Students who attend Vogel Intermediate will attend the new junior high school. (In 2008, the zoning process began for several schools opening in the Oak Ridge High School feeder zone. Tom Cox Intermediate was one of those campuses. Part of the thought process at that time was the natural break between the two intermediate schools and their respective junior high

schools: Vogel Intermediate feeds the new junior high school and Tom Cox Intermediate feeds York Junior High. [See zone map].)

> Students who live in Shenandoah and have been attending schools in the Oak Ridge feeder may apply for an intradistrict transfer to attend the new junior high school. Decisions for approval will be based on space at the school. Transportation will

Students will have the opportunity to apply for a transfer to remain at York for the 8th grade; however, transportation will not be provided. All 6th grade students entering 7th grade from Vogel Intermediate will attend the new junior high school.
