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## Foreword

In June 2010, the Government of the Republic of Zambia (GRZ) through a Cabinet Memorandum decided to conduct the fifth national Census of Population and Housing in October 2010. Following this decision, the Government through the Ministry of Finance and National Planning (MoFNP) made available adequate resources for the conduct of this massive operational undertaking. The 2010 Census operation was coordinated through Cabinet Office. Various Census Technical and Administrative structures were put in place to ensure a successful census operation.

This report provides Preliminary Population Estimates based on Population Summary Counts. The final results will be released once all the questionnaires are scanned and the data analysed. This will be done during the course of the year 2011. Although these are preliminary results, they are very important in informing government, development cooperating partners, civil society organisations and the general public on the population size, distribution and composition as captured by the 2010 Census.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all cooperating partners that supported the 2010 Census of Population and Housing. Particular gratitude goes to the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA), the United Kingdom AID (UKAID-formerly DFID), the American Government through USAID and the African Development Bank (AfDB).

I would also like to thank the National Census Committee chaired by the Secretary to the Cabinet, Dr. Joshua L. Kanganja and the National Census Steering Committee for ably guiding the entire Census operation.

Lastly but most important of all, I would like to thank the Zambian People for their support and cooperation during the 2010 Census enumeration exercise. No census can succeed without the cooperation of the citizenry.

## 1. Introduction

The 2010 Census marks the fifth National Census of Population and Housing conducted in Zambia since independence in 1964. The country has so far conducted censuses in 1969, 1980, 1990 and 2000.

The 2010 Census of Population and Housing was carried out from 16th October to 15th November, 2010. The 2010 Census was conducted by a team of about 25,000 school leavers who worked as Census Enumerators, about 8,400 teachers and other civil servants who worked as Census Supervisors. Four hundred Civil Servants from various Government Departments and Ministries worked as Master Trainers, Assistant Master Trainers and Provincial Census Officers.

The Census was launched by His Excellency, The President of the Republic of Zambia Mr. Rupiah Bwezani Banda on 15th October, 2010. Thereafter, Census Enumerators went out visiting all buildings in Zambia whether completed, incomplete, abandoned, habitable and inhabitable for the purpose of identifying characteristics of all buildings, households and other human aspects. All persons who lived in the buildings were counted.

Persons who were present at the time of the enumerator's visit were counted directly as Usual Household Members present at the Housing Unit/Dwelling at the time of the enumerator's visit or as Visitors of the Household. While those who were absent were enumerated by proxy, that is, as Usual Household Members Absent from the Housing Unit/Dwelling at the time of the enumerator's visit.

Detailed personal information was only collected for Usual Household Members present and Visitors found at the Housing Unit/Dwelling at the time of the enumerator's visit, while for Usual Household Members Absent, only Age, Sex, Relationship to Household Head and Residence Status were collected by proxy from the main respondent for the Household.

## 2. What is new in the 2010 Census?

In the 2010 Census a single questionnaire was used to capture both individual and household characteristics. This is unlike in the 2000 Census where two different questionnaires, Form A (Household questionnaire) and Form B (Individual questionnaire) were used to collect information. The 2010 Census will use both Optical Mark Recognition (OMR) technology as well as Intelligent Character Recognition (ICR) technology, whereas the 2000 Census questionnaires were designed for processing using OMR technology only.

Among some of the new additions in terms of topics covered in the 2010 Census include Deaths of Household Members, Maternal Mortality and Game Ranching.

The 2010 Census used school leavers that had completed their Secondary School Education within 2-5 years prior to the Census as Enumerators while the 2000 Census used Grade Eleven School Pupils.

## 3. National Population Estimates

### Overview

The population of Zambia has been increasing from 7,759,161 in 1990, 9,885,591 in 2000 and 13,046,508 persons in 2010. This gives an average annual growth rate of 2.8 percent between 2000 and 2010. Of the 2010 population, 49 percent were males and 51 percent were females.

