Situated on the U.S. border, Ciudad Juarez is the lynchpin of a major drug trafficking route, and has one of the highest homicide rates in Mexico. Murder-for-hire can be had for \$50. The city's resulting decline and lack of good schools has pushed more and more young people into deadly drug cartels. Photojournalist Dominic Bracco II has spent over two years documenting the lives of these youth, who are known as Los Ninis — short for "ni trabaja, ni estudia" (neither work nor study).
