On behalf of all of us here at The New York Racing Association, Inc. (NYRA), welcome to the 2012 racing season - truly a new era for New York racing.

By the end of 2012, NYRA anticipates showing a profit for the first time in 11 years. On-track attendance and handle are expected to continue the positive trends of 2011, during which time NYRA's account wagering was up 96.5 percent to \$233 million, with on-track handle up 59 percent to \$625 million, and on-track attendance up 10.2 percent to 1,809,865 fans. Continuing to forge ahead in the wake of the closure of New York City Off-Track Betting in late 2010, we are pursuing plans to operate pari-mutuel wagering in 10 bars and restaurants in New York City, with further expansion planned once approved.

The opening of Genting's Resorts World Casino New York City in October has provided an immediate benefit to all stakeholders, providing a new stream of revenue for the state and giving New York's entire thoroughbred industry a financial boost. Ensuring the highest quality of racing, purses for stakes at the upcoming spring/summer meet at Belmont Park will increase more than 26 percent to \$9.5 million, with the stakes purses at Saratoga Race Course increasing 27 percent to \$13.35 million. With overall purses at Aqueduct Racetrack having increased by more than \$8.6 million, the larger purse structure is helping attract top owners, trainers and horses to our tracks, creating larger and more attractive fields for our customers and generating higher handle.

Additionally, thanks to casino revenue, increased incentive awards from the New York Thoroughbred Breeding and Development Fund are bringing quality stallions into the state, which will not only help improve the breed but create and sustain agricultural jobs across New York.

Capital improvements from the gaming revenue include a state-of-the-art sports bar and simulcast center at Aqueduct and 21 potential projects for Saratoga Race Course. These major improvements to Saratoga's backstretch and frontside will allow our crown jewel to grow and flourish while preserving its unique historic integrity. Finally, there are a number of projects in the planning stages at Belmont Park.

As befits the tradition of world-class racing at Saratoga, NYRA and NBC Sports Group have extended "Saturdays at Saratoga" for two more years, the most extensive live national broadcast presence ever of racing at the track. In 2011, Saratoga was the setting for some of racing's brightest stars, among them Horse of the Year Havre de Grace, Three-Year-Old Filly champion Royal Delta, and Two-Year-Old Filly champion My Miss Aurelia, and 2012 promises to provide even more memorable moments.

We hope you enjoy the 2012 Media Guide and the history contained within its pages. The future of New York racing has never been brighter and we are committed to ensuring its continued growth.

A History of The New York Racing Association

Created more than 50 years ago so that New York State could share in the boom in racing that followed World War II, The New York Racing Association, Inc., holds the exclusive right to conduct racing at Aqueduct, Belmont Park, and Saratoga until 2033.

NYRA's beginnings date back to 1955, when the Greater New York Association acquired the assets of the four racing associations operating Belmont, Jamaica, Saratoga and Aqueduct racetracks.

Within four years, the NYRA had demolished the old Aqueduct and in 1959 opened the modern Aqueduct. Jamaica Race Track was closed down the same year and its property sold for use as a housing development. From 1963 through 1968, Belmont Park was shuttered as a new grandstand was built.

In 2011, a new era began at Aqueduct Racetrack with the opening of the Resorts World New York City Casino. Operated by Genting New York LLC, revenue from the casino is directed to help education in the state as well as ensure long-term stability for the racing industry.

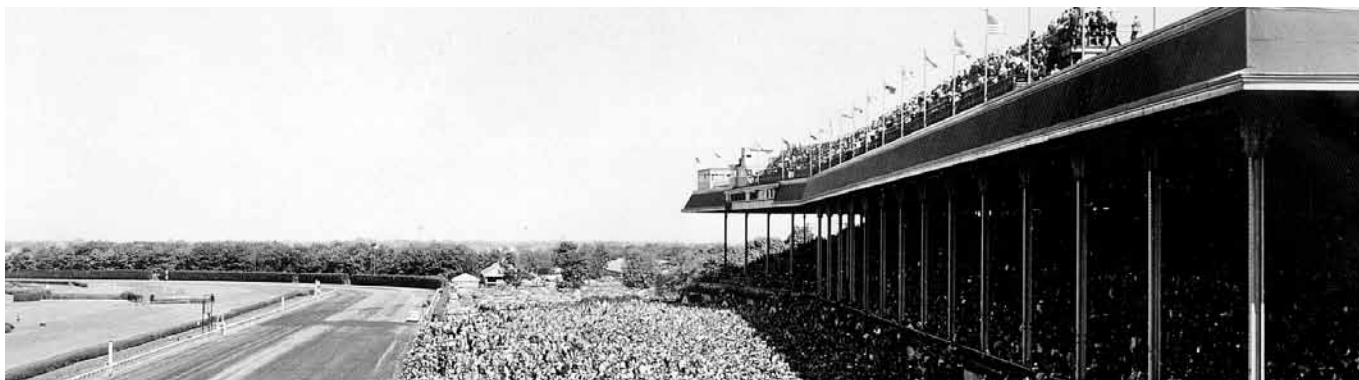
NYRA tracks are the cornerstone of the state's thoroughbred business, which contributes more than \$2 billion annually to New York State's urban, suburban and rural economy.