Three provinces had average growth rate above the national average. Lusaka Province had the highest average population growth rate of 4.7 percent followed by Northern (3.4 percent) and Southern (2.9 percent). The lowest growth rate was in Western Province with 1.4 percent.

The highest growth rate at district level were in Isoka and Luwingu in Northern Province at 5.2 percent each, closely followed by that of Kafue and Lusaka in Lusaka province at 4.9 each.

Luanshya (0.3 percent) and Masaiti (0.7 percent) on the Copperbelt Province had the lowest average annual population growth rate among the districts in the country.

### Population Size and Distribution

The population count from the 2010 Census of Population and Housing for Zambia is 13,046,508 as at October 2010. Of the 13,046,508 persons, 6,394,455 were males while 6,652,053 were females (Table 1).

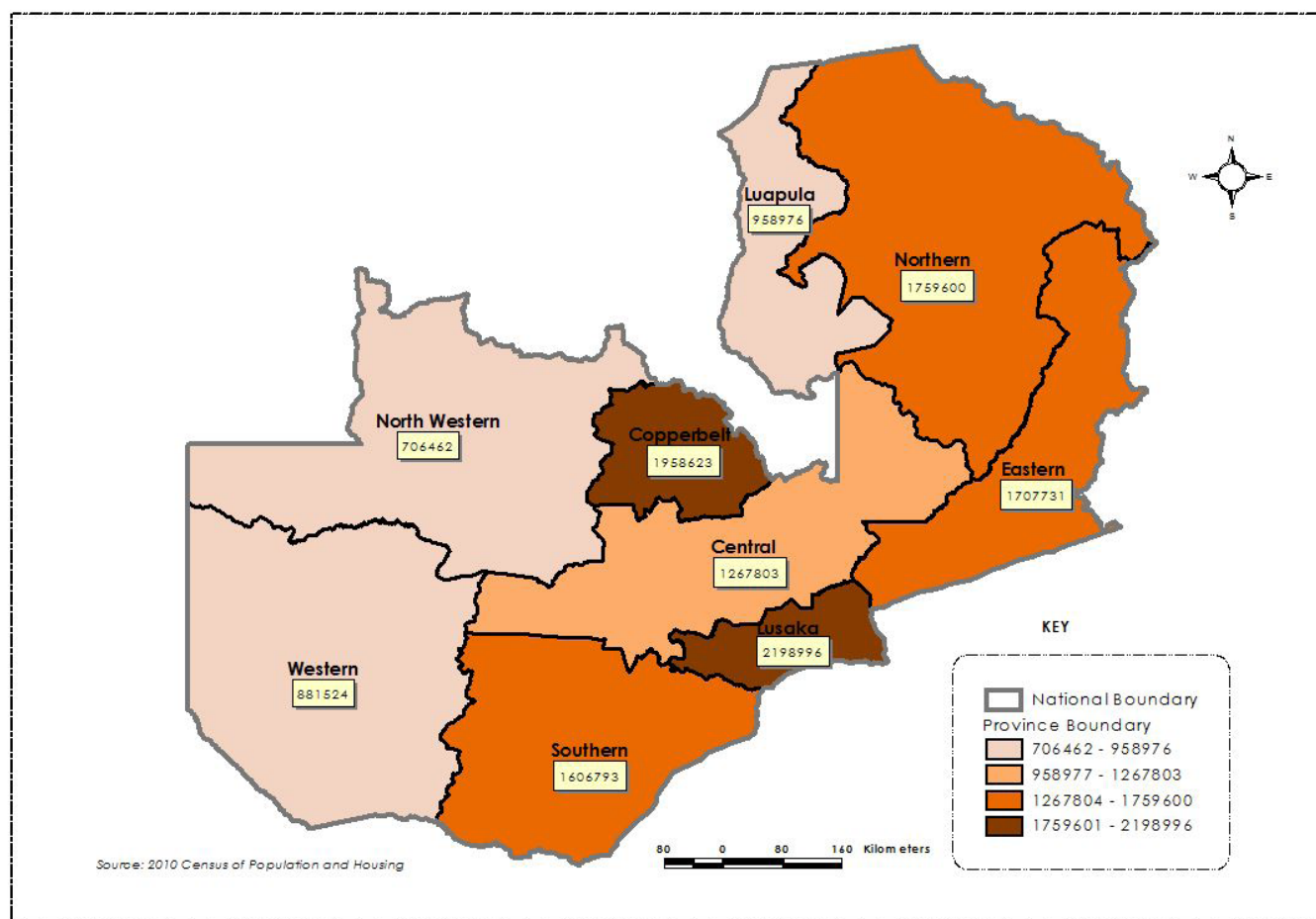
The regional distribution of the population shows that 7,978,274 people (61 percent) resided in rural areas and 5,068,234 (39 percent) resided in the urban areas (Figure 1).

