Storyline

• Maryland advanced to today's quarterfinals with an 82-60 win over Wake Forest yesterday in a first-round game of the ACC Tournament. It may have been the Terrapins' most complete performance of the season as they had team season-bests in victory margin (22), FG% (.544) and were one short of a team-high assist total (18). The Terps are making their fourth straight appearance in the quarterfinals.

• The Terrapins face top-seeded North Carolina, who beat Maryland twice this season - 83-74 on 2/4/12 in College Park and 88-64 on 2/29 in Chapel Hill. Maryland is 3-12 all-time in the ACCT against the Tar Heels, having lost eight straight, though two games went to overtime. The last time they met was in an 84-72 UNC win in the 2003 quarters. Maryland's last win over UNC in the tournament was an 85-75 win in the 1986 quarterfinals. The Terrapins are 27-26 all-time in the quarterfinal round and are 4-5 as a No. 8 seed.

• Sophomore guard Terrell Stoglin had 25 points, a career-high 7 rebounds and 4 assists yesterday against Wake, tying or leading the Terps in those three categories. It marked the first time a Terp had led in those three stats since Jordan Williams had 16-13-3 last year against NC State in a first-round ACCT game on 3/10/2011. Maryland is 14-7 in the 21 times Stoglin has scored 20 or more in a game this season.

• Freshman guard Nick Faust had a career-high 19 points yesterday against the Demon Deacons. It is the third time in eight games he's either matched or raised his career-high in points. It was the most points by a Maryland freshman in an ACCT game since Laron Profit had 19 against Duke on 3/8/1996. In his last eight games (since returning to starting lineup 2/11 after the injury to Pe'Shon Howard), Faust is averaging 13.8 points, 5.0 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 1.3 steals.

4 - Jacob Susskind (6-5, 180, Fr., G, West Orange, N.J.)

- Walk-on who has played in six games this season... 0-1 FG yesterday in 2 minutes late in the game.
- Recovering from knee injury that forced him to miss most of his senior season at Golda Och Academy.

5 - Nick Faust (6-6, 175, Fr., G, Baltimore, Md.)

- Career-high 19 points tied Laron Profit for most points by a Terp freshman in an ACC Tournament game (3/8/1996).
- Averaging 12.3 ppg over his last 10 games... 8 of his double-figure games this season have come in the last 10 games.
- Tied for lead on team in assists (Mosley) with 65 and second on team in steals (30).
- ALL-ACC FRESHMAN SELECTION by ACSMA.

10- Berend Weijs (6-10, 200, Sr., C, Amsterdam, Netherlands)

- Had 2 points and block in 5 minutes yesterday against Wake Forest.
- Second on team with 22 blocked shots.
- Broke Greivis Vasquez's old school record in the preseason 5K run.

11 - Mychal Parker (6-5, 195, So., G, Washington, N.C.)

- Had 2 points, 2 boards and 3 assists yesterday against Wake Forest.
- Averaging 19.3 minutes off the bench since Pe'Shon Howard's season-ending injury.
- Outstanding athleticism, leaping ability... Good defender.

12 - Terrell Stoglin (6-1, 185, So., G, Tucson, Ariz.)

- SECOND TEAM ALL-ACC SELECTION by ACSMA.
- Leads ACC and 8th in NCAA in scoring with 21.3 ppg average.
- 51st Terrapin ever with 1,000 points in his career, but only the 3rd to do it in two seasons (Joe Smith, Tom McMillen).
- Now 9th on Terps' single-season scoring list with 660.
- Likely to be 6th time a Terp leads the ACC in scoring (Joe Smith '95, Walt Williams '92, Len Bias '85 & '86, Albert King '80).
- Back-to-back games with 25 points (also 25 in OT loss to Virginia).
- Shooting .898 (53x59) at FT line in last 11 games.

13 - Arnold Richmond (5-11, 175, Fr., G, Suitland, Md.)

- Walk-on from Crossland HS near Maryland campus.
- Played 4 minutes yesterday vs. Wake Forest... Has appeared in 8 games this year... 2 FTs at UNC account for his points.

