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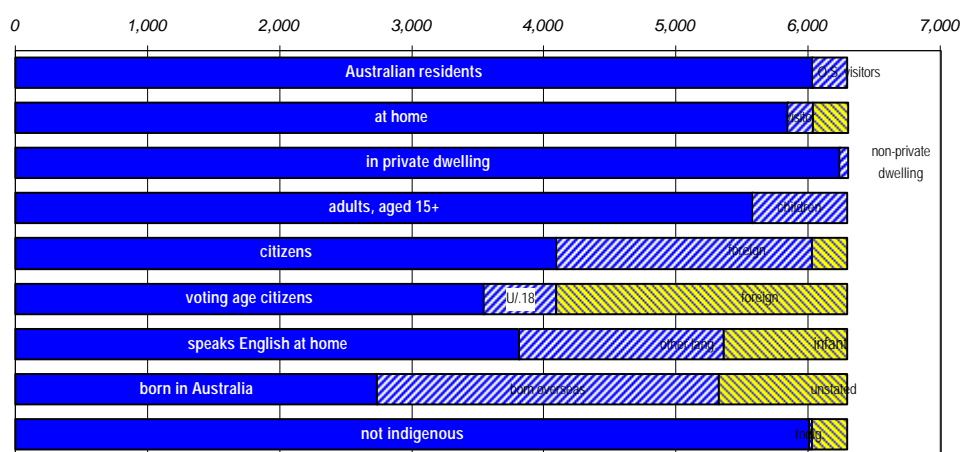
Bondi Junction's population in 2001

On Census night, 7th August 2001, Bondi Junction had a population of 6,299 people. This was an increase of 654 since 1996, so Bondi Junction's annual growth rate over 1996-2001 was 2.2% a year, much greater than Waverley's growth of minus 0.2% pa. If its growth continued since 2001 at the same rate, by mid 2003, the population of Bondi Junction would have reached about 6,580

Bondi Junction's population was 10.2% of Waverley's 61,661. With an area of 0.8 sq.km., Bondi Junction had a population density of 84 people per hectare or 8400 per sq.km. By way of comparison, Waverley had 6600 people per sq. km.

The population of Bondi Junction on Census night, which excluded those away, consisted of:

- * 6,031 Australian residents (ie excluding overseas visitors),
- * 5,846 permanent residents (ie excluding all visitors),
- * 3,541 citizens of voting age,
- * 24 indigenous people,
- * 2,592 people born overseas (not counting overseas visitors),
- * 63 people in non-private dwellings (eg hotels, nursing homes, hospitals, boarding houses).

In this report, the population most commonly used is the Australian resident population, which excludes overseas visitors but includes Australian visitors (who roughly offset those away from home on Census night).

Note that where the number of people in a 'cell' in a Census table is in low single figures (eg the number of men aged 100+), the number has been randomly changed to protect privacy, generally to become 3 or 6. This means very small numbers are not accurate and some columns may not add up exactly.

Bondi Junction's changing age profile

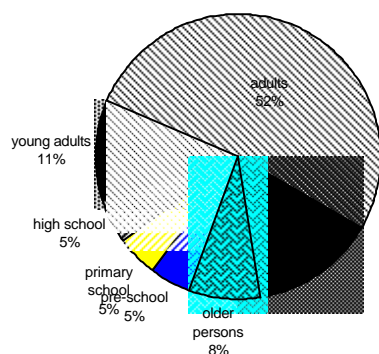
The largest demographic group in Bondi Junction is people in their prime working age, from 25 to 54 years old, with 3,126 people or 52% of the population. This is a similar proportion than in Waverley (52%), though their numbers rose by 261 since 1996.

The other large demographic group consists of more mature people aged 55-74, the generation going through retirement. There are 858 in this age group, 14% of the population, which is similar to Waverley's proportion. This group's size has risen by 111 since 1996. Older people, aged 75+ and entering frailty, number 482, a rise of 190 since 1996. Some 8% of the population was aged 75+, similar to Waverley's 7%.

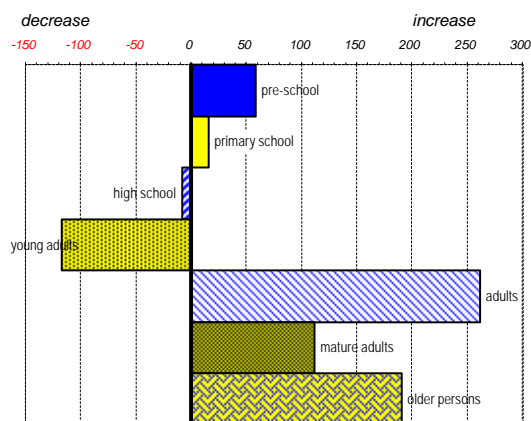
Bondi Junction also had 281 pre-school-aged children under five (up 58 since 1996) and 294 primary-aged children (5-11 years), up 15. Pre-school and primary-aged children constituted 4.7% and 4.9% of the population, compared with 5.2% and 6.2% across Waverley.

The high-school age group (12-17 years) in Bondi Junction numbered 288 in 2001, down 8 since 1996. They contributed 4.8% of the population compared with 5.1% for Waverley. There were 689 young adults aged 18-24, down 117, constituting 11% of the population (10% across Waverley).

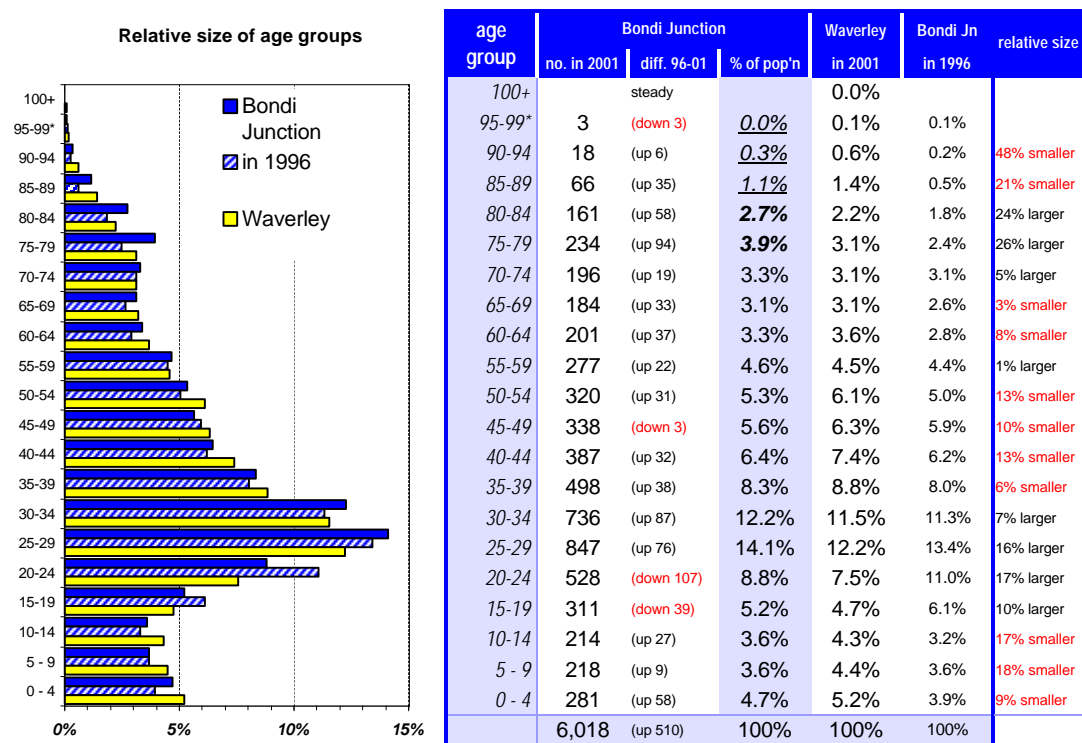
Bondi Junction's age pyramid

The age spread of a community can be illustrated by an age pyramid. The size of each level on the pyramid represents the number of people in a five-year age group or 'cohort'. Higher levels on the pyramid representing older people. Bondi Junction's age pyramid is shown below (the dark layers) compared with Waverley (the light layers).

Normally, an Australian community will bulge most in the 35-54 age group ('the baby-boomers'), tapering off to a peak at the top because there are relatively few very old people. Newer communities tend to have larger bulges in the 'young family' age groups (say 25-39 and 0-14 years old); more established communities tend to have older families with larger bulges amongst 45-59 year olds and their 15-24 year old children. Maturing communities tend to have bulges in the population aged 65+, while renewing communities have this 'ageing' bulge plus others showing the incoming younger families.

Bondi Junction's largest five-year age groups in 2001 were 25-29 year-olds (847 people), followed by 30-34 year-olds (736), and 20-24 year-olds (528).

Age groups which were significantly larger in Bondi Junction compared with Waverley were 75-79 years old (3.9% of the local population but 3.1% of Waverley, or 26% larger); 80-84 years old (24% larger); and 20-24 years old (17% larger). Age groups which were noticeably smaller were 85-89 years old (21% smaller); 5 - 9 years old (18% smaller); and 10-14 years old (17% smaller).

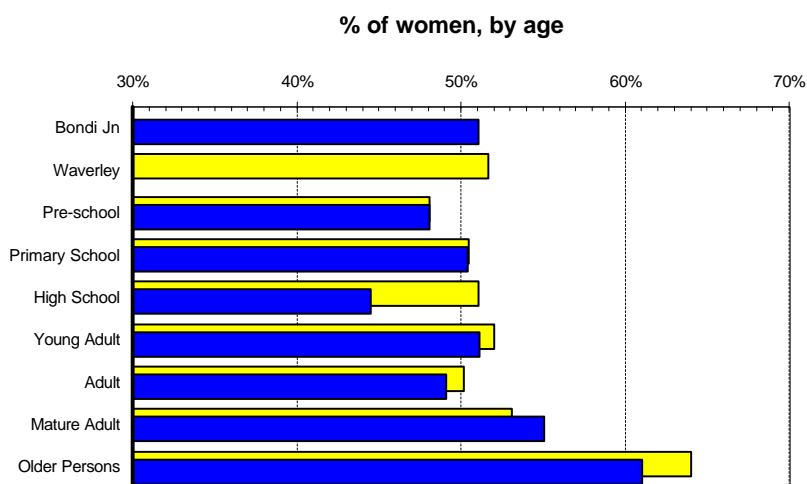

Bondi Junction's male - female ratio

In 2001 in Bondi Junction, there were 104 women for every 100 men, a ratio which is similar to the Waverley average of 107 women per 100 men.