At provincial level, Lusaka had the largest population with 2,198,996, followed by Copperbelt with 1,958,623, Northern with 1,759,600, Eastern with 1,707,731 and Southern with 1,606,793.

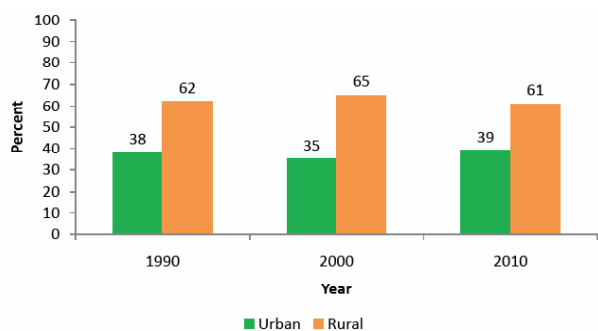
The province with the least population was North-western with 706,462 followed by Western Province with 881,524 and Luapula province with 958,976 (Map 1).

### Annual Rate of Population Growth

Table 2 shows the average annual population growth rate by Sex for Zambia during the inter-censal periods 1990 - 2000 and 2000 - 2010. The table shows that Zambia's population grew at an average annual rate of 2.8 percent in the 2000 - 2010 inter-censal period compared to a growth of 2.4 percent in the 1990 - 2000 period.

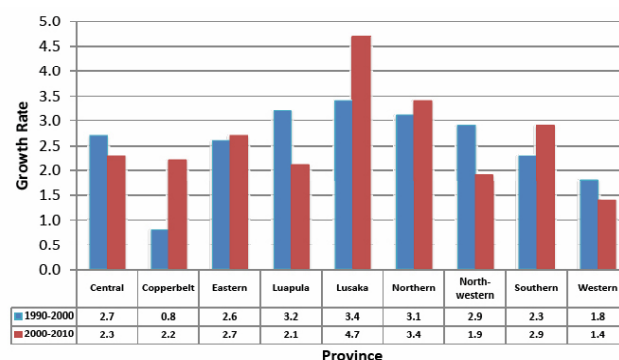
At provincial level, Lusaka had the highest annual population growth rate in the period 2000 - 2010 at 4.7 percent followed by Northern (3.4 percent) and Southern (2.9 percent) provinces. Western province had the lowest annual population growth rate in the same period of 1.4 percent.

There was a decline in annual average population growth rate in North-western, Luapula, Western and Central Provinces in the 2000 to 2010 inter-censal period. The rest of the provinces recorded positive annual population growths. The lowest population growth rate was that of Western Province which declined from 1.8 in the 1990 - 2000 inter-censal period to 1.4 percent in the 2000 - 2010 inter-censal period.

The growth rates for Lusaka, Northern and Southern provinces were higher than the national average growth rate. The rest of the provinces had lower growth rates compared to the national average.

The growth rates for provinces are also shown in Table 2 and Map 2.

