## Technical Report

Method: Telephone interviews conducted with RDD landline and cellular telephones with Massachusetts residents who are likely November 2012 voters by the UNH Survey Center and the Cornell University Survey Research Institute.

Field Period: May 25 to May 31, 2012
Hours: 10 a.m. to 9 p.m.
Median Completion Time: 8 minutes

## Full Sample

Sample Size: 651 randomly selected likely November 2012 voters
Sampling Error: +/- 3.8\%
Response Rate (AAPOR \#4): 24\%

Weighting: The data have been weighted by the number of adults in a household and the number of telephone numbers, land and cellular, at which adults in the household can be reached in order to equalize the chances of an individual MA adult being selected. The data have also been weighted by the sex and race of the respondent and the region of the state based on the American Community Survey conducted by the US Census.