In 2011, more than 1.8 million people attended the live races at NYRA tracks. Factoring in nationwide off-track wagering, the average daily betting handle on NYRA races totals more than \$8.1 million.

C. STEVEN DUNCKER

C. Steven Duncker is the Chairman of The New York Racing Association, Inc. In 2003, Mr. Duncker was elected Vice Chairman of the Board and Co-Chief Operating Officer of NYRA. Prior to being elected Vice Chairman, Mr. Duncker served on the Board since 1999.

In 1980, Mr. Duncker graduated Cum Laude from Duke University and attended the J. L. Kellogg Graduate School of Management, Northwestern University, where he received his MM, Finance in 1982. Immediately following, Mr. Duncker was hired by Goldman Sachs & Company, where he first worked in St. Louis, then Chicago. Mr. Duncker moved to New York and became Vice President in 1986 and was named Partner in 1996. In 2001, Mr. Duncker retired as Partner after successfully running the Global Credit Derivative Department.

Boards on which Mr. Duncker serves include the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders' Association, The Jockey Club Information Systems and Equibase, Inc. He is the Founder and Trustee of the C. Steven Duncker Foundation, which is dedicated to providing educational opportunities to disadvantaged children. Other charitable affiliations include The Jockey Club Safety Net Foundation, which is dedicated to helping the disadvantaged in the racing industry.

Mr. Duncker is an avid thoroughbred owner and breeder racing in New York, New Jersey, Kentucky and Florida.

Mr. Duncker and his wife, Melinda, son, Teddy, and daughter, Haley Elle, reside in Palm Beach, FL and Saratoga Springs, NY.



CHARLES E. HAYWARD

Charles E. Hayward was appointed to his current position as President and CEO of The New York Racing Association, Inc. in November of 2004.

Graduated Cum Laude from Bowdoin College, Mr. Hayward is a current resident of Manhattan and Saratoga Springs, NY, and is married to Manhattan art gallery owner Betsy Senior.

Hayward is former President and CEO of the Daily Racing Form and before that was the President and CEO of Little, Brown Publishing.

He also held executive roles in Simon & Schuster Publishers, HP Books and MacMillan Publishing.

Mr. Hayward currently serves on the Boards of the National Thoroughbred Racing Association, Thoroughbred Racing Protective Bureau, Thoroughbred Racing Association and on the NYRA Board, as he previously did from 1995 to 1999. In 2011, he was elected to The Jockey Club.

Mr. Hayward has been a horse racing fan for more than 30 years and a thoroughbred owner for the last decade.



ELLEN MCCLAIN

Ellen McClain joined NYRA in 2009 as senior vice president and chief financial officer, and in 2011 was promoted to her current position of Executive Vice President and Chief Operating Officer.

From 2004 to 2009, Ms. McClain served as the vice president of finance for Hearst-Argyle Television, Inc., a publicly traded group operator of 29 local television stations. From 1993 to 2004, she served as the senior vice president and chief financial officer for the Granite Broadcasting Corporation, a publicly-traded entrepreneurial group-owner of eight local television stations.

McClain began her career as a media lender, first

at CIBC and before that, Bank of New England, N.A., where she worked with clients in the television, radio and cable industries.

She boasts a 25-year track record in management and media finance and operations, including board membership on the National Thoroughbred Racing Association (NTRA), the Media Financial Management Association and the National Association of Black Owned Broadcasters. NYRA: ON-AIR

After 2011's successful reunion of the Grade 1, \$1 million Belmont Stakes with the first two jewels of the Triple Crown on NBC for the first time since 2005, NYRA and the NBC Sports Group inked an agreement to broadcast live from Saratoga Race Course over seven weekends during the 2011 Spa meet. "Summer at Saratoga" marked the most extensive live, national broadcast of racing from the historic track, including three hour-long shows on NBC and five on VERSUS, which has since been renamed the NBC Sports Network. After a favorable inaugural season, "Summer at Saratoga" was extended for an additional two seasons through 2013.

"The NBC Sports Group's landmark coverage of this past Saratoga meet was phenomenal," said NYRA President and CEO Charles Hayward. "NBC took everything that is special about Saratoga, from the incredible racing to the unparalleled fan experience to the storied history and beauty of the track and the town, and conveyed those elements to viewers across the country. We are very excited to extend this partnership for at least two more years, and are already looking forward to the 2012 meet."

NYRA expanded its television operations following the closure of NYCOTB in December, 2010. Racing fans can tune in to Channel 71 on Time Warner or Channel 27 on Verizon FIOS – the former home of the NYCOTB Racing Network – to watch the NYRA Network, which features live coverage of NYRA racing and simulcast signals from around the country. Simulcasting continues following the NYRA races, with coverage ending with the conclusion of racing at Yonkers Raceway. On dark days, NYRA broadcasts The NYRA Network Presents Raceday, which airs from noon – 6 p.m. and spotlights simulcast racing from around the country.

The NYRA Network is also the home of The National Racing Report, which on Saturdays previews upcoming stakes races in North America and on Wednesdays recaps the previous week's stakes action. On holiday weeks with live racing Monday at NYRA tracks, the recap show usually airs on Thursday instead of Wednesday.