**Figure 2: Average Annual Population Growth Rate by Province, 2000 - 2010**

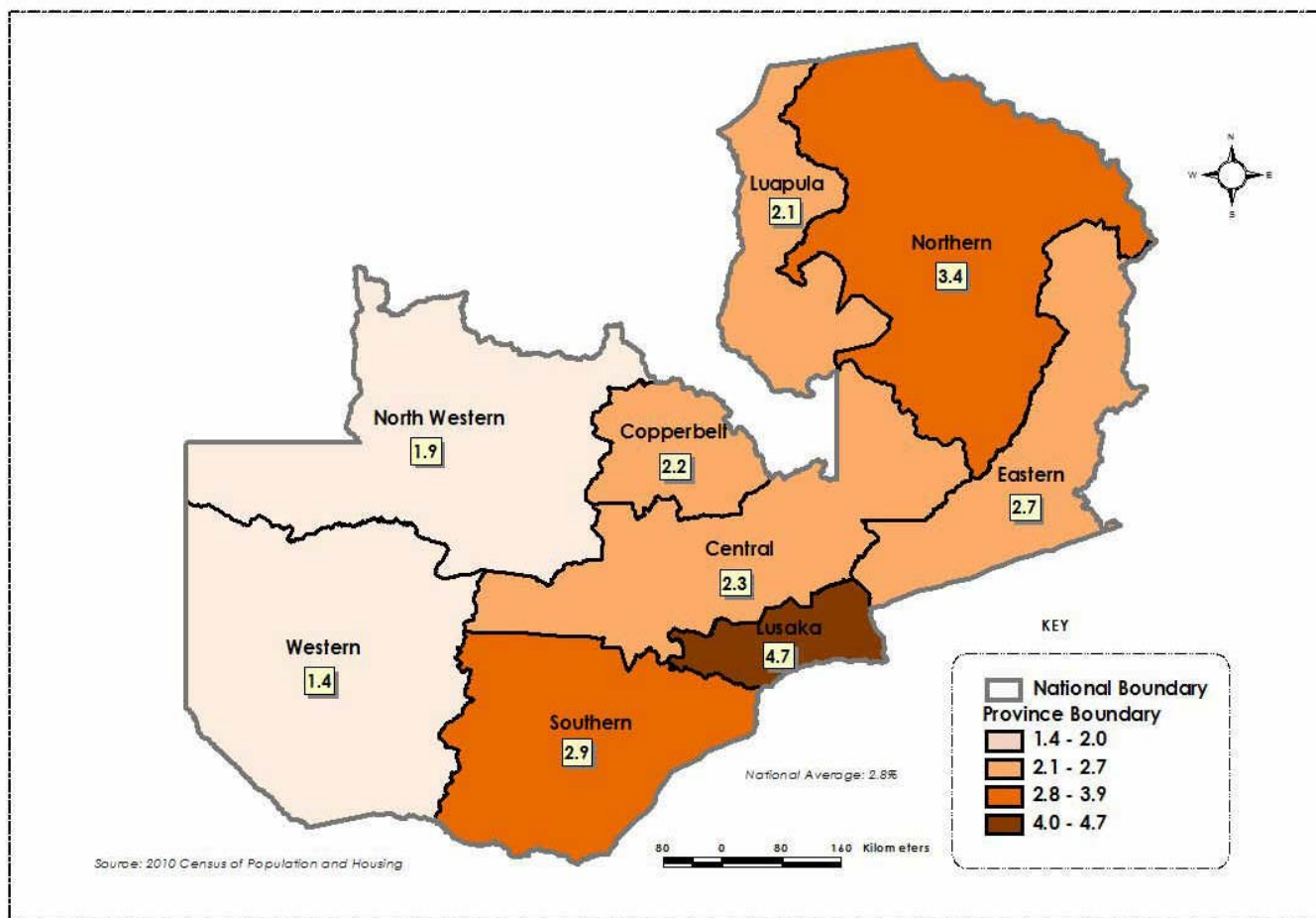

### 3. Population Density

Population Density is herein defined as the total number of people per square kilometre. The Population Density of Zambia increased from 7.5 in 1980 to 9.8 in 1990 to 13.1 in 2000 and now stands at 17.3 persons per square kilometer.

