Game Day Policies

Game management personnel reserve the right to inspect all persons, bags, and items entering the stadium for the purpose of fan safety. All purses or other bags must fit within the assigned seating area for each patron. Rowdy, threatening, or inconsiderate behavior such as profane and abusive language, fighting or drunkenness shall not be tolerated within any tailgate area or within the stadium. Violation may result in ejection, arrest, and/or loss of ticket privileges for future athletic events.

- Throwing of any objects in the stands or onto the field is prohibited.
- Use of umbrellas inside the stadium seating area is prohibited.
- Hand-held size cameras are permitted in the stadium. However, video cameras are not allowed.
- Only players, officials, and authorized personnel are allowed on the field.
- Standing or sitting in the aisles is prohibited.
- Any prohibited items should be returned to your vehicle or disposed of properly prior to entering the stadium. Prohibited items in the stadium will be confiscated and not returned.

Patrons in violation of stadium policies are subject to removal from the stadium, arrest and prosecution under the applicable laws and statutes, and could forfeit the right to season ticket privileges. Students who violate rules may be subject to university disciplinary procedures.

Prohibited Items

Food, drink containers, bottles, artificial noise makers, cans, thermos bottles, ice bags, ice chests, strollers, video cameras, large flags, flags on poles, banners or signs, weapons, or any object deemed hazardous by stadium management. Large bags and backpacks are prohibited. Diaper bags are permitted if accompanied by an infant. Umbrellas are allowed into Carter-Finley stadium, but they cannot be used in any seating areas.

Alcohol Policy

- The consumption of alcoholic beverages inside the stadium is prohibited.
- Persons of legal age may consume malt beverages and unfortified wine in Carter-Finley Stadium parking facilities in connection with football tailgating.
- Rules regarding alcohol consumption at NC State Athletic events are posted at: http://www.ncsu.edu/policies/campus_environ/health_safety_welfare/POL04.20.2.php
- Alcoholic Beverage kegs are prohibited in all permitted parking areas including vendor or university-sanctioned events.
- Carter-Finley visitors shall carry a picture ID in accordance with University regulations. All persons consuming alcohol in the parking lots shall carry a driver's license on them at all times.

Emergency Information

If a situation arises which requires evacuation of Carter-Finley Stadium, we request your cooperation and assistance to exit the facility in an orderly manner. For your safety, numerous police and security officers are positioned around the stadium.

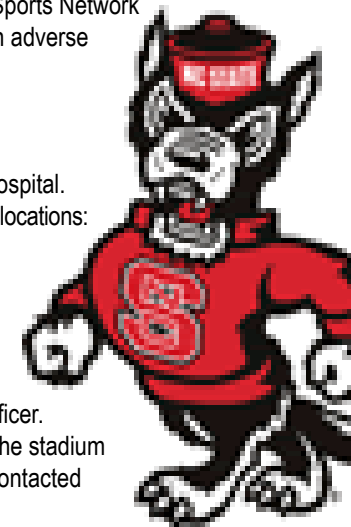
A Campus Police Command Center Van will be located inside the stadium between Gates 4 & 5. Both during and after the game, Campus Police can be contacted at (919) 515-3000 or 911. Listen to the public address system for information about weather, emergency evacuation and other emergency information.

Once an evacuation announcement has been given please proceed to the nearest stairway or exit. Outside the stadium follow the directions of the event staff and do not attempt to re-enter the stadium. Listen to the Wolfpack Sports Network on MIX 101.5 WRAL-FM for more information. In the case of an adverse weather situation please seek immediate shelter.

Rex Healthcare First Aid Stations

Emergency Response Centers are provided courtesy of Rex Hospital. Patrons in need of medical attention should visit one of these two locations:

- East Stands-located behind Gate 9
- West Stands-located behind Gate 4



Lost and Found

Please refer all lost articles and children to a Campus Police officer. A Campus Police Command Center Van will be located inside the stadium between Gates 4 & 5. After the game, Campus Police can be contacted at (919) 515-3000.

Smoking

In a continuing effort to meet the diverse needs of all of our guests, and in accordance with North Carolina state law, the seating area at Carter-Finley Stadium has been designated a non-smoking area. Smoking will be permitted on the concourse areas only.

Accessible Seating

NC State University, in conjunction with the RBC Center, recognizes it should be accessible as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990. It is because of the ADA Amendments Act (ADAAA), which was signed into law in 2008 that changes are being made in ticketing. These laws protect persons with disabilities, and we continue to make every effort to comply with state and federal accessibility regulations and make reasonable accommodations for our guests.

Accessible seating is available in all of our arenas, stadiums, and competition venues. For information on accessible seating, prior to game day, please contact (919) 865-1510. On the day of the game questions and exchanges may be made at the box office, and are subject to availability.

Ticket Office Information

For more information or to purchase tickets in advance, log on to GoPack.com 24 hours a day or call the NC State Athletics Ticket Office at (919) 865-1510, or toll free at 1-800-310-PACK.