In addition to the coverage on the NYRA Network, MSG Plus currently telecasts "Aqueduct/Belmont Park/Saratoga in 30," a daily half-hour race-replay show, and "Thoroughbred Weekly," a weekly half-hour show which includes timely features and races of the week.

NYRA Rewards account holders can also watch live video streams from Aqueduct, Belmont, Saratoga, and many other tracks in North America at NYRARewards.com. The free service returns the largest rebates among all account wagering platforms based in the United States and allows horseplayers to earn cash back for wagers made on track, through the NYRA Rewards telephone service, on mobile devices, and on the NYRA Rewards website.

Fully committed to offering fans an interactive and cutting edge experience, NYRA was one of the first horse racing organizations to embrace social media and maintains a robust presence on Facebook, Twitter and YouTube via the organization's official channel, YouTube.com/nyravideo.

In January 2012, the NYRA2 platform for NYRA Rewards debuted, allowing customers to wager faster with advanced bet building and swifter processing, watch live streaming video of two racetracks simultaneously, and live chat with support analysts to troubleshoot problems. NYRA began offering live video streaming to NYRARewards.com users in December 2010.

The first floor features the Times Square Casino and offers visitors first-class dining selections from around the world – from seasonal and international offerings at the Aqueduct Buffet to an extensive variety of options in the new food court, including Wolfgang Puck Express, the Stage Deli, and Queens Burger, sure to become a local favorite.

On the second floor, visitors can partake in exquisite fine dining selections from around the world at Genting Palace and RW Prime Steakhouse and higher level members can enjoy an enhanced gaming experience on the Fifth Avenue Casino floor. Including the Breeders' Cup, which he called from its inception in 1984 through 2005, and the Triple Crown, which he called through 2010, Durkin has called races at more than 50 tracks in six countries.





NYRA AND THE COMMUNITY

The New York Racing Association, Inc. (NYRA) is committed to upholding the ideals of community service and support, both within thoroughbred racing and in the communities surrounding Aqueduct Racetrack, Belmont Park, and Saratoga Race Course.

Among the industry-related groups receiving ongoing support from NYRA are the Belmont Child Care Association, which established Anna House, the on-site child care center at Belmont Park for the benefit of working families at the track, the Backstretch Employee Services Team (B.E.S.T), which provides a wide range of health and human services to workers in the barn areas of our three racetracks, and the Backstretch Education Fund, which provides educational opportunities for backstretch workers. NYRA also is a supporter of the New York Racetrack Chaplaincy, the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation, Old Friends, the Grayson-Jockey Club Research Foundation, the Permanently Disabled Jockeys Fund, and the Race for Education.

National organizations which receive support from NYRA include the Breast Cancer Research Foundation, the American Red Cross, Special Olympics, Ronald McDonald House, the Muscular Dystrophy Foundation, the Make-A-Wish Foundation, and Toys for Tots.

In 2011, NYRA's Director of Community Relations, Joanne Adams, was selected as one of thoroughbred racing's "Unsung Heroes" by the *Thoroughbred Times* and was also named 2011 Businessperson of the Year by the Floral Park Chamber of Commerce.

NYRA leadership at every level is visibly committed to good corporate citizenship: Chairman C. Steven Duncker is the Founder and Trustee of the C. Steven Duncker Foundation, which is dedicated to providing educational opportunities to disadvantaged children. President and CEO Charles Hayward was elected as a member of The Jockey Club in 2011, and has been honored in recent years for his outstanding leadership in the communities surrounding NYRA's three racetracks.

In December, NYRA was proud to welcome back Major Chuck Kilbride and the U.S. Marine Corps as they returned to Aqueduct Racetrack for the Annual Toys for Tots Campaign. NYRA matched all financial donations made by trainers and owners to the drive with more than \$40,000 raised. Hayward and Adams both have been named Honorary Chairs of the Toys for Tots Campaign.

At Saratoga Race Course, NYRA offers the Community Outreach Booth, which provides local charities and organizations the opportunity to provide information about their mission and raise much-needed funds. NYRA also donates the Community Outreach Box in the clubhouse for the entire Saratoga season, which gives groups an additional opportunity to raise funds through charity auctions. At Belmont Park, NYRA hosts annual community days for Elmont, Floral Park, and Garden City.



HAVRE DE GRACE & RAMON DOMINGUEZ

YEAR IN REVIEW

2011

If 2011 was any indication, then The New York Racing Association, Inc. (NYRA) continues to provide the premier path to Eclipse Award glory. Of the 10 equine Eclipse Award winners, five of them won at least one race at a NYRA track in 2011. All three human Eclipse Award winners – Outstanding Jockey Ramon Dominguez, Outstanding Trainer Bill Mott, and Outstanding Owner Ken and Sarah Ramsey – were regular participants on the NYRA circuit in 2011.

Havre de Grace and Dominguez teamed up to win Saratoga Race Course's Woodward, with the 4-year-old becoming the second filly in three years to defeat males in the prestigious 1 1/8-mile race. Just as with 2009 Woodward winner Rachel Alexandra, Havre de Grace was later named Horse of the Year, the third straight female to garner the title.