The most densely populated province in Zambia was Lusaka whose density increased from 31.6 in 1980 to 45.1 in 1990 to 63.5 in 2000 and 100.4 persons per square kilometre in 2010. The second most densely populated province was Copperbelt with a density of 62.5 persons per square kilometre. In the 1980 and 1990 Censuses, the density of Copperbelt Province was higher than that of Lusaka Province. North-western Province had the least density of 5.6 persons per square kilometre in 2010. It continued having the least density since 1980.

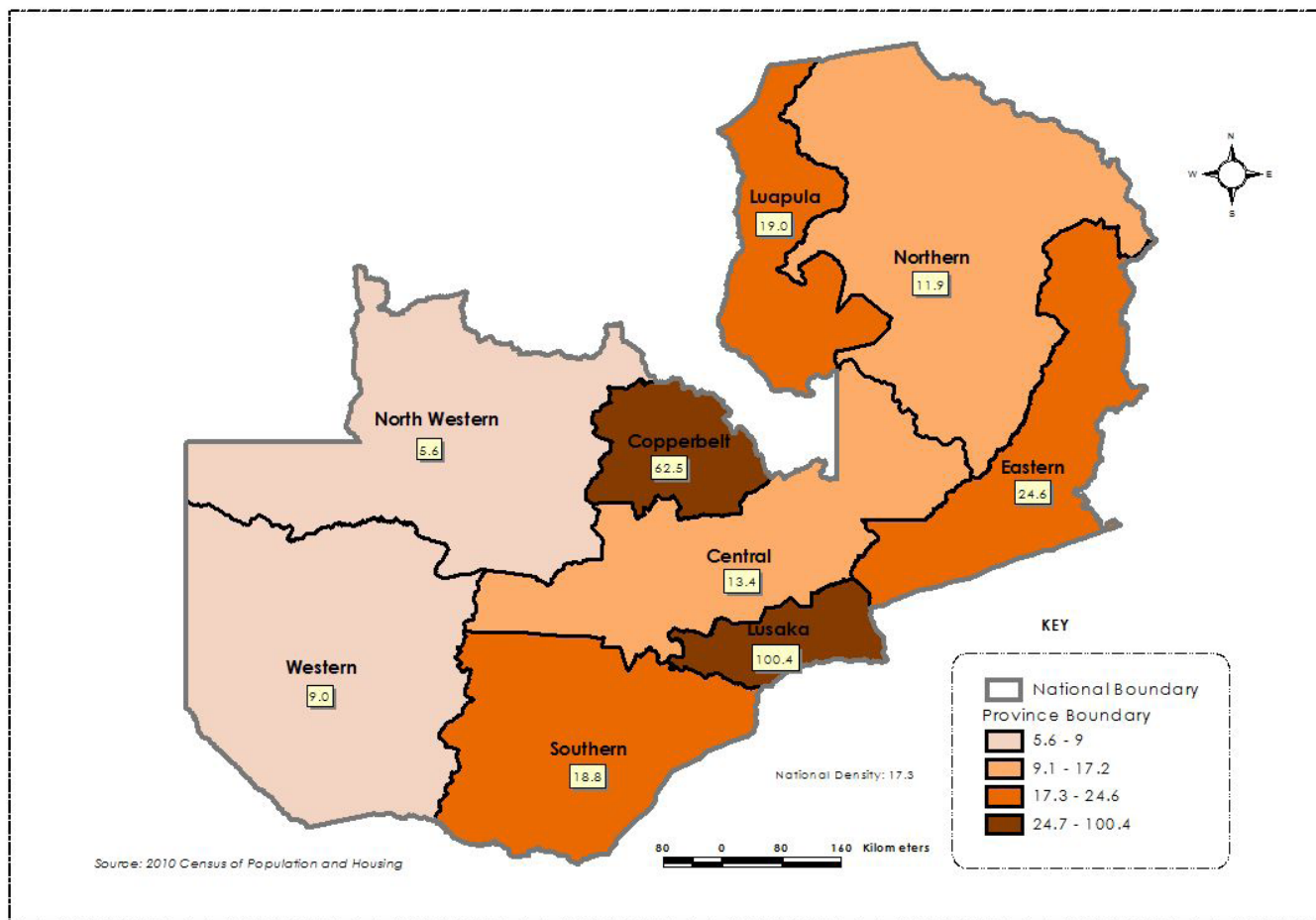
The percent distribution of Population has been declining on Copperbelt and Western provinces, while it has been increasing in Central, Eastern, Luapula, Lusaka, Northern and North-western Provinces. Lusaka Province had the highest increase making it the province with the largest share of the population at 17.2 percent in 2010. This was followed by Copperbelt Province at 15.5, Eastern Province at 13.1 and Northern Province at 12.8 percent. Southern Province had the fifth largest share at 11.7, followed by Central Province at 9.9 percent. Luapula Province had 7.5 percent share while Western Province had 6.8 percent. North-western Province had the smallest share at 5.5 percent. Details are presented in Annex 1.