14 - Sean Mosley (6-4, 210, Sr., G, Baltimore, Md.)

- One of only 8 Terps ever with 1,000 points, 500 rebounds, 250 assists and 120 steals.
- Start today would be his 108th, one more than Juan Dixon.
- Comes into today's game with 3,386 minutes played as a Terrapin.
- 6 points, 6 boards, 4 assists and 3 steals in 29 minutes yesterday vs. Wake Forest.
- One of two seniors on this year's team... outstanding leader.

15 - Spencer Barks (6-9, 225, Fr., F, Poolesville, Md.)

- Had 2 FTs, 3 rebounds, block in 4 minutes off the bench yesterday vs. Wake Forest.
- Walk-on with good size from St. Albans HS where he played for former Terp guard Duane Simpkins.

21 - Pe'Shon Howard (6-3, 195, So., G, Los Angeles, Calif.)

- Missed first 9 games of the season with a broken foot, played in 14 games, now missed last 8 with ACL tear to his right knee.
- Averaged 6.5 points, 3.7 assists in his 14 games this season.
- Hopefully, a quick healer.

22 - Jon Dillard, (5-11, 165, Sr., G, Yorktown, Va.)

- Survived a grueling walk-on tryout to earn one of two roster spots (Thomas) on this year's team.
- 4 minutes yesterday vs. Wake Forest... Points came with bucket against Virginia... Has played in 6 games, including 4 of last 6.
- Majoring in kinesiology.

23 - John Auslander, (6-7, 225, So., F, Herndon, Va.)

- Played in 13 games this season for Terps, including 4 of the last 6... 4-minute stint yesterday vs. Wake Forest.
- All 14 of his points this season came in the first 9 games.
- Former walk-on as a transfer from Greensboro College who earned a scholarship this season.

24 - Jonathan Thomas (6-2, 170, Jr., G, Frederick, Md.)

- Had a 3-point FG yesterday along with an assist, 2 steals in win over Wake Forest.
- 12 minutes yesterday were second only to 16 vs. Iona early in the season... Has played in each of the last 6 games.
- Father is an engineer and mother is a chemist... Thomas majors in mechanical engineering with a math minor.

25 - Alex Len (7-1, 225, RFr., C, Antratsit, Ukraine)

- Had 7 points, 6 boards, 3 blocks and 2 assists yesterday vs. Wake Forest.
- Despite missing first 10 games of the season, his 45 blocked shots this year are 3rd on Terps' list by freshmen.
- Was 3rd in conference in ACC games in blocks (2.2 bpg)... Only 2 games this season out of 21 played when he failed to have a block.
- Sat 10-game suspension due to NCAA amateurism ruling.
- Athletic center who did a cartwheel in the lane before dunking at Maryland Madness before the season.

30 - Ashton Pankey (6-9, 220, RFr., F, Bronx, N.Y.)

- Had 6 points, 2 rebounds, steal in 13 minutes off the bench yesterday vs. Wake.
- Had tough shooting stretch ended yesterday with 3-for-4 effort (0-for-11 in 3 games prior).
- Has led Terps on boards eight times this season, tied with James Padgett for best on the team.
- Saw only 3 minutes of play last season (vs. Seattle Univ. in 2010-11 opener) due to stress fracture in his leg... Had surgery around Christmas last year and has been a pleasant surprise this year.

35 - James Padgett (6-8, 215, Jr., F, Brooklyn, N.Y.)

- Solid front-line player for Terps this season and a good finisher on the block.
- Only eighth time in last 26 seasons Terps have had a player with 100 career rebounds.
- Had 10 points, 5 rebounds, 2 assists yesterday in 22 minutes.
- Averaging 9.1 points and team-high 6.0 rebounds per game this season.
- Terps are 11-3 this season when he scores in double figures.

Head Coach Mark Turgeon

- Fourth head coach for the Terps in 43 seasons, eighth in Maryland basketball history (1923-24).
- Replaced Gary Williams in May after Williams announced his retirement.
- Now 267-173 overall in 14 seasons as a head coach... Now 9-11 in conference tournaments.
- Led Texas A&M to four straight NCAA appearances.