Three other females also used the NYRA circuit as a steppingstone to the Eclipse Awards. Mott oversaw the development of Royal Delta, who drew clear to a 5 1/2-length score in the Alabama, and two starts later cemented Champion 3-Year-Old Filly honors with a win in the Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic. My Miss Aurelia, the Champion 2-Year-Old Filly, made her first three starts at NYRA tracks, breaking her maiden on debut and winning the

Adirondack at Saratoga, before running away with the Frizette at Belmont. She concluded her unbeaten campaign with an easy win in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. Stacelita, already a Classic winner in France, was named Champion Female Turf Horse based on a pair of United States stakes victories, including the Flower Bowl Invitational at Belmont with Dominguez in the saddle.

Champion Male Turf Horse went to Cape Blanco, who was based in Ireland but made three trips across the Atlantic Ocean in 2011. Each trip was rewarded with a Grade 1 triumph, including wins in Belmont's Man o' War in July and Joe Hirsch Turf Classic Invitational in October.

In addition to his Woodward, Beldame, and Flower Bowl victories, Dominguez won major races in New York throughout the year, taking Aqueduct Racetrack's Gotham with Stay Thirsty, Saratoga's Spinaway with Grace Hall, and Belmont's Empire Classic with Haynesfield. Dominguez topped the year-end NYRA jockey standings for the third straight year, winning 321 races. His mounts earned nearly \$20.3 million, best in the country for the second straight year, edging fellow New York-based riders John Velazquez and Javier Castellano. In 2011, Dominguez won five



races at Aqueduct Racetrack on January 8 and November 24, made six trips to the winner's circle at Belmont on June 5, and won seven straight races spanning December 14 and 15 at the Big A.

Mott concluded 2011 in strong fashion, winning the Breeders' Cup Classic with 2010 Belmont Stakes winner Drosselmeyer, the Ladies' Classic with the aforementioned Royal Delta, and the Cigar Mile Handicap with To Honor and Serve.

On April 9, Aqueduct hosted its largest Resorts World Casino New York City Wood Memorial Day crowd since 2004 when 12,144 watched Toby's Corner and jockey Eddie Castro prevail by a neck in the 87th running of the race, with 1-10 favorite and previously undefeated juvenile champion Uncle Mo finishing 1 ¼ lengths behind the winner in third.

Tizway emerged as a leader of the older male division with a 2 ¾-length decision in the Metropolitan Handicap, and his final time of 1:32.90 made it the second-fastest running in the race's 119-year history. Ridden by Rajiv Maragh for trainer Jim Bond, Tizway made one more start, defeating 10 opponents in a deep renewal of the Whitney Handicap in August at Saratoga.

The 143rd edition of the Belmont Stakes, contested June 11, attracted 12 sophomores, including Kentucky Derby winner Animal Kingdom and Preakness hero Shackleford, marking the 22nd time the winners of the first two Triple Crown

races had a rubber match in the 1 ½-mile "Test of the Champion." The day belonged to Ruler On Ice, however, as the gelding stalked the pace and turned back a late bid from Stay Thirsty to win by three-quarters of a length, giving jockey Jose Valdivia, Jr. and trainer Kelly Breen their first victories in a Triple Crown race. Shackleford faded to fifth after setting the pace, while Animal Kingdom finished sixth after being cut off at the start.

Stay Thirsty stepped out of the long shadow cast by fellow Repole Stable-representative Uncle Mo with a 1 ¼-length win in the 142nd Travers, respectively giving jockey Javier Castellano and trainer Todd Pletcher their third and second victories in the centerpiece of the Saratoga meet.

Belmont's Super Saturday card featured six graded stakes, including five Grade 1 events. In addition to Stacelita and Cape Blanco's triumphs in the Flower Bowl and Joe Hirsch Turf Classic, New York-bred Giant Ryan took the Vosburgh, Uncle Mo regained winning form with a brilliant score in the Kelso Handicap, and Havre de Grace humbled her opponents in the Beldame. In the final October 1 stakes, Flat Out and trainer Scooter Dickey won their first Grade 1 race with a 2 ¼-length decision over Drosselmeyer in the Jockey Club Gold Cup.

One week later, Corey Nakatani joined Dominguez as the second jockey to win six races on a single card at a NYRA track in 2011, including the Frizette aboard My Miss Aurelia. Union Rags, who had already

captured the Three Chimneys Saratoga Special, added another stakes score with a 5 ¼-length domination of the Champagne with Castellano aboard for trainer Michael Matz.

New York-bred Haynesfield, who won the Jockey Club Gold Cup in 2010, added his second McMahan Adena Empire Classic on October 22, having previously won the New York Showcase Day feature in 2009.

Pletcher repeated as NYRA's leading trainer by wins, marking the fourth time in his career he topped the list. Among his 118 victories were Grade 1 scores in the Ogden Phipps, Mother Goose, Prioress, Ballerina, and Travers.

The leading owner on the NYRA circuit by wins in 2011 was Flying Zee Stable, whose principle, Carl Lizza, died in July. Lizza, who campaigned Wayward Lass, Cosmonaut, and Noble Nashua, added one final graded stakes win in June when Street Game captured the Hill Prince. In October, Flying Zee, now operated by his wife, Viane, took the Miss Grillo with Pure Gossip and unveiled promising sprinter Agave Kiss.