### Trends in Population Density by Province, 2000-2010

Overall, the Population Density for Zambia increased from 13.1 persons per square kilometer in 2000 to 17.3 in 2010. Lusaka province had the highest increase in population density from 63.5 persons per square kilometer in 2000 to 100.4 in 2010. Copperbelt province had the second highest increase in population density from 50.5 to 62.5 persons per square kilometer. This was followed by 24.7 persons per square kilometer in Eastern Province. Western province had the lowest increase in population density from 6.1 in 2000 to 7.0 persons per square kilometer in 2010.

**4. Provincial Population Patterns and Trends**

**Central Province**

The population for Central Province increased from 1,012,257 in the year 2000 to 1,267,803 persons in the year 2010. Of the population in 2010, 49 percent were males and 51 percent were females. The population growth rate for Central Province declined from 2.7 percent in the 1990-2000 inter-censal period to 2.3 in the 2000 – 2010 inter-censal period. The district with the least population growth rate in Central Province was Kabwe which grew at 1.4 percent in the 2000 – 2010 inter-censal period. Mkushi district had the highest population growth rate of 3.5 percent followed by Mumbwa district which grew at 3.2 percent in the 2000 – 2010 inter-censal period.

Chibombo District had the largest share of the population in the province at 23.2 percent followed by Kapiri Mposhi District at 19 percent. Mkushi District had the least share of the province’s population at 12 percent.

**Copperbelt Province**

The population for Copperbelt Province was 1,958,623. Of this population 49.7 percent were males and 50.3 percent were females. The average annual population growth rate for the province was 2.2 percent in the 2000 – 2010 inter-censal period. The average annual population growth rate was highest in Mpongwe District at 3.6 percent. This was closely followed by Kitwe and Chililabombwe districts at 3.3 and 3.0 percent growth, respec-

tively. Luanshya and Masaiti Districts had less than 1 percent population growth. Luanshya had a population growth rate of 0.3 percent while Masaiti grew at 0.7 percent in the inter-censal period 2000 – 2010.

Kitwe District had the largest share of the population in the province at 26.7 percent. This was closely followed by Ndola district at 23.2 percent of the population. Lufwanyama District had the smallest share of the population at 3.9 percent of the total population on the Copperbelt Province.

