Academic Calendar:

The academic school year at Homestead consists of two semesters of study, each ending with a period of three days for final examinations. The first semester runs from September 1 to January 20. Student mid-year reports and transcripts are released to colleges during the first week of February 2011. Second semester classes begin on January 23 with final exams administered during the week of June 4. The graduation date for the class of 2012 is June 10.

Graduation Requirements:

The minimum graduation requirement is 22 credits to include 2 mathematics, 2 science, 3 social studies, 4 English, 1 fine arts or the 1/2 credit Fine Arts Survey course, 1/2 computer science, 1-1/2 physical education, 1/2 health, plus electives. One credit is awarded for successful completion of a course which meets five days a week for the school year, and 1/2 credit for courses meeting five days a week for one semester. A semester consists of 18 weeks. The minimum course load for students is 6 classes in a seven period day. All classes meet for 50 minute periods.
