## #84 George Bryan

**Tight End ... 6-5 ... 265 ... Castle Hayne, N.C.**

**Career:** Finished his Wolfpack career with more receptions than any tight end in school history - 126 ... Finished his career tied for seventh in school history in total catches ... Tied for fourth in school history with 17 career touchdown grabs ... Only Wolfpack tight end

ever to win first-team All-ACC honors twice.

**In 2011:** Graduated from NC State in December ... Voted a season team captain by his peers ... Fifth-leading receiver for the season with 33 grabs ... A second-team All-ACC performer ... On the preseason list for the 2011 Mackey Award, he was also a preseason second-team All-America pick by Lindy's, that publication also named him to its first-team preseason all-conference team.

**In 2010:** First-team All-ACC performer for the second straight year ... A semifinalist for the 2010 Mackey Award ... Ranked third on the team in receiving with 35 catches for 369 yards ... Pulled down the longest catch of his career, a 37-yarder, in the win over Boston College ... A first-team preseason all-conference choice according to Phil Steele's College Preview ... An honorable mention preseason All-American according to Consensus Draft Services ... Preseason favorite to win the 2010 College Football Performance TE Trophy ... Only the third tight end in school history to earn first-team All-ACC honors and the only one to do so twice ... Earned the team's Bo Rein Award, given to the players who "makes a vital contribution in an unsung role."

**In 2009:** Named a first-team All-ACC performer after leading all league tight ends in receptions ... The Wolfpack's second-leading receiver with 40 catches, he led the team for much of the season ... Named to the midseason 'watch' list for the Mackey Trophy, he was the only ACC player to make the list and one of just three sophomores ... Named to Phil Steele's mid-season All-ACC first team ... Had six grabs for 89 yards and two touchdowns in the win over Gardner-Webb, all three marks were career bests ... Also had six catches at Wake Forest ... Scored six TDs on the season.

**In 2008:** Talented young player who started six games in 2008 - four when the Pack's two most experienced tight ends were out with injuries and two when the team opened with two tight ends ... Scored the Pack's first touchdown in the romp at North Carolina - he held on to a 17-yard

reception despite getting hammered at the goalline ... Led the team in receiving with five grabs against East Carolina, gaining 58 yards including a 30-yard bomb and the late fourth-quarter game-tying score ... The Pack's fifth-leading receiver with 18 catches for 201 yards... Ranked second on the team with four TD receptions ... In for more snaps (404) from scrimmage than any other Wolfpack tight end ... A 2009 preseason second-team All-ACC choice by Phil Steele's College Football Preview and a third-team choice by Athlon Sports.

**In 2007:** Redshirted the season at tight end ... Was the recipient of the game-winning 30-yard touchdown pass in the Red/White spring game.

**Prep:** Talented athlete who played football, basketball and baseball in high school ... Played both tight end and defensive end for New Hanover HS under head coach Kevin Motsinger ... Reeled in eight touchdowns as a senior ... Earned all-conference honors and all-area honors ... A member of the North Carolina Shrine Bowl team.

**In 2011:** Did not see action in 2011.

**In 2010:** Started the first four games of the season at the boundary corner ... In for a season-high 63 snaps in the win at Georgia Tech ... Played in 11 games, seeing action mainly on special teams over the last half of the season ... Missed 2010 spring practice after undergoing shoulder surgery in December of 2009.

**In 2009:** Came off the bench to tie for the team lead in tackles versus Wake Forest with nine ... Started at safety in the season opener, then at cornerback versus Duke ... In for 82 snaps from scrimmage and another 14 on special teams against the Blue Devils ... Saw action only on special teams in three of the last four games of 2009.

**In 2008:** Started the first eight games and then did not see action from scrimmage at Duke or versus Wake Forest ... Saw increased time in the last two games and ended up with 517 total snaps played - the third-highest mark among defensive players returning in 2009 ... Tied for third on the team in interceptions - he pulled down one in the season opener with South Carolina and one versus East Carolina ... Tallied eight tackles in the South Florida and Boston College contests.

