














Figure 2 Percentage of population urban, Malaysia, 1970 and 2000


Contribution to GDP by kind of economic activity, Selangor, Kelantan, Pulau Pinang and Malaysia, 2000

Figure 4 Employed population by age, Selangor and Malaysia, 2000







Figure 6 Employed population distribution by industry category and by ethnic group, Selangor, 2000 (%) 100 Agriculture, hunting, forestry 5.0 0.2 0.2 0.2 and fishing 90 ■ Mining and quarrying 18.9 27.2 80 30.7 0.5 Manufacturing 9.7 70 1.1 ■ Electricity, gas and water 1.0 supply 5.2 60 12.5 Construction 26.1 14.9 50 8.8 ☐ Wholesale and retail trade, hotels and restaurants 40 6.8 11.0 ☐ Transport, storage and 13.1 communications 30 17.7 12.2 ■ Finance, insurance, real estate, renting and business activities 20 Community, social and 27.9 personal services 18.7 10 15.8 ☐ Others and unknown 0 Bumiputera Chinese **Indians**

Employed population distribution by industry category, Selangor, Kelantan, Pulau Pinang and Malaysia, 2000








Figure 9 Incidence of poverty by state, 1970 to 2002

Educational attainment of persons aged 6 and over by level and ethnicity, Selangor, 2000





Figure 12 Progress in literacy, 1991 and 2000

Figure 13 Child mortality by state, 1990 and 2000 Under age 5 deaths per 1000 births >20 15-20 10-15 <10




Figure 15 Progress in child mortality, 1990 and 2000 Urban Progress Terengganu 1990 2000 Perlis Pahang Johor Negeri Sembilan Kelantan Perak Selangor Kedah Federal Territory Kuala Lumpur Melaka Pulau Pinang Pen. Malaysia Rural Pahang Kedah Perlis Terengganu Perak Kelantan Johor Selangor Negeri Sembilan Melaka Pulau Pinang Pen. Malaysia Total Pahang Terengganu Perlis Kedah Kelantan Perak Johor Negeri Sembilan Selangor Melaka Federal Territory Kuala Lumpur Pulau Pinang Pen. Malaysia 20 15 10 Under-five mortality rate per 1000 live births

Figure 16 Proportion of infant immunized against measles, 1990 and 2001




Figure 17 Proportion of births attended by skilled health personnel, 1989 and 2002