Since 1996, the number of women has risen by 277 or 9.5% while the number of men has risen by 374 or 13.8%.

The ratio of women to men increases with age because men, on average, die younger than women. The male-female imbalance is most evident among very old people, and communities with significant male-female imbalances tend to have older populations. Among those aged 75 or over in Bondi Junction, 61% are women, so there are 1.6 women for each man. This is less than Waverley's rate of 1.8 women for each man.

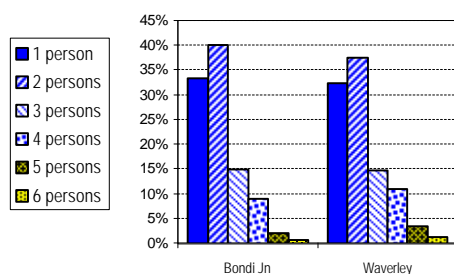
Bondi Junction's households

In 2001, Bondi Junction had some 2,570 households (up 106 since 1996), of which half (55%) were family households, including about 17 with more than one family. The average family household had 2.7 people. There were also 307 group households (of unrelated people) which averaged 2.5 people. Bondi Junction's overall average household size, including its 859 single-person households, was 1.7 persons, similar to Waverley's 1.9.

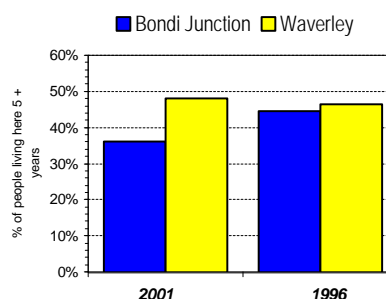
Amongst Bondi Junction's households, the most common sizes were 2 persons (40% of households) and 1 person (33%). Altogether, 12% of Bondi Junction's households had four or more people, housing 24% of the community. By way of comparison, 16% of Waverley's households had four or more people, housing 31% of the community.

The stability of a community is indicated by the proportion of people who have remained for a reasonable period of time. In Bondi Junction, 36% of residents aged over five were living here in 1996. This residential stability is much less than Waverley's, where 48% had remained for five years, and less than Bondi Junction's stability in 1996, when 44% of residents had lived here that long. Relative to Waverley, Bondi Junction's residential stability decreased since 1996.

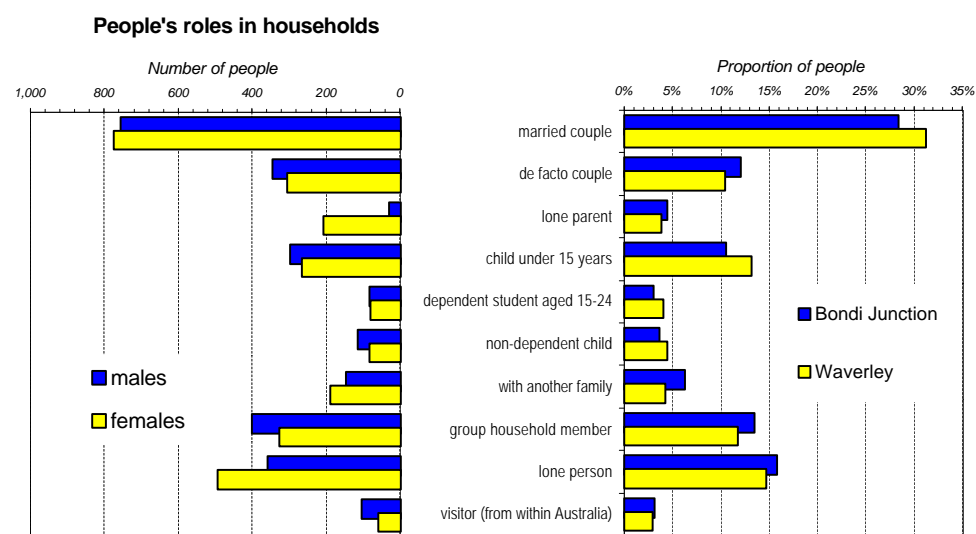

Household arrangements in Bondi Junction

Most commonly, people live as a part of couple, with 40% of people living this way in Bondi Junction (similar to Waverley's 41%). About 30% of couples were not married in 2001, higher than Waverley's rate of 25%. As well, there were 238 lone parents, 4% of the population, with seven-eighths of them being women.

Living with the couple- and single-parents were some 1,300 children and young people, most commonly a child under 15 years. These represented 22% of the people compared with 23% of Waverley.

The other people in Bondi Junction lived either alone (851 people) or in group households (726). Among those living alone, the number of women was much greater than the number of men with 494 women and 357 men; lone people constituted 18% of females and 14% of males.

Families in Bondi Junction

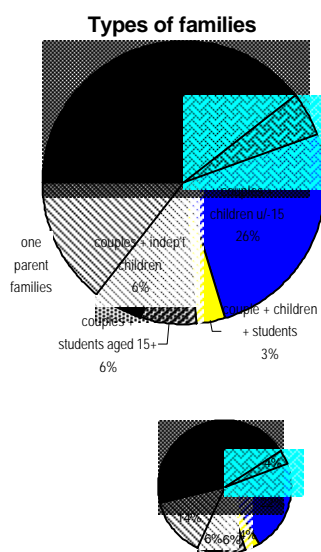
Altogether, 58% of Bondi Junction's people live in families, with some 3,520 people in some 1,420 families of an average size of 2.5 people. This is similar to Waverley's average family size of 2.7 people.

Bondi Junction has some 410 couples with children, with 62% having all their children aged under 15. They constitute 29% of all families and have 24% of Bondi Junction's people.

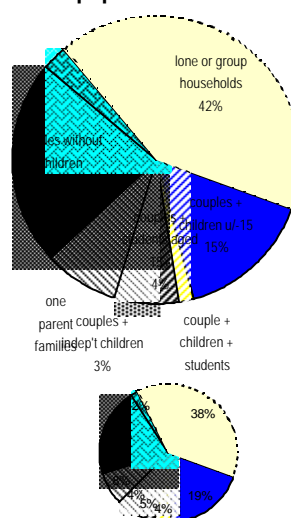
Another 49% of families are couples without children, home to 23% of the population. In addition, there are 229 single-parent families (with 8% of the population) and 79 families of other types.

Since 1996, the average family size in Bondi Junction has decreased by 10.0%. The average size of couple families with children has decreased by 7.7% from 3.80 to 3.51 persons, while the average size of single-parent families has decreased by 12.0% from 2.51 to 2.21 persons.

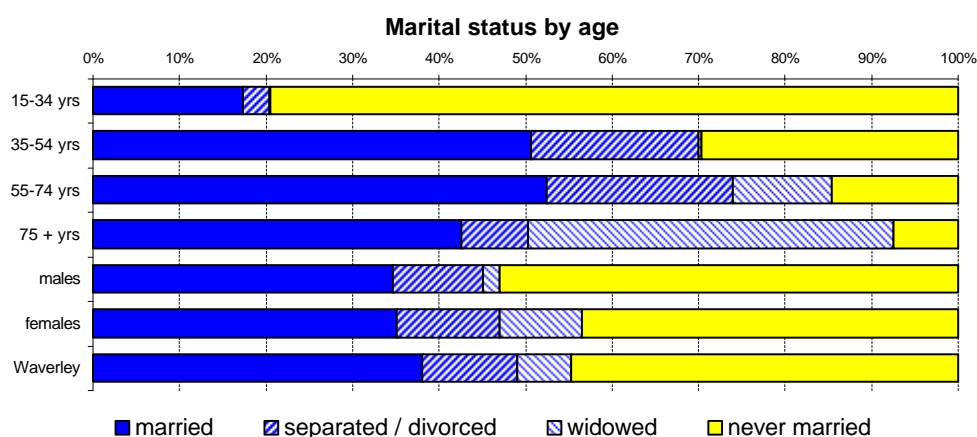

Marital status in Bondi Junction

Overall in Bondi Junction, 35% of adults (aged 15+) are married, 11% are separated or divorced, 6% are widowed, and 48% have never been married. By comparison with Waverley, Bondi Junction has a lot fewer married people (by 3.1 percentage points), slightly more separated or divorced people (by 0.2 points), slightly fewer people widowed (by 0.5 points), and more people who have never married (by 3.4 points).

Only 17% of younger people (15-34 years old) were married in 2001. This was similar to Waverley's rate of 18%. This rate had barely changed from 17% in 1996, while the proportion of younger people who had never married went from 79% to 79%.

Among older people aged 75+, the marital status of men and women becomes quite divergent due to the earlier death of many men, leaving many widows. In Bondi Junction, 58% of older women but just 18% of such men were widowed, while conversely 68% of the men but only 26% of the women were still married.

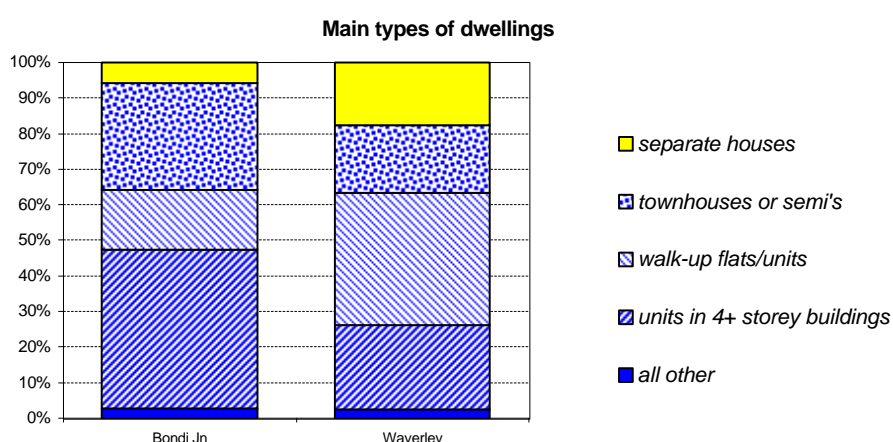
Types of dwellings in Bondi Junction

In mid-2001, Bondi Junction had 3,271 dwellings, an increase of 344 since 1996. Some 297 dwellings were vacant, giving a vacancy rate of 9.1% of dwellings, similar to Waverley's 9.1%. Lower vacancy rates at the mid-winter census are more common in stable communities and in winter holiday places.