Other notable deaths in 2011 included Stonestreet Stable owner Jess Jackson, who campaigned Horses of the Year Curlin and Rachel Alexandra; Joseph Cornacchia, who co-owned Kentucky Derby winners Strike the Gold and Go for Gin; Dr. Manuel Gilman, a former chief examining veterinarian for NYRA; and Peter Ferriola, a three-time NYRA leading trainer.

AQUEDUCT RACE TRACK

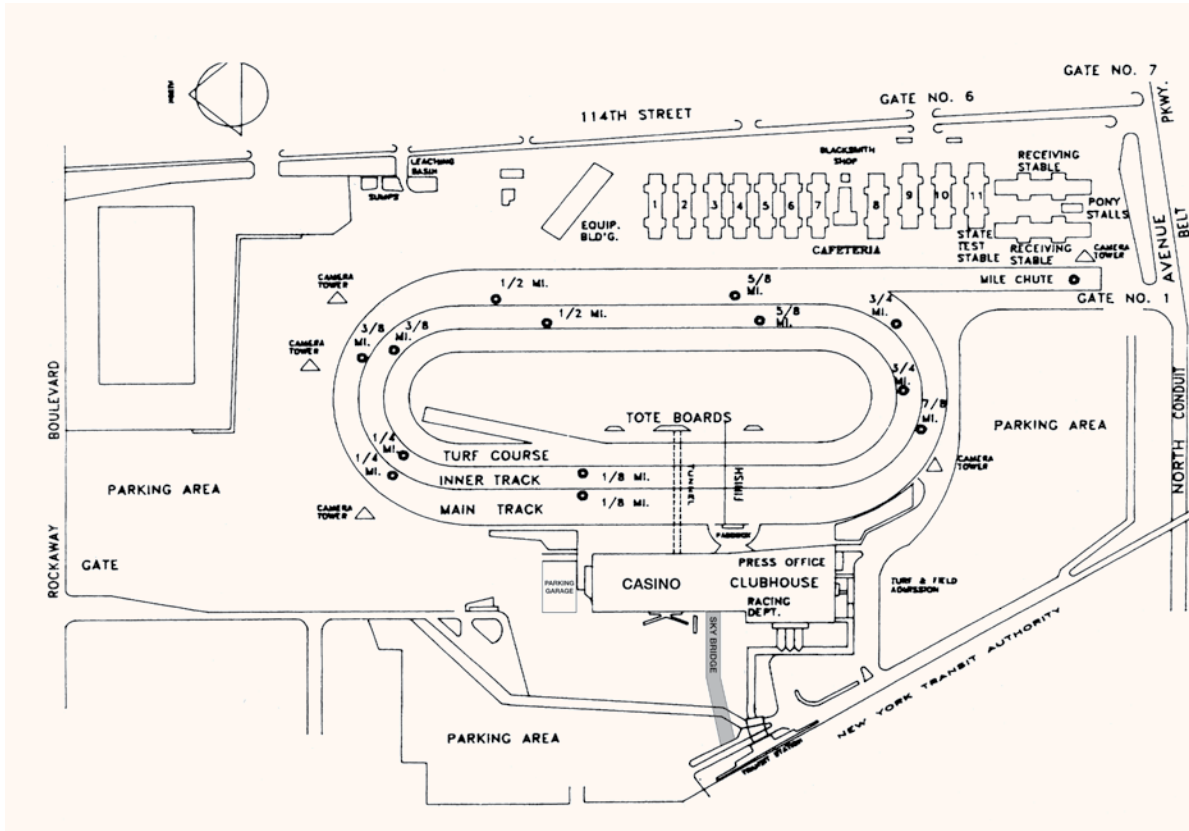
Aqueduct Racetrack opened on September 27, 1894, on property that belonged to the old Brooklyn Water Works, which was home to a conduit that brought water to New York City from the vast Hempstead Plain. Also known as the Big A, Aqueduct is the only racetrack in New York City, occupying 210 acres in South Ozone Park in the borough of Queens. Just eight miles from its sister track, Belmont Park, Aqueduct's neighbor is John F. Kennedy International Airport, the top international passenger gateway in the United States.

Through the years, the Big A has been the scene of some of racing's landmark events, including the only triple dead heat in stakes history when Brownie, Bossuet, and Wait a Bit hit the wire as one in the Carter Handicap on June 10, 1944. Man o' War, Sword Dancer, Kelso, Buckpasser, Dr. Fager, Secretariat, Forego, Easy Goer and Smarty Jones built their legends at Aqueduct, and Cigar, for whom the Grade 1 Cigar Mile is named, won the first two races of his 16-race winning streak at the Big A.

From 1955-59, Aqueduct was rebuilt at a cost of \$34.5 million. With a new grandstand, racing strip, barns, and accessory buildings, the new Aqueduct opened on September 14, 1959 to a crowd of 42,473 and rave reviews as the most up-to-date racing facility in North America. From 1963-68, during the reconstruction of Belmont Park, Aqueduct was the site of the Belmont Stakes.

