SHIP'S HISTORY 1992

1. Command Composition and Organization.

a. USS McClusky (FFG-41), a third flight Oliver Hazard Perry class guided missile frigate, is named after Rear Admiral Wade McClusky, a hero of the battle of Midway. Her primary mission is general escort duty of convoys, amphibious task forces, underway replenishment groups, and carrier battle groups, defending high value units against subsurface, surface and low level air threats. With her embarked air wing, two SH-60B helicopters, the LAMPS MK III team provides unprecedented capabilities in over-the-horizon surface detection, surveillance, and engagement of hostile warships and submarines.

b. *McClusky* is a member of Destroyer Squadron Fifteen, commanded by Captain Richard A. Robbins.

d. USS McClusky is a member of the Overseas Family Residency Program at United States Fleet Activities Yokosuka, Japan.

e. USS McClusky deployed with HSL-51, an antisubmarine helicopter squadron detachment consisting of one LAMPS MK III SH-60B, HELLFIRE 03, from February 27 to April 26, and HELLFIRE 00, from July 24 to August 7.

3. Narrative

a. USS McClusky began the new year in a holiday leave and upkeep period, but was soon underway to a Missile and Gunnery Exercise in the Subic Bay Operation Areas. Following the exercises, McClusky completed a two week upkeep with SRF Subic Bay. While inport, sailors and officers contributed their time and services to a community relations project of repairing and painting the Kalalake Elementary School in Olongapo, Republic of Philippines. This project is detailed in Supporting Documents (1), the COMREL After Action Report.

b. On March 1, USS McClusky conducted a memorial service and wreath laying ceremony commemorating the 50th anniversary of the Battle of Java Sea-Sunda Strait. The ceremony was held over the site of the sinking of USS Houston off the coast of Jakarta, Indonesia and paid tribute to the hundreds of sailors of the multinational American, British, Dutch, Australian (ABDA) Task Force which was defeated by a superior Japanese force during World War II. McClusky was host to United States, Indonesian, British and Dutch dignitaries as well as an Indonesian TV crew for the memorial service. Supporting Documents (2-15) include the Schedule of Events, SITREP's, Press Releases and commemorative pamphlets covering the event.

c. Following departure from Jakarta, Indonesia for Operation Remembrance, *McClusky* made port calls in Kota Kinabalu and Surabaya, returning to Yokosuka, Japan in the end of March.

d. On April 24, while inport Yokosuka, *USS McClusky* changed hands at a Change of Command Ceremony where CDR David W. Prather was relieve by CDR Ronald L. Chapman. Supporting Document 16 is a Change of Command Program.

e. From May 20 through July 16, *McClusky* remained inport Yokosuka while completing Selected Restricted Availability Period 4 (SRA4).

f. From July 24 through August 7, *McClusky* conducted Harpoon Exercise 1992 South West of Guam. The exercise was to consist of five Harpoon shots, one each from *McClusky*, an US F/A-18, a US P-3, a US Submarine and a Missile Corvette of the Royal Navy of Singapore. No Harpoon shots were actually made however due to the target sled sinking prior to commencement of the exercise.

g. In early September, *McClusky* made a port call to Hong Kong, stopping briefly for fuel in Okinawa. *McClusky* returned to Yokosuka on September 9.

i. From September 20 through 22, USS McClusky and USCGC Chase pulled into Vladivostok, Russia for the reopening of the US Consulate in Vladivostok. The ships were the first US Warships to enter Vladivostok following the collapse of the Soviet Union. Supplementary Document 17 is a press release covering this event.

j. Upon return to Yokosuka, *McClusky* successfully completed its Cruise Missile Tactical Qualification (CMTQ) and began an intensive Type Training Schedule in preparation for the Operational Propulsion Plant Exam (OPPE). *McClusky* completed its OPPE in early December with outstanding results, receiving an extended 24 month certification.