The most common kinds of dwellings in Bondi Junction are units in 4+ storey buildings, of which there were some 1,300 in 2001 (45% of Bondi Junction's dwellings; 24% over Waverley). Of other common types of dwellings, there were about 900 townhouses or semi's, 500 walk-up flats/units and 170 separate houses.

The most commonly-built types of dwelling over the previous five years were units in 4+ storey buildings, with 429 more dwellings since 1996. The number of walk-up flats/units was 23 smaller. The number of townhouses or semi's decreased by 41.

Among the less common types of dwellings, Bondi Junction had 11 flats on shops / offices (down by 39 since 1996) and 5 "granny" flats on houses (down by 1).

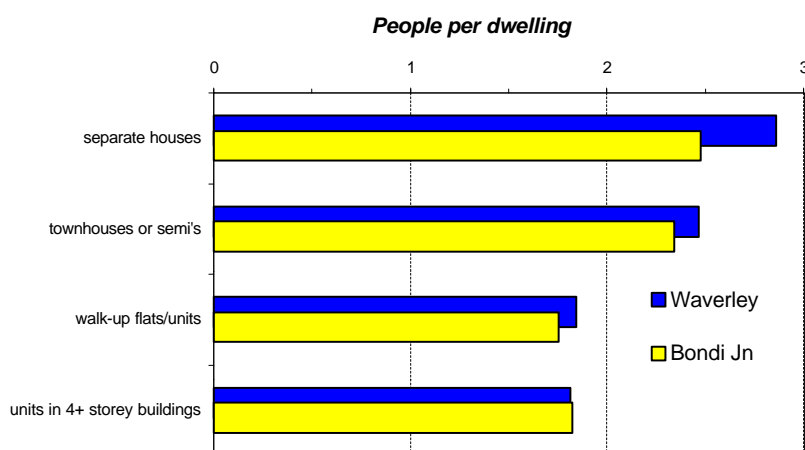
Dwelling occupancy in Bondi Junction

The average number of people in each occupied dwelling in Bondi Junction is 2.01 which is lower than Waverley's average occupancy rate of 2.13.

Since 1996, Bondi Junction's average occupancy rate has fallen by 0.06 or 3%. This is a result of the population living in private dwellings rising by 9% while the number of occupied private dwellings rose by 12%.

Among separate houses, the average occupancy was 2.47 people per house, a decrease of 0.02 since 1996. This occupancy rate was 13% lower than Waverley's rate of 2.85. The average occupancy of semis and townhouses was 2.33 persons, up 0.05 since 1996 and 5% lower than Waverley's.

Bondi Junction's occupancy rate for walk-up flats/units was 1.75, down 0.04 since 1996 and 5% lower than in Waverley's. The rate for units in 4+ storey buildings was very similar.

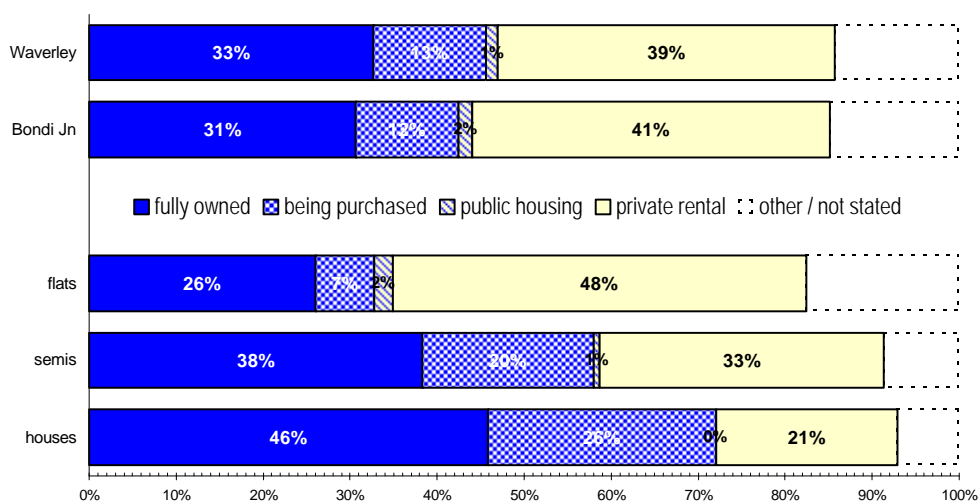
Owning and renting in Bondi Junction

In Bondi Junction, it is most common for dwellings to be private rental, with 1,218 dwellings or 41% of the occupied dwelling stock in this form of tenure in 2001. The remaining dwellings were fully owned (31%), being purchased (12%) or public housing (1.6%). Bondi Junction's similar proportion of dwellings which were fully owned, relative to Waverley, suggests this community has relatively similar proportions of long-term residents.

In all, some 72% of detached houses in Bondi Junction were owner-occupied (either fully owned or being purchased), compared with 33% of units or flats. Conversely, 50% of units and flats were rented, either privately or through public housing, compared with 21% of detached houses and 33% of semis and townhouses.

The proportion of dwellings which were rented privately was similar to that of Waverley (39%), indicating Bondi Junction may have similar population turnover to Waverley. The share of dwellings in public housing was 1.6%, which was 15% larger than Waverley's proportion.

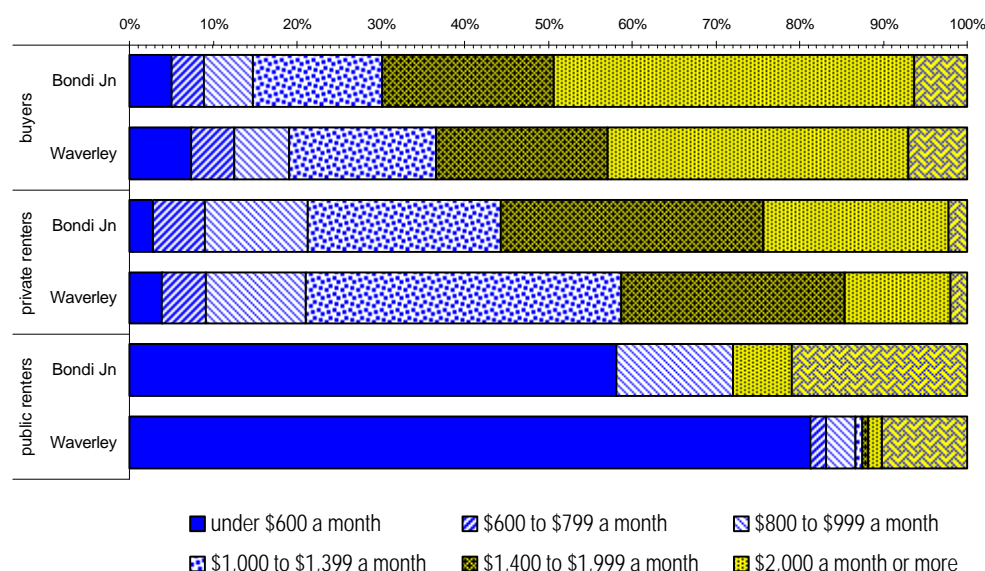

The cost of housing in Bondi Junction

The average mortgage payment in Bondi Junction in 2001 was about \$2,040 a month, 8% higher than Waverley's average of \$1,890 a month. Most commonly, the mortgage payment was in the band \$2,000 a month or more.

Among private renters, the average rent was about \$400 a week (about \$1,740 a month), 13% above Waverley's average rent of some \$360 a week. The most common rental range was \$350 - \$499 a week, paid by 31% of tenants.

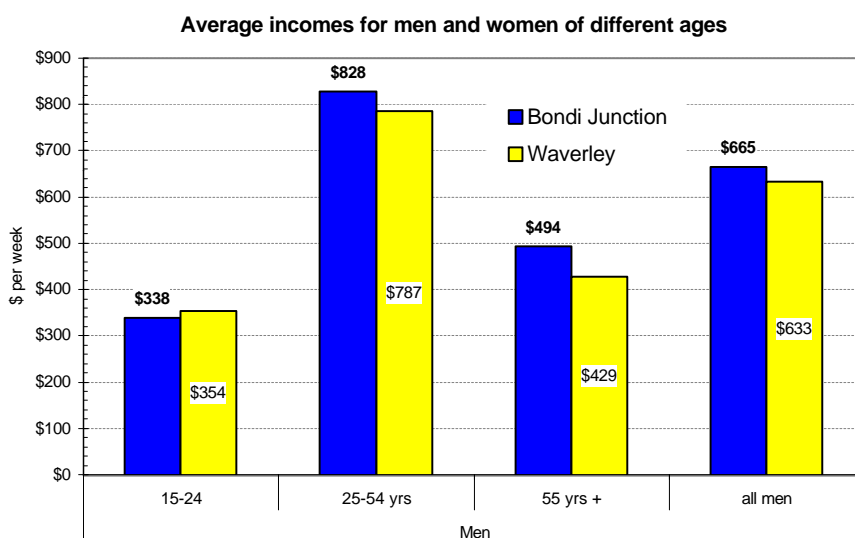

Incomes of men and women

On average, the incomes of Bondi Junction's adults (aged 15+) in 2001 were similar to Waverley's. The average female income in 2001 was around \$670 a week in Bondi Junction while the male average was about \$890. On average, women earned 75% of men, which was almost the same as Waverley's rate.

Bondi Junction men of prime working age, 25-54 years, reported average incomes of around \$1,100 a week in mid-2001, which was similar to Waverley's average. Women of this age had an average weekly income of about \$830 a week, 5.2% above Waverley.

Among young people (15-24), average weekly incomes were \$409 for males and \$338 for females, while among older people, average incomes were \$617 for men and \$494 for women.



