 1) \& turn; sl1, P15 (to end of needle 4) \& turn; * sl1, K15 \& turn; sl1, P15 \& turn; * repeat between ${ }^{*}$ four more times.

Sl1, k8, ssk, k1, turn; sl1, p3, p2tog, p1, turn; sl1 k4, ssk, k1, turn; sl1, p5, p2tog, p1, turn; sl1 k6, ssk, k1, turn; sl1, p7, p2tog, p1, turn; k5.

Using empty needle; k5; pick-up 8 sts along left edge of heel; work next 16 sts in ribbing; pick-up 8 sts along
right edge of heel; k5 (there are now 13 sts on needles 1 $\& 4$ and 8 sts on needles $2 \& 3)$.

## Gusset \& Instep

K10, k2tog, k1; work next 16 sts in ribbing; k1, ssk, k10.
K12; work next 16 sts in ribbing; k12.
K9, k2tog, k1; work next 16 sts in ribbing; k1, ssk, k9.
K11; work next 16 sts in ribbing; k11.
K8, k2tog, k1; work next 16 sts in ribbing; k1, ssk, k8.
K10; work next 16 sts in ribbing; k10.
K 7 , k2tog, k1; work next 16 sts in ribbing; k1, ssk, k7.
K9; work next 16 sts in ribbing; k9.
K6, k2tog, k1; work next 16 sts in ribbing; k1, ssk, k6.
K8; work next 16 sts in ribbing; k8.
Repeat above rnd 6 times, and knit one round.

## Toe

Work [K5, k2tog, k1; k1, ssk, k5] twice.
Work two rnds stockinette (k all 28 sts).
Work [K4, k2tog, k1; k1, ssk, k4] twice.
Work one rnd stockinette (k all 24 sts).
Work [K3, k2tog, k1; k1, ssk, k3] twice.
Work one rnd stockinette (k all 20 sts).
Work [K2, k2tog, k1; k1, ssk, k2] twice.
Work [K1, k2tog, k1; k1, ssk, k1] twice.
Work [k2tog, k1; set down empty needle; k1, ssk] twice.
Use kitchener st to join the 4 sts on each needle and weave in ends.
