# Message from the President of the ITF

On behalf of the ITF, it is my great pleasure to welcome you to the 24th edition of the Hyundai Hopman Cup, which is taking place at the Burswood Dome in Perth for the last time before moving to the Perth Arena next year.

Sanctioned by the ITF since 1996 as its official mixed team competition, the event enjoys a special place in the calendar as a fitting memorial to Australian legend Harry Hopman, who made such a difference and achieved so much in the sport.

In a calendar that focuses on individual events, the ITF team competitions, that also include Davis Cup by BNP Paribas and Fed Cup by BNP Paribas, give players a different perspective on the game and a rare opportunity to represent their country.

During its first 23 years, the Hopman Cup has attracted some of the game's modern greats, with Boris Becker, Novak Djokovic, Roger Federer, Steffi Graf, John McEnroe, Arantxa Sanchez Vicario, Monica Seles, Michael Stich and Serena Williams just some of the players to have competed here for their country.

This year's event is headlined by the top two women in the world – Caroline Wozniacki and Petra Kvitova – as well as reigning Roland Garros champion Li Na.

Former Grand Slam winner Lleyton Hewitt leads the home charge alongside Jarmila Gajdosova as Australia is drawn alongside No. 2 seeds France, No. 3 seeds Spain and China in Pool B. No. 1 seeds Czech Republic are the team to beat with Wimbledon champion Kvitova being joined by Tomas Berdych. They face No. 4 seeds USA, Bulgaria and Denmark in Pool A.

The eight teams are split into two round-robin pools of four with the top team in each pool meeting in the final, which is scheduled to take place on Saturday.

I would like to thank the organisers, staff and players for their involvement with the Hopman Cup. My thanks also go to the title sponsor Hyundai, supporters of the event since its inception, and major sponsors Burswood Entertainment Complex, Eventscorp, Edith Cowan University, Amcom Telecom and National Australia Bank.

I wish everyone involved with the event a successful and enjoyable week.

# Harry Hopman

**1906 - 1985**

THE International Tennis Federation is proud to maintain the tradition of having the Hyundai Hopman Cup named after one of the game's playing and coaching legends, the late Harry Hopman, whose influence was felt across several decades of players.

The Hopman Cup was initiated in 1988 by two of Mr Hopman's early protégés in Paul McNamee and Charlie Fancutt, who - along with former Wimbledon champion Pat Cash - wished to honour the non-playing captain of Australia's Davis Cup teams, guiding the Aussies to an incredible 15 victories from 1950 to 1969.

Magical names like Lew Hoad, Ken Rosewall, Frank Sedgman, Rod Laver, John Newcombe and in latter years, his successor Neale Fraser, who is an annual contributor to the corporate side of the Hyundai Hopman Cup, were among his proteges. Now the world's leading players from a variety of nations head to Perth each summer to contest this international event. This year the tournament will also welcome one of the nation's greats in Margaret Court as a special VIP guest.

The Cup has developed into the world's most prestigious invitational teams tennis tournament, with the players competing in singles, doubles and mixed doubles - an event that Mr Hopman himself played a lot of in his tennis hey-day.

The championship is now officially part of the ITF's world calendar and Mr Hopman would have been proud to see the event standing in the same stable as the Davis Cup (for men) and the Fed Cup (for women).

Mr Hopman wasn't just a Davis Cup captain.

He played for Australia from 1928-32, mainly in doubles, though he once beat famous American Donald Budge in the singles final of a Californian tournament. Mr Hopman won two Australian doubles championships and with his first wife, Nell (who died in 1967), won the Australian mixed doubles title and they were runner's up at Wimbledon.

Mr Hopman was also the Australian squash champion four times.

Mrs Lucy Hopman is the second wife of the coaching icon and each year she travels from her USA home to preside over the championship, seldom missing a match from her courtside box - and the fans have warmly adopted her as the Queen of the Cup.

Mrs Hopman and two of Harry Hopman's former Australian players in renowned TV commentator Fred Stolle and his successor as the Davis Cup captain in Neale Fraser have been appointed Roving Ambassadors of the Hyundai Hopman Cup.

# The draw and how it works

Hyundai Hopman Cup XXIV has prizemoney of A\$1-million and will follow the traditional Round Robin format.

The seedings for four of the eight nations were determined by the seeding committee of Tournament Director Paul McNamee, Assistant Tournament Director Rob Casey and former Australian player Geoff Masters.

Ground A is headlined by the No. 1 seeds from the Czech Republic. They are joined in the Group by fourth-seeds the USA, Denmark and Bulgaria.

Group B is headed up by No. 2 seeds France. They are joined by third-seeds Spain, Australia and China.

The leading teams in each Group after three Round Robin matches qualify for the Final. All matches are the best of three sets, with the exception of the mixed doubles, which will use the Match Tie-break (the first team to reach 10 points) if the match is tied at one set all.

The order of matches in each Tie is the women's singles, the men's singles and the mixed doubles.

In the case of a draw in terms of the win/loss record in either Group, the following factors, in order, will be used to separate the teams:

The highest total of matches won.

Best percentage of sets won/lost \*

Best percentage of games won/lost \*\*

Head to head performances

The toss of a coin.

\* The dead rubber mixed doubles third set Match Tie-break will count as a set.

\*\* All tie-breaks count as one game.

## Hawk-Eye Officiating

The Rules of Tennis provide the following procedures for the electronic review under the Hawk-Eye Officiating system:

A request for an Electronic Review of a line call or over-rule by a player (team) shall be allowed only on either a point-ending shot or when a player (team) stops playing the point during a rally (returns are permitted, but then the player must immediately stop).

The chair umpire should decide to use the Electronic Review when there is doubt about the accuracy of the line call or over-rule. However, the chair umpire may refuse the Electronic Review if he/she believes the player is making an unreasonable request or that it was not made in a timely manner.

In doubles, the appealing player must make his/her appeal in such a way that either play stops, or the chair umpire stops play. If an appeal is made to the chair umpire, then he/she must first determine that the correct appeal procedure was followed. If it was not correct or if it was late, then the chair umpire may determine that the opposing team was deliberately hindered, in which case the appealing team loses the point.

The original call or over-rule will always stand if the Electronic Review is unable, for whatever reason, to make a decision on that line call or over-rule.

The chair umpire's final decision will be the outcome of the Electronic Review and is not appealable. If a manual choice is required for the system to review a particular ball impact, an official approved by the referee shall decide which ball impact is reviewed.

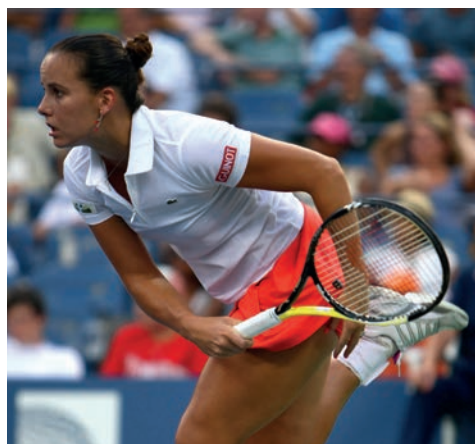