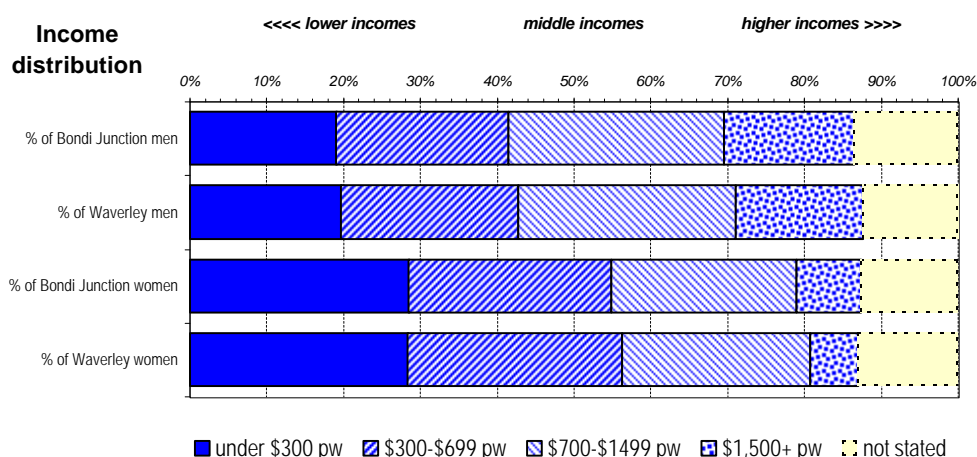

Incomes distribution in Bondi Junction

The 2001 incomes of people (aged 15+) in Bondi Junction fell into three broad bands - low (under \$300 pw), middle (\$300-\$700 pw) and high (over \$700 pw). The male income distribution was 19% low, 22% middle and 45% high (with the rest unknown). Female incomes were 28% low, 26% middle and 32% high.

Low incomes (under \$300 a week) tends to be more common among young people (aged 15-24) and women (due to lower wages and more part-time work) and older people (aged 65+ and generally retired).

In Bondi Junction, 39% of older women had low incomes, less than Waverley's 45%, along with 42% of young women (45% in Waverley). Among males, 40% of young men and 29% of older men had low incomes (viz-a-viz 41% and 33% for Waverley).

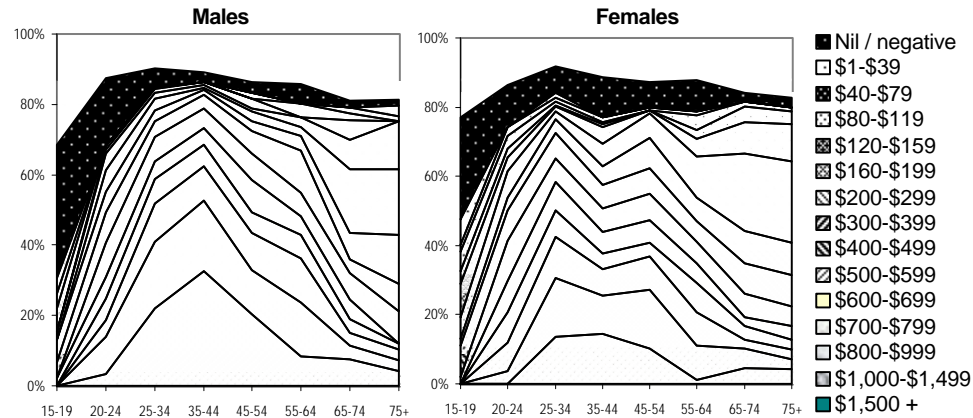

Changing incomes by age and sex

The charts below illustrate how incomes change with age for men and women. For example, the proportion in lower-income bands (under \$300 pw) falls from around half the 15-19 year olds to about 10-15% of adults as people enter the workforce, but rises over the age of about 55 as people retire onto a pension-level income. The proportion earning higher incomes peaks at about 35-44 years old and falls slightly over the 45-54 age group as retirements. The differences between male and female incomes are most apparent in the higher income bands, where the proportion of men greatly exceeds that of women. The effect of more women working part-time can be seen in the higher proportions earning under \$400 a week. The blank area at the top of the charts represents those who did not give their income.



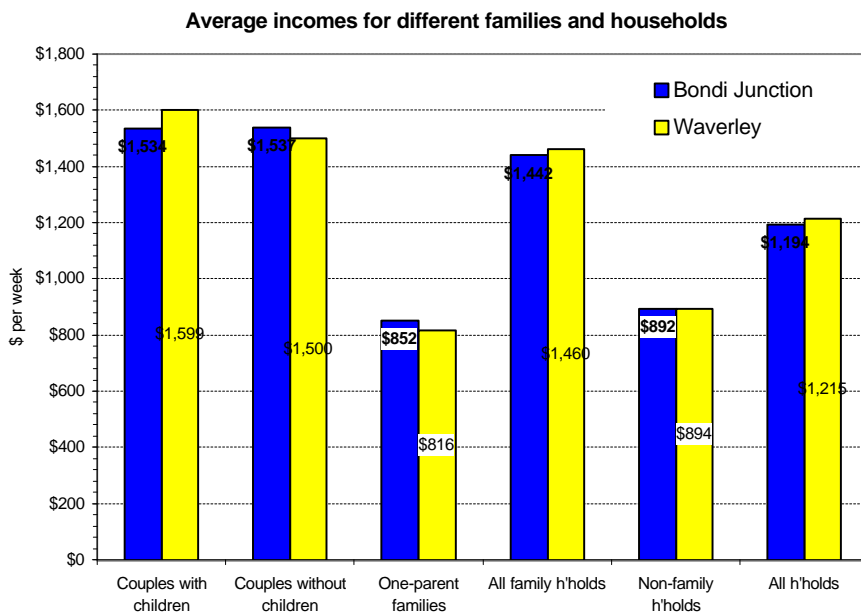

Bondi Junction's average household incomes

The average family income in Bondi Junction in 2001 was around \$1,400 a week or \$75,000 a year, similar to Waverley's average of \$75,900 pa (1% lower).

Couples without children had the highest average family incomes at about \$1,500 a week. One-parent families had the lowest average family incomes at about \$850 a week. Non-family households in Bondi Junction had lower average incomes than family households, at about \$890 a week, due to many being single-person households.



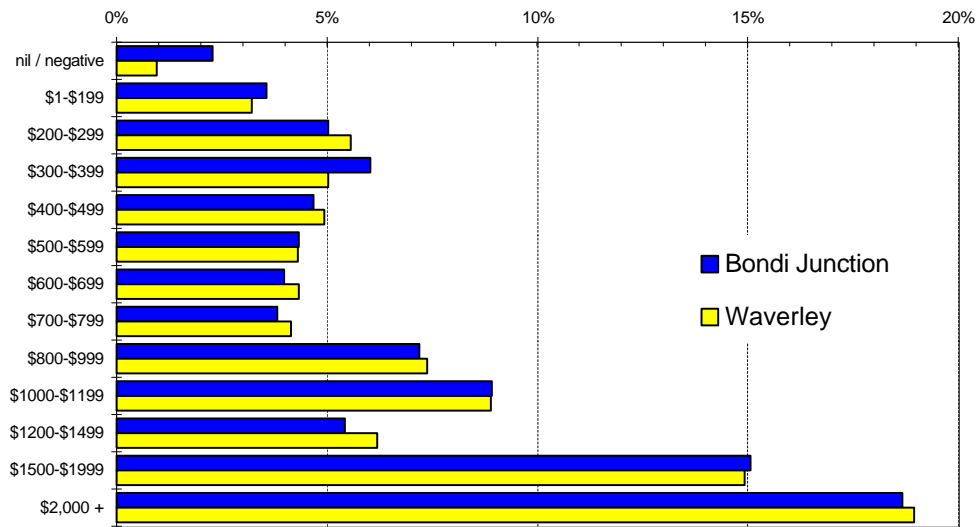

Bondi Junction's household income variations

Compared with Waverley, Bondi Junction's household incomes differed most in the proportion in the nil / negative income band, which had 2.2% of Bondi Junction's households compared with 0.9% of Waverley's (ie one and two-fifths larger). The \$300-\$399 income band with 5.0% of Bondi Junction's households was one fifth larger than Waverley's equivalent income band. Conversely, Bondi Junction's households were most under-represented in the \$1200-\$1499 income band, which had 5% of Bondi Junction's households compared with 6.2% in Waverley (ie one eighth smaller) and the \$200-\$299 income band (5.0% of Bondi Junction's households, one tenth smaller than Waverley).

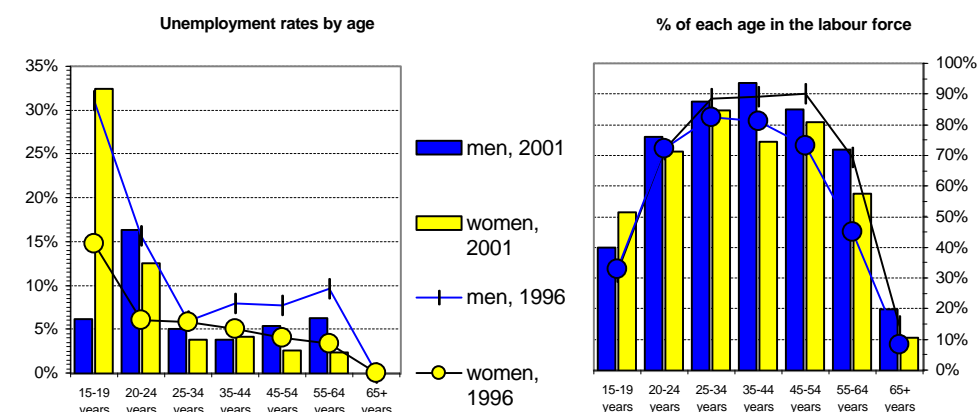
Employment in Bondi Junction

Bondi Junction provided a total labour force of around 3,290 people in 2001 (1,740 men and 1,550 women), an increase of 99 or 3% since 1996. This labour force represents 69% of the working-age population (aged 15+), a rate lower than Waverley's 72%.

