

CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The West Derbyshire (Parishes) Order 1980

Whereas the District Council of West Derbyshire, under section 48(8) of the Local Government Act 1972(a), made recommendations to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for proposals for the constitution of 6 new parishes in parts of the area of the former urban district of Matlock;

And whereas the said Commission, under sections 47 and 51(1) of the said Act, made such proposals to the Secretary of State for the Environment;

Now therefore the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) and (5) of the said Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the West Derbyshire (Parishes) Order 1980.
- 2.—(1) 20th March 1980 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purposes set out in regulation 4(1) (Coming into operation of order) of the Regulations as modified by paragraph (2).

For all other purposes this order shall come into operation on the appointed day.

- (2) In the said regulation 4(1), item (e) shall not apply in relation to the constitution of any new parish council.

Interpretation

3. In this order—

“the appointed day” means 1st April 1980;

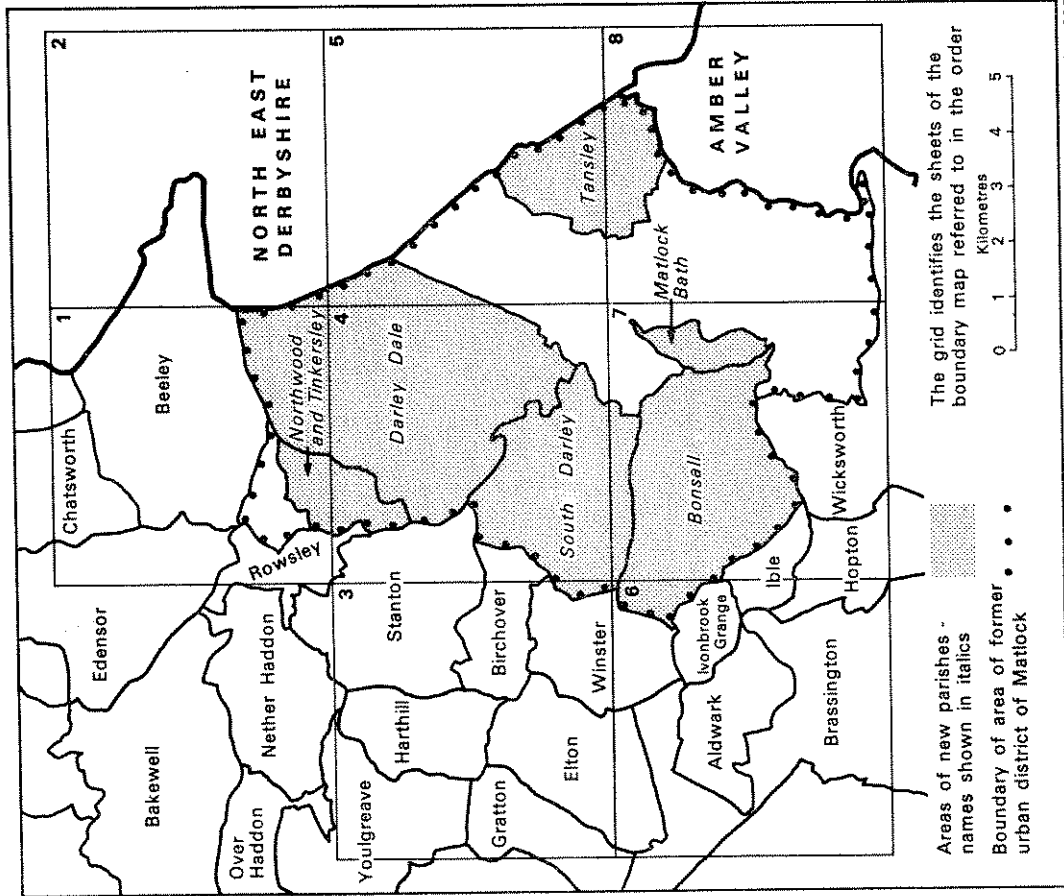
“the district” means the District of West Derbyshire, and “the district council” means the council of the district;

“new parish” means a parish constituted by this order;

“new parish council” means a parish council established by this order;

“new parish ward” means a parish ward formed by this order;  
 “the Regulations” means the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(a) as amended by the Local Government Area Changes (Amendment) Regulations 1978(b); and  
 “the Schedule” means the schedule to this order.

#### *The boundary map*

4. In this order, “the boundary map” means the map printed for Her Majesty’s Stationery Office by Ordnance Survey as “Map referred to in the West Derbyshire (Parishes) Order 1980”. The sheets of the boundary map are respectively marked with the numbers 1 to 8.

#### *Changes in areas*

5. Six new parishes to be known by the names specified in column (1) of the Schedule shall be constituted in parts of the area of the former urban district of Matlock, such parishes consisting of the areas shown by continuous red lines on the boundary map and remaining or forming part of the electoral divisions of the county of Derbyshire and wards of the district specified in respect thereof in columns (4) and (5), of the West Derbyshire petty sessional division and of the High Peak coroner’s district.

#### *Parish councils*

6.—(1) There shall be a parish council for each new parish.

(2) From the appointed day to 5th May 1980 any new parish council shall consist of the district councillors for the wards wholly or partly comprising the area of the parish.

(3) As from 5th May 1980—

- (a) the new parishes of Darley Dale and South Darley shall be divided into the parish wards named in respect thereof in column (2) of the Schedule, such wards consisting of the areas shown by broken red lines on the boundary map;
- (b) the number of parish councillors for each new parish not divided into parish wards and for each new parish ward shall be that shown in respect of the parish or parish ward in column (3) of the Schedule.

(4) Parish councillors of the new parishes shall be elected on 1st May 1980. The persons elected shall come into office on 5th May 1980 and shall retire on the fourth day after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 1983.

(5) The annual meeting of each new parish council for 1980 shall be held on, or within 14 days after, 5th May 1980 and shall be convened by the officer appointed for that purpose by the district council.

#### *Parish meetings*

7.—(1) The first assembly of the parish meeting for any new parish shall be convened by the officer appointed for that purpose by the district council.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE *(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This order constitutes 6 new parishes in parts of the area of the former urban district of Matlock in the District of West Derbyshire.

The map forming part of this Note (page 4) shows the new parishes. The map also incorporates a grid identifying the sheets of the boundary map referred to in article 4 of the order.