**In 2007:** Redshirted the season at cornerback.

**Prep:** Played for Coach Jeff Simpson at Zebulon B. Vance High School ... Took home defensive MVP honors from the Shrine Bowl as a senior ... Notched 75 tackles, four interceptions and one fumble recovery as a junior in 2005 ... Also played offense, scoring two touchdowns on four receptions for 145 yards, a 36.5 average ... Scored a pair of touchdowns on punt returns as a junior ... A sports management major.

**Linebacker ... 6-5 ... 239 ... Monroe, Michigan**

**Career:** Finished his Wolfpack career ranked 12th in school history with 328 career tackles ... Tallied 32.5 tackles for loss for his career, the 13th-best mark ever for a Wolfpack player ... His 15 sacks ties for 10th ... Team leader in tackles each of the past three

**In 2007:** Redshirted the season at linebacker.

**Prep:** Played quarterback, safety and linebacker at Monroe HS for Coach Greg Hudkins ... Rivals.com top-30 player out of Michigan ... Threw for 3,285 yards and 23 touchdowns in his career and was named all-league as a senior ... Rushed for 10 touchdowns his final season and threw for more than 1,700 yards ... Was a three-year starter at quarterback and also played defense as a senior ... Lettered in baseball and basketball in addition to football ... Also a Golden Glove winner in boxing.

**In 2011:** A semi-finalist for the 2011 Butkus Award, he led the team with 132 tackles ... Moved to middle linebacker during spring drills and started every game at that spot ... Leading tackler in five games as a senior ... Tallied a career-high 16 stops at Cincinnati and tied that mark against Georgia Tech ... had a huge 19-yard sack to cause a fumble in the win over North Carolina ... Graduated from NC State in December.

**In 2010:** Tied for the team lead in tackles with 97, his 10.5 tackles for loss ranked third among Wolfpack players ... Played the SAM linebacker spot... Led the defense with 809 snaps from scrimmage ... Tied his then-career-high with 13 stops in the win at North Carolina ... That tally included a six-yard sack and he also recovered a fumble in that contest ... Led the team in tackles at Central Florida with a dozen, including a sack, two others for loss ... Also pulled down his first career interception against the Knights ... Named the ACC Defensive Back of the Week by the league and the ACC Player of the Week by Rivals.com for that performance ... Tied for the lead in tackles against Cincinnati with seven and with eight stops in the win over Florida State.

**In 2009:** NC State's leading tackler in 2009 with 85 stops ... Led the team in stops versus Florida State (9) and UNC (10) ... Racked up a career-high 13 tackles at Virginia Tech ... Finished second on the squad in tackles for loss with eight, he also tallied four sacks ... Started all 12 games ... Recipient of the team's Al Michaels Award, which is given to the player who "puts team before self."

**In 2008:** Saw action mainly on special teams in 2008, his 213 specialty snaps ranked third on the team ... In for 30 snaps from scrimmage at Maryland, just 38 for the entire season ... Tallied 14 total tackles.

**Center/Defensive Tackle ... 6-3 ... 303 ... Philadelphia, Pa.**

**Career:** One of the Pack's most active players in terms of community service, he started a chapter of "Uplifting Athletes" at NC State to raise money for leukemia research ... Named a national finalist for that organization's award.

**In 2011:** Came to State as a defensive lineman and played that position in 2008 before moving to the offensive line, where he played center and guard ... Moved back to the defensive side of the ball the week before the Central Michigan game and played there in the next five outings ... Back at offensive line for the Maryland contest and the bowl game ... Saw action in 11 games as a senior ... Graduated in May of 2011 with a degree in business administration.

**In 2010:** Saw action at center in five contests, including a season-high 10 snaps in the season opener versus Western Carolina

**In 2009:** Moved over to center from defensive line following the 2008 campaign ... Saw action in one game, playing five snaps in the win over Gardner-Webb.

**In 2008:** Reserve defensive tackle who saw action in six games ... In for a season-high 27 snaps versus South Florida ... Played in five of the first six games, then not again until the bowl game.

**In 2007:** Redshirted the season at defensive tackle ... Named to the ACC Academic Honor Roll for 2007-08.