In 1975, Aqueduct opened its winterized, one-mile inner dirt track on the former site of the inner turf course, and on October 11, 1981, it unveiled one of the largest restaurants in New York City, the multi-tiered Equestris. In 1985 and 1989, Aqueduct underwent two more rounds of improvements, including the construction of mini-theatres, the expansion of the backyard, paddock and grandstand and installation of a weather-insulated paddock.

In 2011, Aqueduct commenced its most sweeping change with the opening of the multi-level, 415,000 square foot casino, Resorts World Casino New York City, operated by Genting New York LLC. The casino, which occupies the former grandstand, commenced operations in October, 2011, and expanded to a second floor in December, with more than 5,000 VLTs and ETGs available.

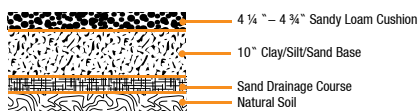

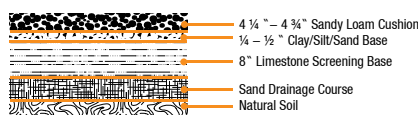

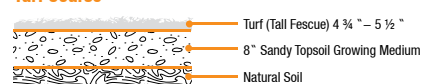

BELMONT PARK

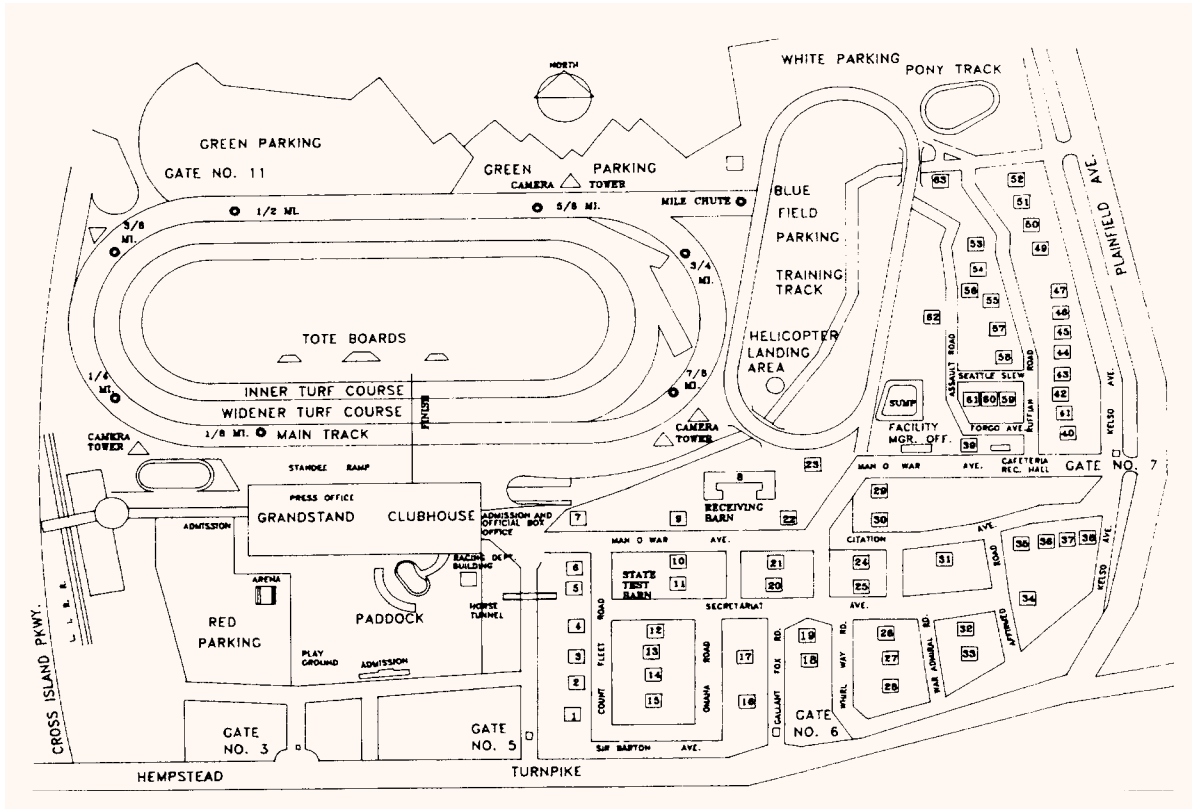
In 1902, a syndicate headed by August Belmont II and former Secretary of the Navy William C. Whitney sought land on Long Island to build the most elaborate track in America, one modeled after the great race courses of Europe. They found what they were looking for on the border of Queens County and Nassau County. Originally known as Foster's Meadow, the 650 acres of land included a turreted Tudor-Gothic mansion owned by William de Forest Manice, which was to serve as the track's Turf and Field Club until 1956.

The grand opening of Belmont Park on May 4, 1905, prompted the first of countless traffic jams in Long Island history as more than 40,000 fans, in all manner of conveyance, tried to arrive by the first race post time of 3 p.m. Not all of them made it in time to see August Belmont II's Blandy, at 7-1, hold off 100-1 shot Oliver Cromwell in the \$1,500 Belmont Inaugural. Later, James R. Keen's Sysonby, who would be ranked No. 30 on the Blood-Horse Magazine's top 100 horses of the 20th century, made his 3-year-old debut against the super filly Beldame, another of Belmont's charges. In the stretch, Sysonby got unexpected competition from 20-1 Race King, and the two hit the wire in a dead heat.

