2011 GLOBAL GO TO THINK TANK RANKINGS

In 2006, the Carnegie Endowment for International Peace announced a plan to build the world's **first global think tank**. Since then, we have created three new research centers—in the Middle East, China, and Europe.

What was an ambitious aspiration has become a thriving reality. We are very proud that in just a few years, **every one of the Carnegie Endowment's five offices** ranks in **the top tier** (top 30) in its region in the 2011 rankings of think tanks worldwide¹:

- The Carnegie Moscow Center is #1 in Central and Eastern Europe (for the fourth straight year)
- The Carnegie Middle East Center is #1 in the Middle East and North Africa (for the third straight year)
- The Carnegie-Tsinghua Center for Global Policy, only two years old, is #28 in Asia, #6 in China, and second among non-government-affiliated Chinese think tanks
- Carnegie Europe, rising rapidly, is #22 in Western Europe
- **Two of our centers**, Carnegie Moscow and Carnegie Middle East, are ranked #13 and #21 respectively among **non-U.S. think tanks worldwide**, underlining the centers' **unique dual identity** as independent entities in their own societies and as parts of a single global institution

The Global Go To Think Tank Rankings have been compiled annually since 2008 by the Think Tanks and Civil Societies Program at the University of Pennsylvania, led by Professor James McGann. The ranking process involves 1,500 experts and analysts who assess the impact and effectiveness of think tanks across a broad range of categories.