The unemployment rate amongst Bondi Junction's workforce in mid-2001 was 5.5% when Waverley's was 4.9%. Over 1996 to 2001, the male unemployment rate decreased from 8.8% to 6.0% while the female unemployment rate increased from 5.5% to 5.8%.

Among male workers, 72% were employed full-time. Unemployment rates ranged from 16% among those aged 20-24 years and 6% among those 55-64 years to nil among those aged 65+ years and 4% among those aged 35-44 years.

Among female workers, only 62% were employed full-time. Unemployment rates ranged from 6% among those aged 15-19 years and 16% among those 20-24 years, to nil among those aged 65+ years and 2% among those aged 55-64 years.

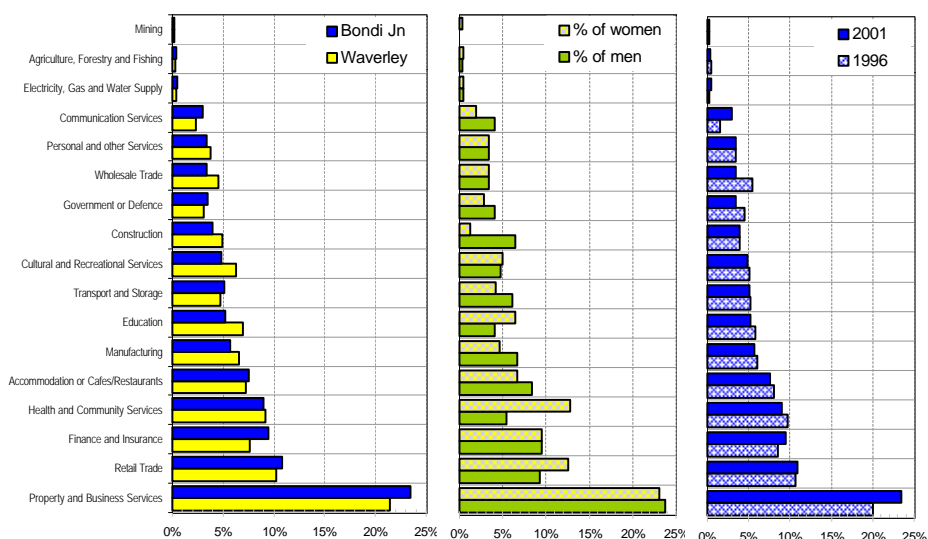
The industries where Bondi Junction works

The industry providing the most Bondi Junction residents with work in 2001 was Property and Business Services, which employed some 730 people: 24% of men and 23% of women in Bondi Junction's workforce. The next largest employers were Retail Trade (about 340 workers), Finance and Insurance (about 290) and Health and Community Services (about 279).

Over 1996-2001, the fastest growing industries amongst Bondi Junction workers were Property and Business Services (up 152), Finance and Insurance (up 48), Finance and Insurance (up 48) and Retail Trade (up 30). There were fewer workers in Wholesale Trade (down 52) and Government or Defence (down 24).

The biggest differences in the workforce's industries from Waverley were:

- * larger proportions in Property and Business Services (23% compared with 21%), Finance and Insurance (9% v. 8%) and Communication Services (3% v. 2%).
- * smaller proportions in Education (5% v. 7%), Cultural and Recreational Services (5% v. 6%) and Wholesale Trade (3.3% v. 4.4%).

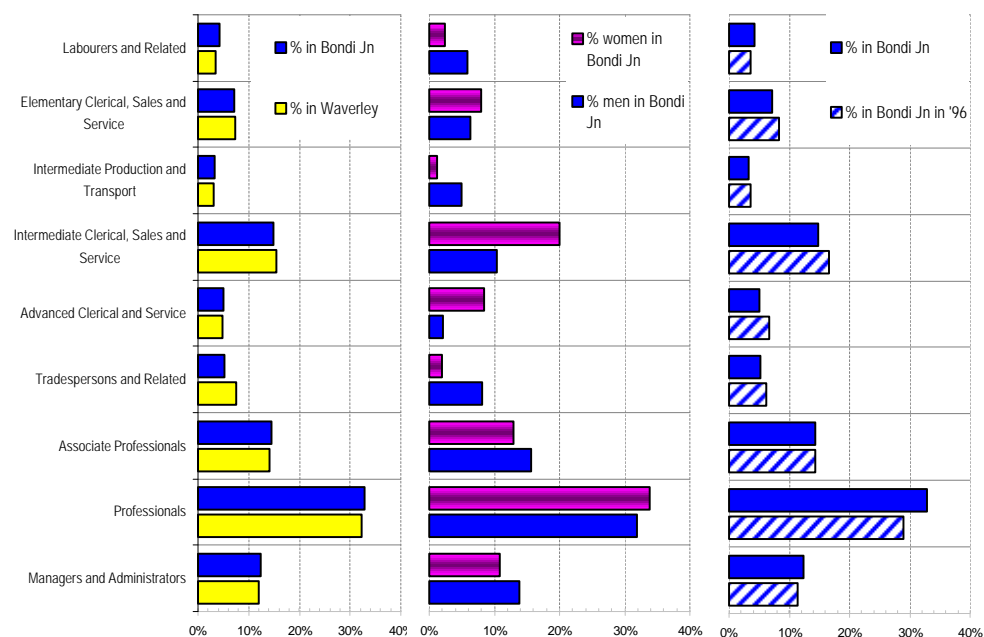

Occupations in Bondi Junction

The most common type of occupation in Bondi Junction in 2001 was Professionals with some 1,000 people or 33% of the local workforce, followed by Intermediate Clerical, Sales and Service (around 460), Associate Professionals (about 450) and Managers and Administrators (about 380).

The biggest occupational differences between the sexes were that men were much more likely to work as Tradespersons and Related (8% of men but just 2% of women), Intermediate Production and Transport (5% of men; 1% of women) and Labourers and Related (6% of men; 2% of women).

Women were more likely to work in Intermediate Clerical, Sales and Service (20% of women but 10% of men), Advanced Clerical and Service (8% of women; 2% of men) and Professionals (34% of women; 32% of men).

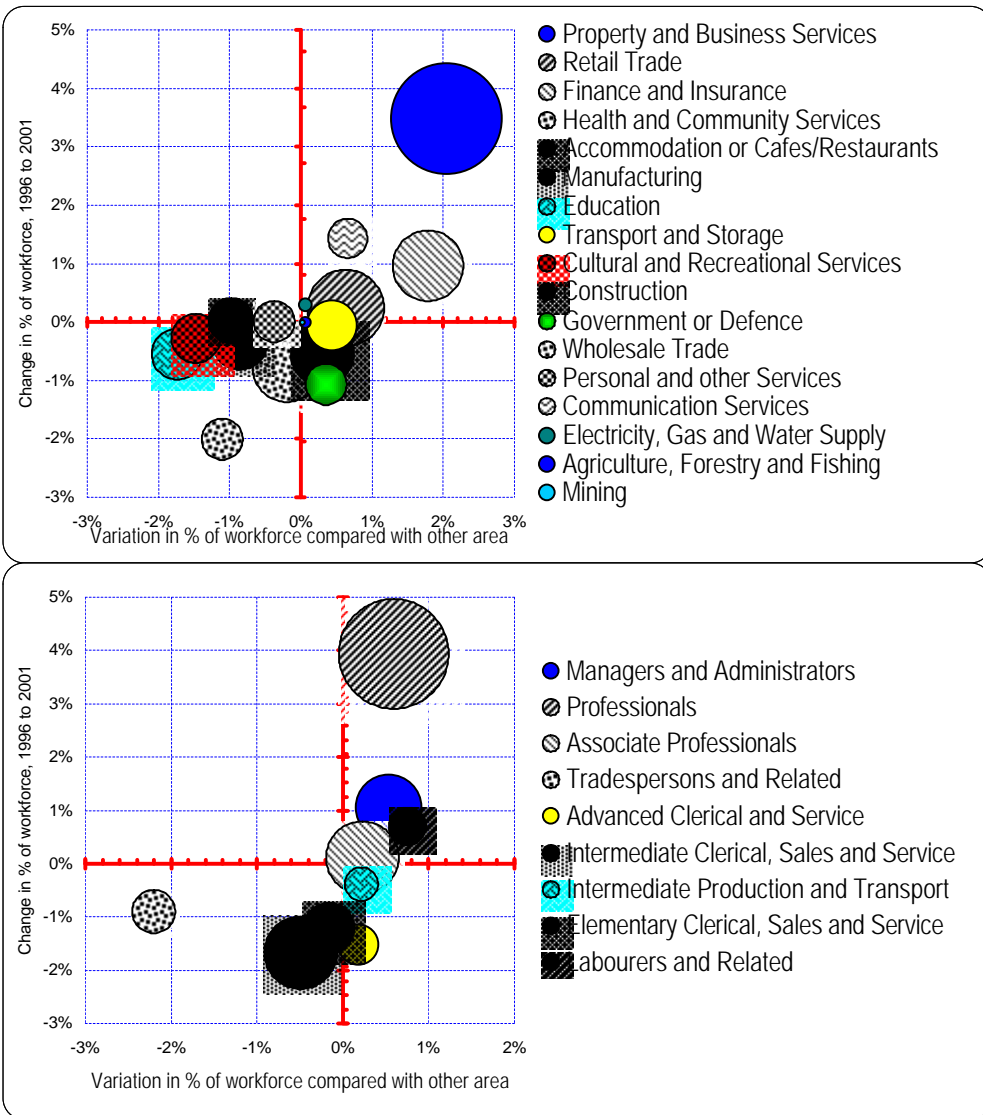

Bondi Junction's employment strengths

The bubble-charts below show the relative importance of various industries and occupations to employment in Bondi Junction. In the top chart, each industry is listed in order of employment size, indicated by the size of its bubble. The second chart shows occupations. The higher the bubble, the faster that sector grew, relative to others in Bondi Junction, over 1996-2001. The further to the right the bubble, the larger is that sector in Bondi Junction relative to Waverley. A 'stable' area's pattern would be a series of concentric circles. A diagonal pattern of bubbles from bottom left to top right, with the larger upper-right bubbles (representing many people), indicates that employment diversity is decreasing and the population is becoming more homogeneous.