**Eastern Province**

Eastern Province had a population of 1,707,731. Of this population, 49 percent were males while 50 percent were females. The population in Eastern province grew at an average annual growth rate of 2.7 percent in the period 2000 - 2010. The growth rate increased from 2.6 percent in the 1990-2000 inter-censal period. The average annual population growth rates for all the districts in Eastern Province were above 2 percent. The population growth rates ranged from 2.0 percent in Nyimba District to 4.1percent in Mambwe District in the 2000 – 2010 inter-censal period.

Chipata district had the largest percentage share of the population in the province at 26.5 percent while Mambwe District had the least share at 4.2 percent.

## **Luapula Province**

The population for Luapula province was 958,976 persons. Forty-nine percent of this population were males and 51 percent were females. In the 2000 – 2010 inter-censal period, the population for Luapula Province had been growing at an annual average growth rate of 2.1 percent compared to 3.2 percent in the 1990 – 2000 inter-censal period. The district growth rates varied considerably from 1.1 percent in Mwense to 4.2 percent in Milenge.

The largest share of the population in the Province was in Mansa District at 22.7 percent while the least share was in Milenge District at 4.6 percent of the total population.

## **Lusaka Province**

The population for Lusaka Province increased from 1,391,329 in 2000 to 2,198,996 in 2010. This means that the annual average population growth rate for the province was 4.7 percent in the 2000 – 2010 inter-censal period. The growth rate increased from 3.4 percent in the 1990 – 2000 inter-censal period. Lusaka province had the highest provincial population growth rate in the country. Kafue and Lusaka districts had the highest annual average growth rate in the province at 4.9 percent each. Chongwe district grew at a rate of 3.2 percent while Luangwa had the lowest growth rate of 2.9 percent.

More than three quarters (79 percent) of the provincial population was in Lusaka district. Luangwa district had the lowest share of the population at 1.2 percent.

## **Northern Province**

Northern Province had a population of 1,759,600 of which 49.0 percent were males and 51.0 percent were females. The population has increased from 1,258,696 in 2000. This indicates an annual population growth rate of 3.4 percent.

Among the districts in the province, Chinsali had the lowest population growth rate at 1.4 percent while Luwingu and Isoka had the highest growth rate at 5.2 percent each.

Kasama district had the largest share of population in the province with 13.5 percent followed by Mbala with 12.1 percent and Mpika 12.0 percent. Chilubi District had the smallest percent share of 4.4 percent.

## **North-western Province**

The population for North-western Province increased from 583,350 in 2000 to 706,462 in 2010. This gives an average annual population growth rate of 1.9 percent. The population growth rate declined from 3.8 percent between 1980-1990 to 2.9 percent between 1990-2000 to 1.9 percent in the 2000-2010 period.

Zambezi district had the highest annual population growth rate of 3.2 percent followed by Kabompo (2.5 percent), Kasempa (2.4 percent), Mufumbwe (2.3 percent) and Solwezi (1.6 percent). Mwini-lunga and Chavuma Districts had 1.2 percent growth each.

Solwezi district had the largest share of the provincial population at 33.8 percent, followed by Mwinilunga at 18.8 percent, Kabompo at 12.9 percent and Zambezi at 12.6 percent. Chavuma had the smallest share of population at 4.8 percent.

## **Southern Province**

Southern Province had a population of 1,606,793 of which 49 percent were males and 51 percent were females. The population increased from 1,212,124 in 2000. The average annual population growth rate for the province over the intercensal period 2000-2010 was 2.9 percent. There was a decline in the growth rate from 2.3 percent in the 1990 -2000 period to 2.9 percent between 2000 and 2010.

Among the districts of the province, Gwembe has the highest population growth rate of 4.4 percent, followed by Siavonga at 4.3 percent and Itezhi tezhi and Kalomo with 4.1 percent each. The Districts with the least population growth were Choma and Monze with a rate of population growth of 1.8 percent each.

Mazabuka District had the highest population share within the province of 16.3, followed by Kalomo with 15.8, Choma 15.2 percent and Monze 12.2 percent. Gwembe had the smallest population share of 3.3 percent.

