





POPULATION PYRAMID, BRUNEI CITIZENS AND PERMANENT RESIDENTS 2010




POPULATION PYRAMID, ALL RESIDENTS 2010




INFANT AND UNDER 5 MORTALITY RATE


TOTAL MARRIAGES AND DIVORCES