How Bondi Junction gets to work

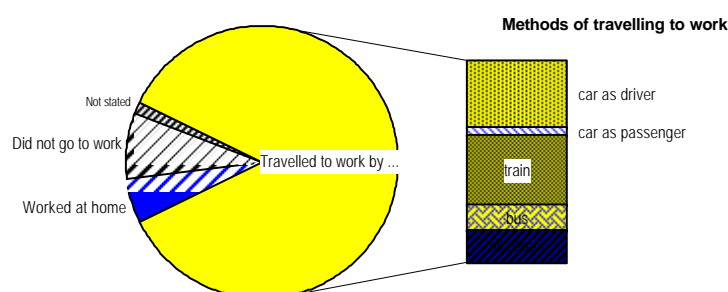
Of the 3,080-person workforce in Bondi Junction, some 85% travelled to work in 2001 (82% of women and 88% of men). Another 5% worked at home, much higher than Waverley's rate. Working at home was more common amongst women than men in the workforce.

Around 250 people in the workforce did not attend work on Census day, representing 8% of the workforce (compared with 8% for Waverley). Some 87 people were unemployed, while the others may have been employed only part-time or having a day off.

Of those travelling to work, the most common means were by train (34% of the trips) and by car as driver (33%). Compared with Waverley, there were larger proportions travelling by train and smaller proportions travelling by bus.

Since 1996, the number travelling to work in Bondi Junction increased by 4% while their travel patterns changed little. The number travelling by car increased by 1% with the number of drivers stable. The number travelling by public transport (train, bus, ferry etc) increased by 12% with travel by bus up by 18%.

The proportion of workers using only their own effort to get to work was much greater than Waverley with 9.8% walking and 0.5% cycling, a total of 317 people. The number walking to work fell by 6% since 1996 while the number cycling fell by 21%, but the numbers were small.

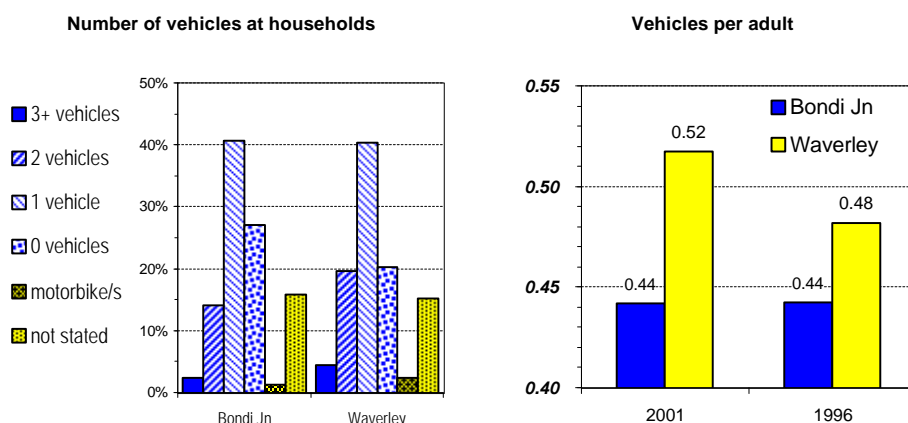

Vehicle ownership in Bondi Junction

There were some 2,310 registered motor vehicles owned or used by Bondi Junction's people and parked at or near their homes on Census night 2001. This is an average of 0.9 vehicles per household or 0.44 vehicles for every person aged 18+. Vehicle ownership was less than Waverley's, which had 1.1 vehicles per household or 0.52 vehicles for every adult.

Vehicle ownership per household increased over 1996-2001 by 6.6%, compared with the rise of 11.6% for Waverley, while ownership per adult went from an average of 0.44 to 0.44 over this period.

Most commonly, Bondi Junction households had 1 vehicle, parked at 41% of households. Some 27% of households had no vehicles, a proportion which was one third larger than Waverley's car-less rate of 20%. Some 2% of households had three or more vehicles, which was half of Waverley's rate.

School students in Bondi Junction

In 2001, Bondi Junction was home to 55 pre-schoolers, 215 infant and primary students and 198 high school students. Compared with 1996, attendance was stable at preschool; decreased at infants / primary school by 13; and decreased at high school by 69 students.

Bondi Junction's overall school participation rates differ from Waverley's. For pre-school students, the participation rate is 57% (Waverley's is 60%); for primary students, 73% (82%); and for high school students, 69% (79%).

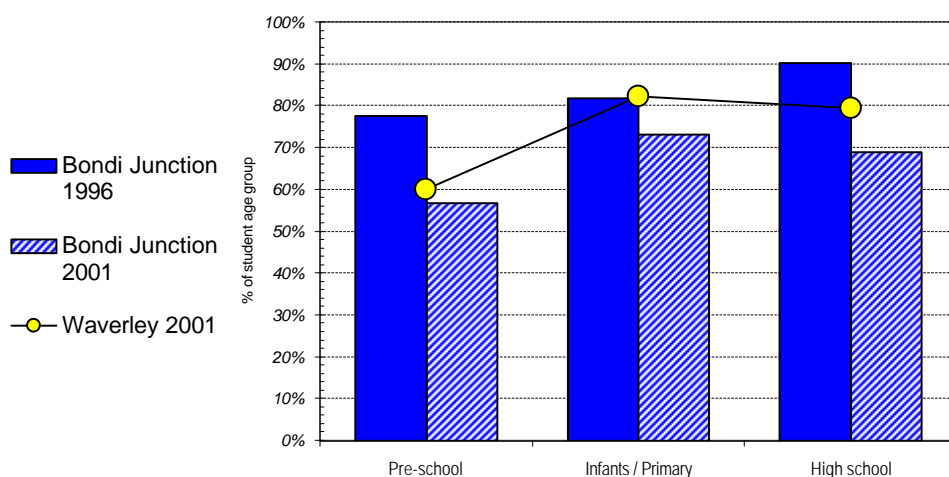
These participation rates are calculated by dividing the number attending school by the school-age population. The most common ages of school students (in August, when the Census was taken) are 3-4 years old for pre-school; 5-11 for primary school and 12-17 for high school. Although children start and finish school at various ages, this 'participation rate' provides a good indicator of school attendance.

* Lower participation rates at pre-school can indicate a shortage of pre-school places or a supply of alternative child care services.

* Lower participation rates at primary school, when attendance is compulsory, suggests the student population is reduced by late-starters or young-finishers.

* Lower rates for high school usually indicate more students leaving school before finishing Year 12.

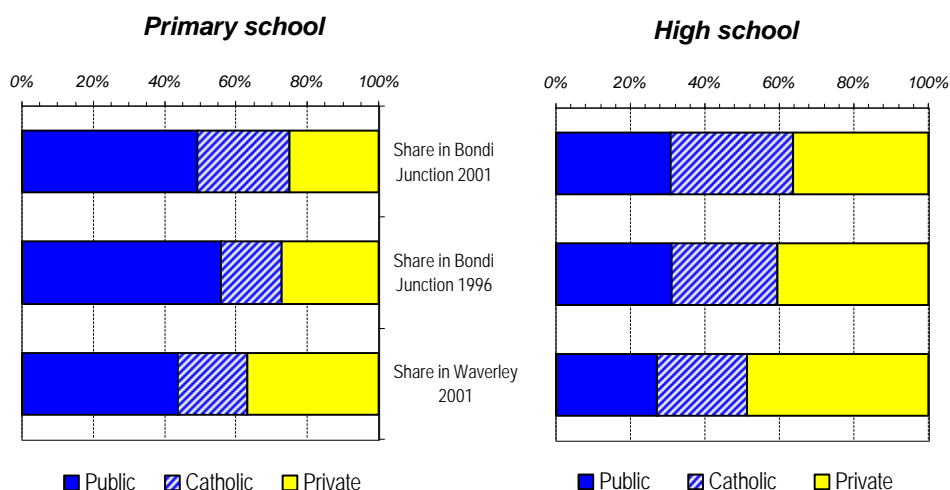

The public / private school choice

In Bondi Junction in 2001, 49% of primary students and 31% of secondary students attended public schools. These proportions were higher than Waverley's (44% and 27% respectively) but overall were down since 1996 (56% and 31%).

Attendance at Catholic schools (by 26% of primary and 33% of secondary students) was at a higher rate than Waverley (19% and 24% respectively). Non-Catholic private schools attracted 25% of primary and 36% of secondary students, much lower than Waverley's rates of 37% and 49%.

Bondi Junction's tertiary students

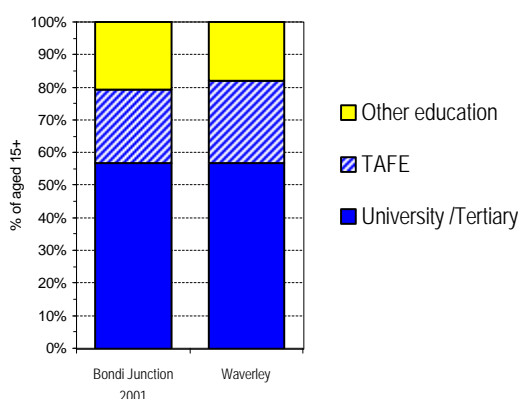
Bondi Junction had a total of 714 people studying at university, TAFE or other tertiary places in 2001, with just over half attending full-time. The number of students was equivalent to 104% of the number of 18-24 year-olds living in Bondi Junction, compared with 99% for Waverley, suggesting Bondi Junction has similar participation in tertiary education by those aged over 25 years. Participation in tertiary education amongst women is similar to amongst men (equivalent to 107% of the 18-24 year-old female population, 100% of the male).

There were 406 university students (49% male and 51% female), an increase of 25 since 1996. About three-fifths of Bondi Junction's university students attended full-time. The number of university students represented 59% of the 18-24 year old population.

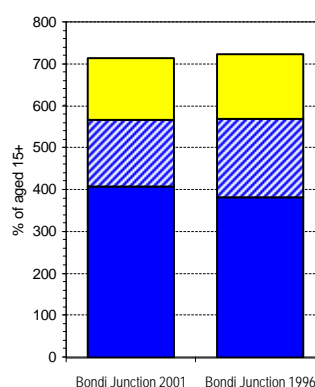
Some three-fifths of Bondi Junction's 160 TAFE students attended part-time. The majority of students were women with 70 men to 90 women. TAFE numbers were equivalent to 23% of the 18-24 year old population.