The most celebrated race at Belmont Park is the Belmont Stakes, the final jewel of racing's Triple Crown. Since 1919, when Sir Barton was the first to sweep the Kentucky Derby, the Preakness and the Belmont, the "Test of the Champion" has crowned but 11 winners of racing's most prestigious, and elusive, prize.

Belmont Park holds a place in history in other areas as well. In 1910, Wilbur and Orville Wright staged an international aerial competition at Belmont Park that drew 150,000 spectators. In 1918, the track served as the New York City terminal for the first airmail service between New York and Washington, D.C. Belmont Park was the site of "War Relief Day" in 1940 to benefit the American Red Cross and in 1943 hosted "Back the Attack" Day, wherein fans had to buy a war bond to gain admission to the track. Total receipts that day were between \$25 and \$30 million.

Closed in 1963, the rebuilt Belmont Park grandstand reopened on May 20, 1968. Over the next decade it rocked to the cheers of thousands as Secretariat (1973), Seattle Slew (1977) and Affirmed (1978) joined Sir Barton (1919), Gallant Fox (1930), Omaha (1935), War Admiral (1937), Whirlaway (1941), Count Fleet (1943), Assault (1946), and Citation (1948) as Triple Crown winners. History was made in 2007 when Rags to Riches defeated Curlin to become the first filly in 102 years and one of only three to win the race, and history was denied in 2008 when Da' Tara ended Big Brown's bid to sweep the Kentucky Derby, Preakness and Belmont.

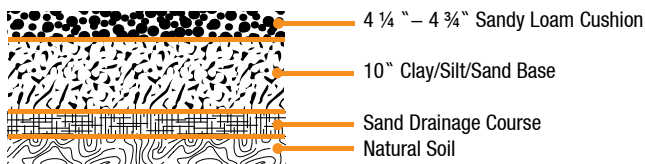

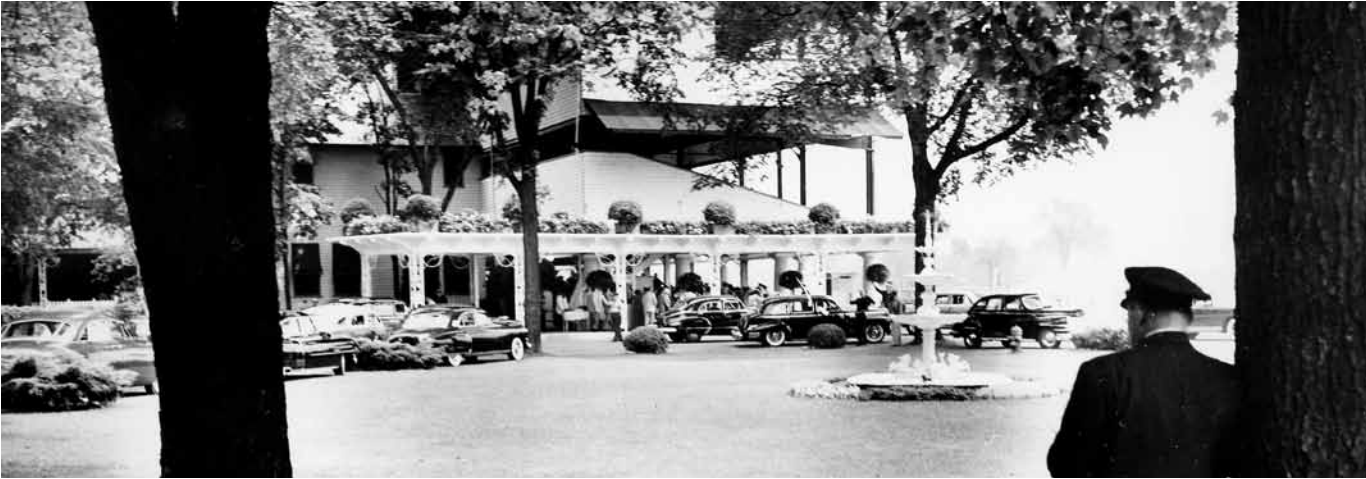

SARATOGA RACE COURSE

Thoroughbred racing has no finer setting than Saratoga Race Course, named one of the world's greatest sporting venues by Sports Illustrated. Every summer, the past comes alive in the historic grandstand as fans experience not only the best in racing, but the unmatched ambience and charm of historic Saratoga Springs.

Already famous for its mineral baths, Saratoga held its first thoroughbred meet just a month after the Battle of Gettysburg. Staged by gambler, casino owner, ex-boxing champion and future Congressman John "Old Smoke" Morrissey and beginning on August 3, 1863, the four-day meet drew thousands of locals and tourists who saw Lizzie W. defeat Captain Moore in the best-of-three series of races.

Emboldened by the success of that first meet, Morrissey promptly enlisted his friends John R. Hunter, William Travers and Leonard Jerome to form the Saratoga Association. Its first responsibility was the construction of a new, permanent grandstand on the current site of Saratoga Race Course. Across the street, the "old course" became the barn area known as Horse Haven, with the vestiges of the original track still encircling the stables.

