



Lacy Knitted Shawl in 3-2-YO Pattern

This triangle shaped shawl is quite easy to knit. Its reversible and requires only knitting and yarn overs.

Materials

4 skeins Nature's Palette Hand Jive yarn
size 6 circular 24" or longer needles, 1 ring marker

Cast on 2 stitches.

Knit 1, Yarn over, knit the rest of the stitches.

Repeat this row till there are 12 stitches total.

Next Row: Knit 1, Yarn over, knit 3, knit 2 together, yarn over. Place a ring marker and knit the remaining stitches on row.

3-2-YO Pattern Row: Knit 1, yarn over * knit 3, knit 2 together, yarn over.* Repeat this pattern between the *'s until you come to marker. (If there are odd stitches before marker, just knit them)

After marker, knit all stitches to end of row. Repeat this

pattern throughout the shawl. End shawl with 4 rows of all knit stitches, and bind off loosely.