Bondi Junction's tertiary students were about as likely to be at university than Waverley's, with 57% of students at university when the Waverley proportion was 57%. They were as likely to be at TAFE, attended by 22% of the student population compared with 25%.

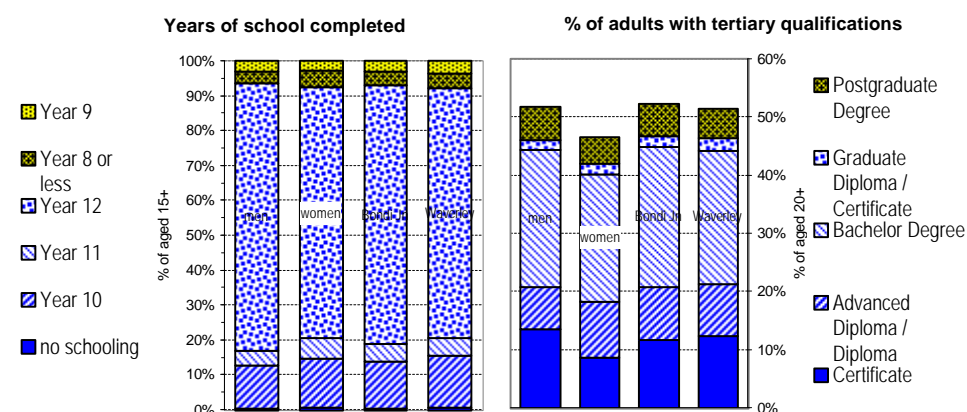
Bondi Junction's education levels

The average number of years of school completed by adults is a good indicator of the overall education of a community. In Bondi Junction, the average final year of school was Year 11.35 meaning a 'typical' adult left school after completing 11 years and 4 months. This was similar to Waverley's average.

Some 74% of Bondi Junction's adults completed Year 12, while 7% left school before completing Year 10. By way of comparison, 72% of Waverley's adults completed Year 12 and 8% left school before completing Year 10. The Year 12 completion rate for men in Bondi Junction was much greater than women's (77% to 72%).

Bondi Junction's tertiary education levels were similar to Waverley's, with 52% of people aged 15+ having a tertiary qualification, versus 51% for Waverley. The biggest difference was in the number with a Bachelor Degree (24.1% of Bondi Junction's adults compared with 22.9% of Waverley's).

Since 1996, the fastest growing qualifications in Bondi Junction were Bachelor Degrees, up by 266 and Certificates, up by 115.

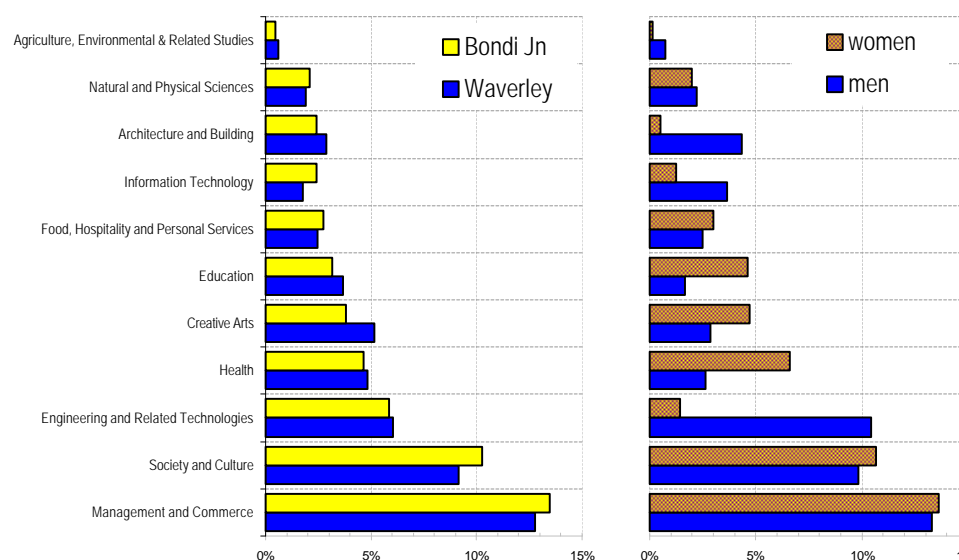

Fields of qualifications

The most common fields in which Bondi Junction residents had tertiary or other non-school qualifications at July 2001 were Management and Commerce with around 710 workers, followed by Society and Culture with about 540, Engineering and Related Technologies with about 310, and Health with some 240 workers.

Overall, 66% of Bondi Junction people aged 15+ (68% of men and 63% of women) had tertiary qualifications in 2001, while Waverley averaged 65%. The major variations from Waverley were that training was more common in Society and Culture, in Management and Commerce and in Information Technology; but less common in Creative Arts, and in Education.

Between men and women in Bondi Junction, the main differences were that women were more likely to be qualified in Health; Education; Creative Arts; and Society and Culture. Men were more often qualified in Engineering and Related Technologies; Architecture and Building; Information Technology; and Agriculture, Environmental & Related Studies.

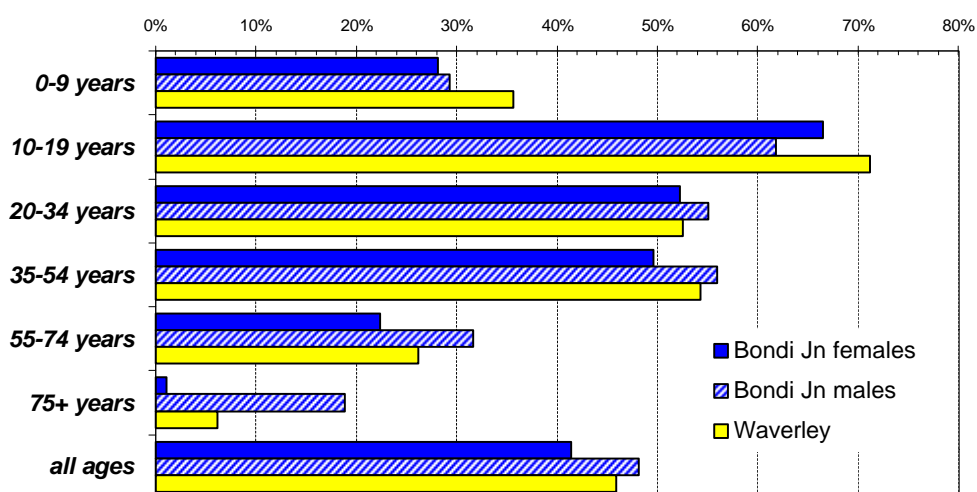
Computer use in Bondi Junction

Computer usage in Bondi Junction is similar to the Waverley average, with 45% of the population (some 2,700 people) using a computer in the week preceding the 2001 Census, compared with 46% for Waverley. The age group most different from Waverley in computer usage was 10-19 years old, whose usage was 7 percentage points below Waverley's, at 64%.

Computer usage among age groups ranged from a maximum of 64% among 10-19 years olds to the lowest usage of 8% among those aged 75+ years old.

Computer usage by males is generally greater than for females, and this difference tends to increase with age. In Bondi Junction, 48% of males and 41% of females used a computer in 2001. The greatest gender difference is for people aged 75+ years old, when 19% of men use computers compared with 1% of women.

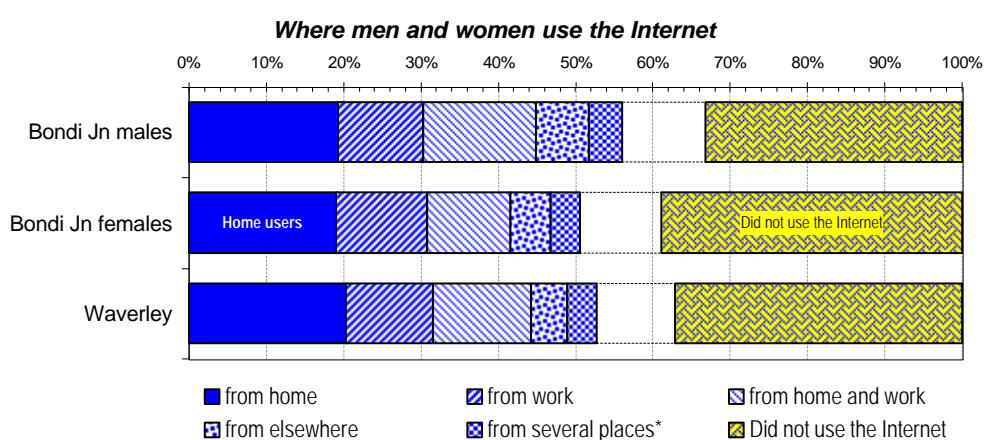
Internet usage in Bondi Junction

Half of Bondi Junction's people (53%) used the Internet in the week prior to the 2001 Census, similar to 53% over Waverley. Some 51% of women used the Internet, a lower proportion than for men (56%).

The main places where people in Bondi Junction used the Internet were at home (19%), at work (11%) and at both home and work (13%). Compared with Waverley, Bondi Junction had higher proportions using the Internet from elsewhere (1.3 percentage points above Waverley) and lower proportions using the Internet from home (1.1 percentage points below Waverley).

Among home computer users, women more often used the Internet - some 46% of women and 40% of men using their home computer accessed the Internet over the Census week. By way of comparison, among Waverley's home computer users, 47% of women and 42% of men used the Internet that week.

Some 690 people used the Internet at work, representing 22% of the employed workforce of around 3,100. This was similar to Waverley's rate of 21%. Internet usage amongst male workers in Bondi Junction was 20% while amongst female workers it was 25%.