Today, looking out over the jam-packed backyard and grandstand on any sunny summer afternoon, it's hard to fathom that racing at Saratoga once teetered on the brink of extinction. In the early 1960's, there was a movement to conduct summer racing exclusively at the new and modern Aqueduct Racetrack. But in 1962, New York State Governor W. Averill Harriman, who owned Log Cabin Stud, signed "The Harriman Law," which mandated a minimum of 24 race days at Saratoga every year.

Nowadays, the population of Saratoga Springs triples to 75,000 when the thoroughbreds return each summer, with those who come for the races discovering the area's amazing breadth of history and culture.

With more than 1,000 buildings on the National Register of Historic Places, Saratoga Springs was honored with the first American Heritage Magazine "Great American Place" award and the National Trust for Historic Places "Great American Main Street" award. Walking Magazine cited it as one of America's "Most Walkable Cities."

Saratoga Springs is home to the National Museum of Racing, the Saratoga Performing Arts Center (SPAC), the National Museum of the Dance, Skidmore College, and many art galleries. Resplendent in Victorian architecture, it also boasts Yaddo Rose Gardens, the Little Theatre at SPAC, the Saratoga Music Hall and the Foundation for Baroque Music. Nearby, Saratoga Battlefield in Stillwater is dedicated to "The Turning Point of the American Revolution," while Ulysses S. Grant's Cottage at Mt. McGregor is where the bankrupt former president and Civil War hero, wrote his memoirs and restored his family's fortune.

Although some may quibble with the order, it's no wonder that Saratoga's motto is "Health, history, and horses."

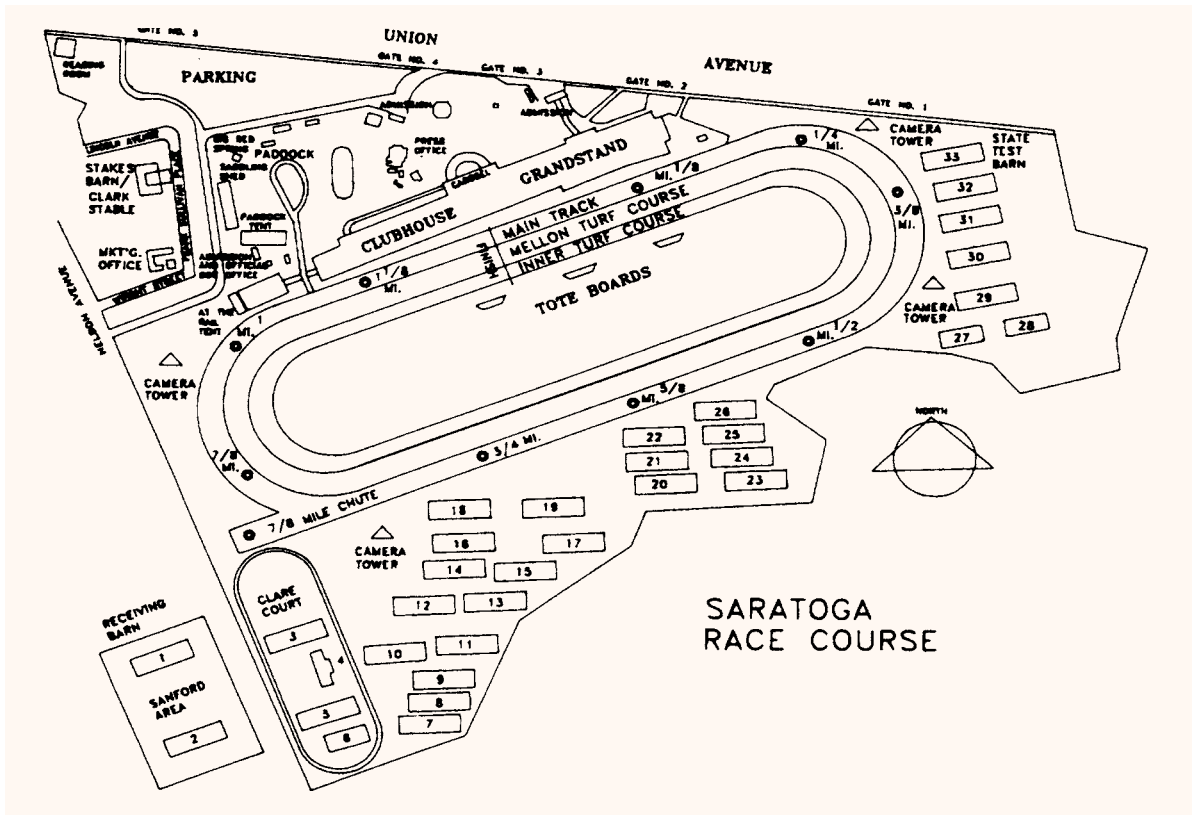

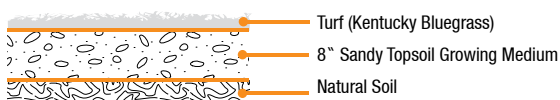
