## THE BIG SING 2011

This year 58 Auckland choirs took part in the Big Sing choral festival and competition, including *Sublimitas*, the Massey High School choir of 50 students, prepared by Mr Loretz, Mr Tipi and Head Boy Metitilani Alo. The choir sang three works: a Renaissance motet by Palestrina entitled "Sicut Cervus", a gospel spiritual "Aina that Good News" by William Dawson and the world premiere of "Ave Lo'u Ola", composed by Metitilani Alo (13MAL). The latter work was performed again last Wednesday night at the adjudicator's request to a packed Town Hall for the Gala Concert. The work received a sustained standing ovation for both performances and delighted the audience with its intricate blending of four voice choir, piano, karanga, haka, fa'ataupati, Cook Island percussion and putatara. For this piece, *Sublimitas* won the top award for the performance of a New Zealand work, one of the three main categories of the festival that must be offered by each participating choir.