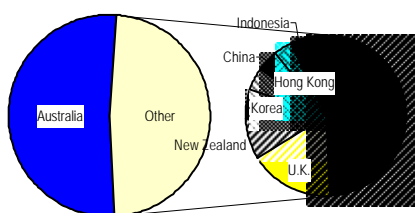

Birthplaces of Bondi Junction's people

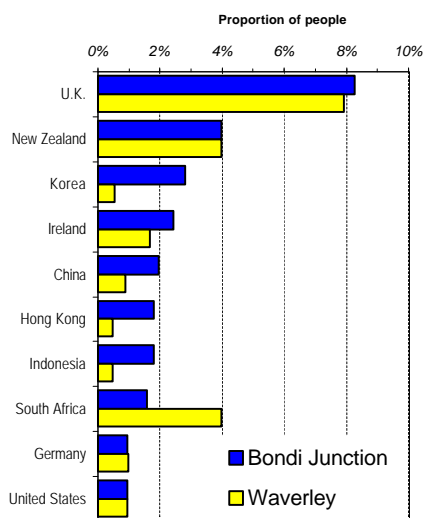
Some 2,740 of Bondi Junction's people (46%) were born in Australia with 2,603 (43%) born overseas. The proportion born overseas was greater than Waverley's rate of 37%, and their number was up by 67 since 1996. The most common foreign birthplaces in Bondi Junction were U.K. with 434 people, followed by New Zealand with 208, Korea with 146 and Ireland with 126 people.

The biggest increases since 1996 were among those born in U.K. (up by 37 people), Ireland (up by 35) and Yugoslavia (up by 25). The overseas-born populations with the biggest falls were from Indonesia (down by 37), Hong Kong (down by 32) and Philippines (down by 22). Falls are usually most common among post-war European immigrant communities due to ageing.

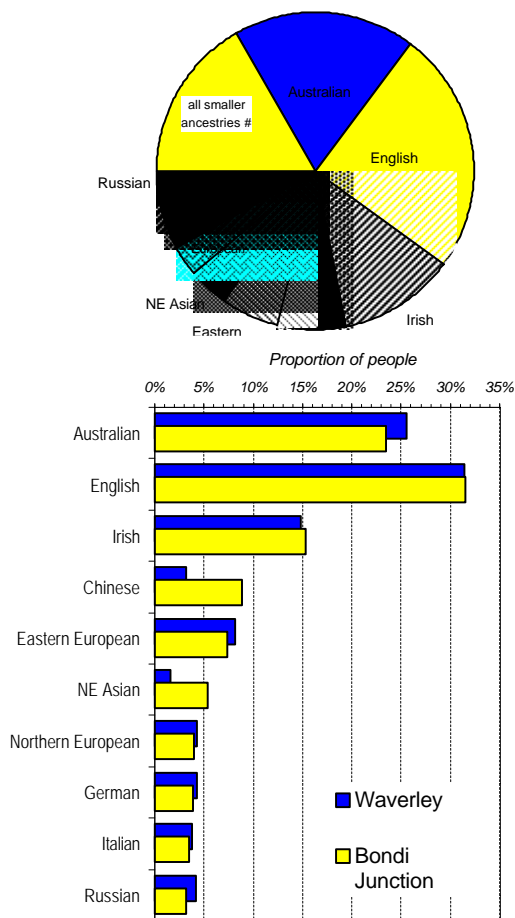
Ancestry of Bondi Junction's people

The 2001 Census was the first to ask people to describe their ancestry. Some people gave multiple answers. In Bondi Junction, only 23% gave their ancestry as Australian. Of the others, the most commonly cited ancestry was English (31%) followed by Irish (15%), Chinese (9%), Eastern European (7%), NE Asian and Northern European.

Compared with Waverley, the biggest differences in the common ancestries of Bondi Junction were the larger proportions of people with Chinese ancestry (8.7% versus 3.0%), NE Asian ancestry (5.3% versus 1.5%), and Irish ancestry (15.2% and 14.8%). There were smaller proportions with Sub-Saharan African (0.9% versus 3.2%), Australian (23.4% versus 25.4%) and N Africa & Mid East ancestry (2.7% versus 4.6%).

Bondi Junction's indigenous population in 2001 was about 24 (24 Aboriginals). They constituted 0.4% of the population compared with 0.3% over Waverley. Over 1996-2001, the indigenous population of 18 males and 6 females was static, while Waverley's changed - 15%.

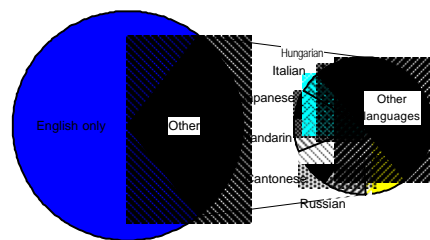
Languages spoken at home

While 71% of Bondi Junction's people speak English in their homes, 29% speak another language (compared with 22% in Waverley). The most commonly spoken language in 2001 was Korean, spoken by 155 people (2.9%), followed by Russian (152 or 2.8%), then Cantonese, Mandarin, Japanese and Italian.

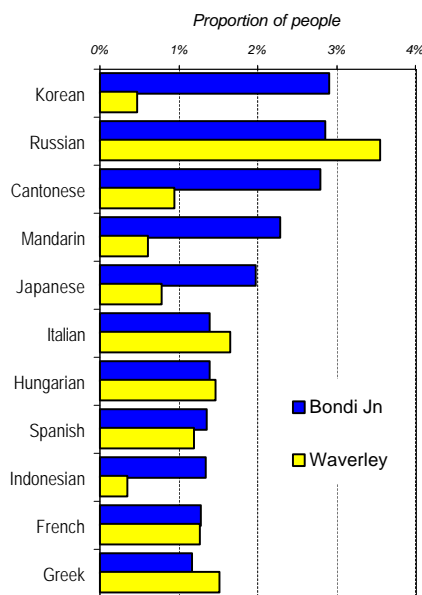
Among the common foreign languages spoken at home, Bondi Junction differed most from Waverley with Korean (spoken by 6.3 times the proportion of people of Waverley), Indonesian (spoken by 4.0 times), and Mandarin (spoken by 3.8 times Waverley's proportion). On the other hand, of languages spoken here, Greek, Russian and Italian were spoken by proportionally fewer people.

Bondi Junction's fastest growing community languages were Mandarin, spoken by 47 more people than in 1996; Russian, spoken by 39 more, and Hungarian, spoken by 39 more. The biggest falls were in Indonesian, down by 38 from 1996, and other Chinese, down by 28.

Among local indigenous people, none spoke indigenous languages at home. In Waverley, 3% of the indigenous people did so.

Immigration patterns and English proficiency

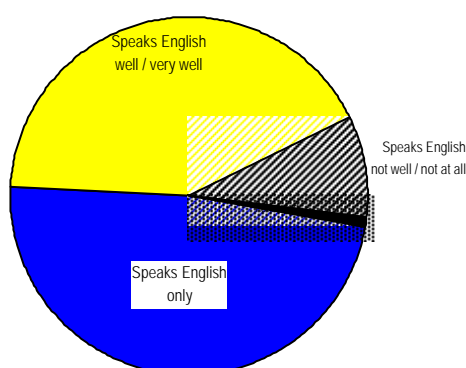
Bondi Junction's population of people born overseas increased by 165 from 1996 to 2001. This included some 862 people who arrived from overseas over 1996-2001, with the balance accounted for by a net movement out of Bondi Junction of about 700 overseas-born people.

Compared with Waverley, Bondi Junction has more recent immigrants, with 21% of the overseas-born population arriving over 1999-2001, and a further 12% over 1996-1998, while Waverley's rates were 16% and 10%.

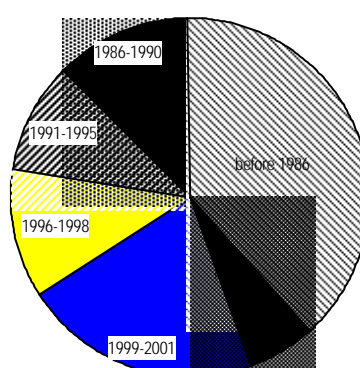
Of the 2,600 or so people born overseas, half (48%) speak only English and a further 42% speak English well. However, 9% of the overseas-born (around 240 people) are poor speakers of English. About two-fifths of the poor English speakers arrived in the past six years. About one quarter arrived more than 15 years ago.

Bondi Junction's recent immigrants are more likely to be poor English speakers than Waverley's, with 15% of those who arrived over 1999-2001 and 5% of those who arrived over 1996-1998 being weak at English, compared with 7% and 6% across Waverley. This suggests that Bondi Junction had proportionally more immigrants from non-English-speaking countries than average for Waverley.

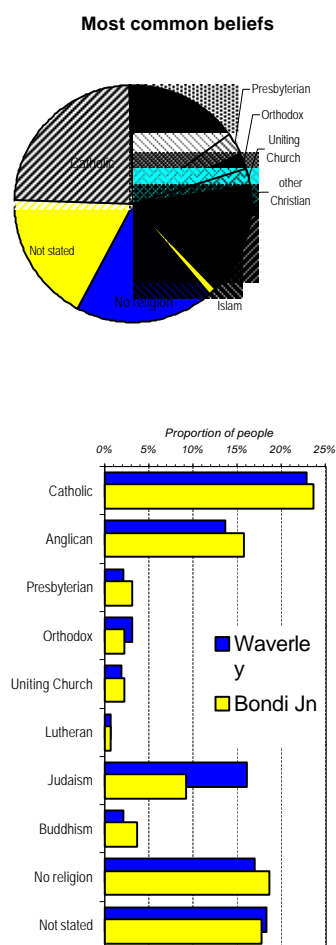

Religion in Bondi Junction

Bondi Junction's main religious belief in 2001 was Christianity, followed by 49% of the community. The main Christian churches were Catholic (24%), Anglican (16%), Presbyterian (3%) and Orthodox (2%). The most significant differences from Waverley among Christian beliefs were Bondi Junction's larger Anglican and Presbyterian communities (2.1% and 0.9% more of the population than in Waverley), and the smaller Orthodox and Pentecostal communities (0.8% and 0.2% percent less).

The most common non-Christian religion was Judaism, with 548 followers or 9.1% of the community (16.% for Waverley). Other religions included Buddhism with 216 followers and Islam with 63 followers.

From 1996 to 2001, the religion with the largest increase was Judaism with a rise of 100 while the biggest fall was 21 for Presbyterian. By comparison, the number of people with no religion fell by 226 but the number who did not give their religion rose by 413.