Regular ticket office hours are 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Day of game will call and ticket information windows are located on the west side of the stadium between Gates 4 and 5 at the Ammons Family Ticket Center. Credit cards are accepted, but cash is preferred. Ticket windows will open 2 hours prior to kick-off and will close at halftime. Photo ID is required when picking up will call tickets.

Tickets must be presented at gate for entry into the stadium. One ticket required per person.

Children two and under are permitted into Carter-Finley Stadium without a ticket, but are required to sit in their parent/guardian's lap.



Will Call and Relocation Questions

All questions related to will call and/or relocation should be directed to the Ammons Family Ticket Center located between Gates 4 and 5 on the west side of the stadium.

Reprint Policy

The NC State Athletic Ticket Office can replace a season ticket that has been lost, stolen or damaged. In order to facilitate the replacement of a ticket through the NC State Ticket Office, the Season Ticket Holder must complete a Replacement Ticket Request Form and mail or fax it to the NC State Ticket Office. The replacement fee is free for the first request and \$10 per ticket for all additional requests. Information regarding replacement tickets must be received at least 48 hours prior to the game.

- A form must be submitted for each season ticket account and each game.
- All forms must be signed by the Season Ticket Holder.
- Replacement tickets will not be mailed. All replacement tickets will be left at Will Call.

Tickets that have been damaged, lost, left at home or stolen on game day may be replaced to the Season Ticket Holder only at the stadium ticket office prior to kickoff.

The 2011 ACC Championship game will be held on Saturday, December 3rd at Bank of America Stadium in Charlotte, NC.

Ticket applications will be mailed to Wolfpack Club members in late October. Applications will be included in the 2011 Football Preview edition of the Wolfpacker and through various emails sent by the Athletic Department. In order to receive priority seating, applications need to be submitted by **Friday, November 18, 2011**. Tickets ordered by the application deadline will be shipped via FedEx on Monday, November 28th.

2011 Bowl Information

The ACC has partnerships with eight bowl games including serving as the host team of the FedEx Orange Bowl of the Bowl Championship Series in Miami.

Ticket applications will be mailed to Wolfpack Club members in late October. Applications will be included in the 2011 Football Preview edition of the Wolfpacker and through various emails sent by the Athletic Department. In order to receive priority seating, applications need to be submitted by **Friday, December 9, 2011**. Once the bowl announcement is made, all remaining tickets will be on sale at GoPack.com or by calling (919) 865-1510 during normal business hours.

Tickets ordered by the application deadline will be shipped via FedEx on Friday, December 16th. Any orders placed after the deadline will be available for pick up at Will Call. Will Call dates and times will be posted on GoPack.com shortly after the bowl announcement.

Parking

All parking gates open five hours before kick-off. Gate E (Edwards Mill Road), will open at 7 a.m. for vendors and service personnel only.

All parking on the grounds of Carter-Finley Stadium is reserved and is accessible by parking pass only. General public parking is located in the Vet School fields, and paid lots can be located at the West Chase Office Complex (West Chase Rd. and Blue Ridge Rd.), Wade Office Park I (Wade Ave. between Edwards Mill Rd. and Trinity Rd.), and Trinity Park Office Complex (Trinity Rd. between Edwards Mill Rd. and Nowell Rd.).

Handicapped parking is available for purchase on a priority basis through the Wolfpack Club. Fans with special needs that are in need of a parking pass can pay (\$15) to park at Cardinal-Gibbons High School and ride a shuttle to and from Dail Plaza North. Cars will need to display a disability placard in order to park. The shuttle runs every 15 minutes and only travels to and from the Dail Plaza North. It will NOT take fans to the West or East entrance gates. Riders of the shuttle will receive a boarding pass that should be shown to board the return shuttle after the game.

Tents shall remain contained within the allocated parking area of a tailgating group.

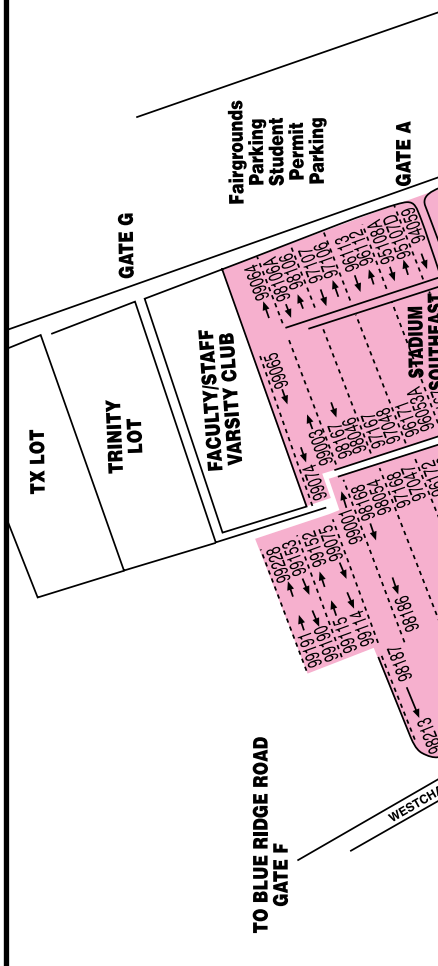