## **Western Province**

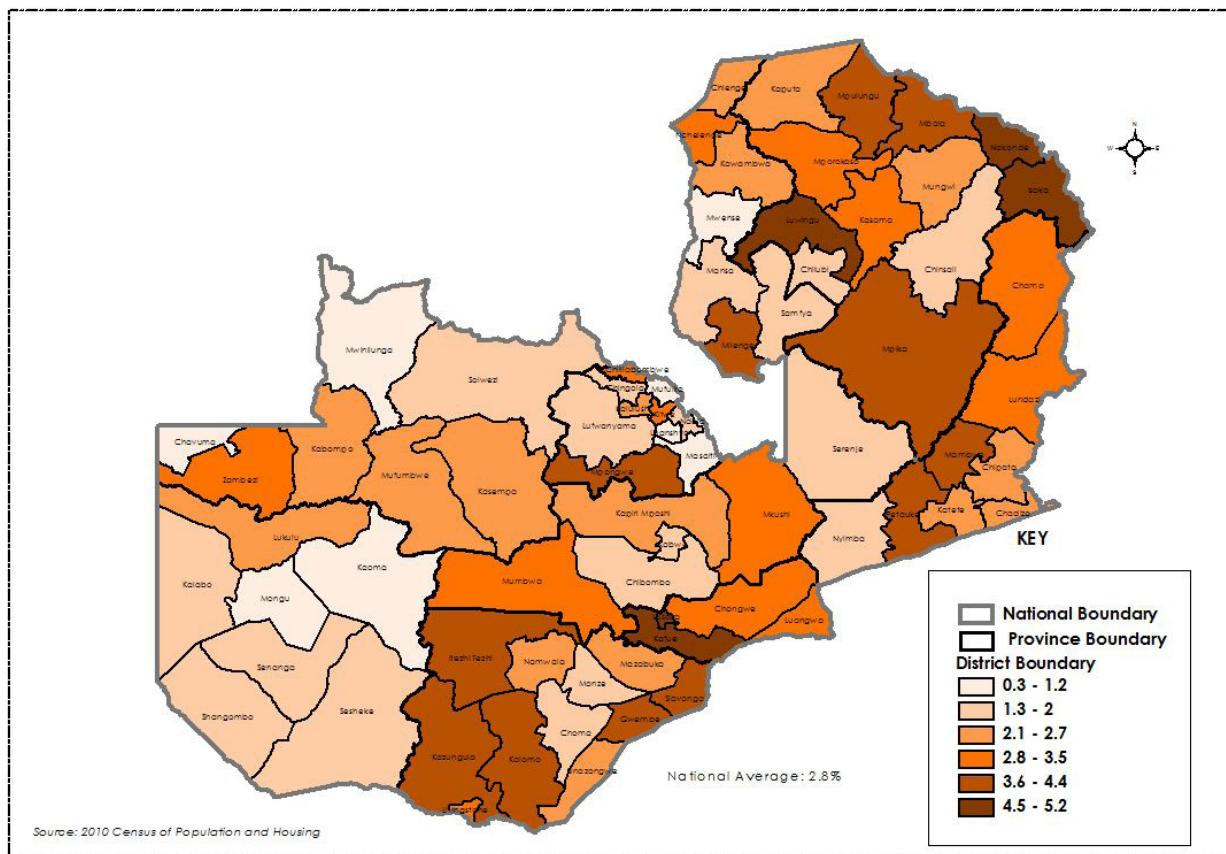
The population for Western Province increased from 638,756 in 1990 to 765,088 in 2000 and to 881,524 in 2010. Of the total provincial population, 47.0 percent were males and 53.0 percent were females. The average annual growth rate for the province for the period between 2000 and 2010 was 1.4 percent.

Among the districts, Lukulu had the highest rate of growth at 2.1 percent followed by Shangombo 2.0 and Sesheke at 1.9 percent. Kaoma and Mongu had the lowest growth rates of 1 percent each.

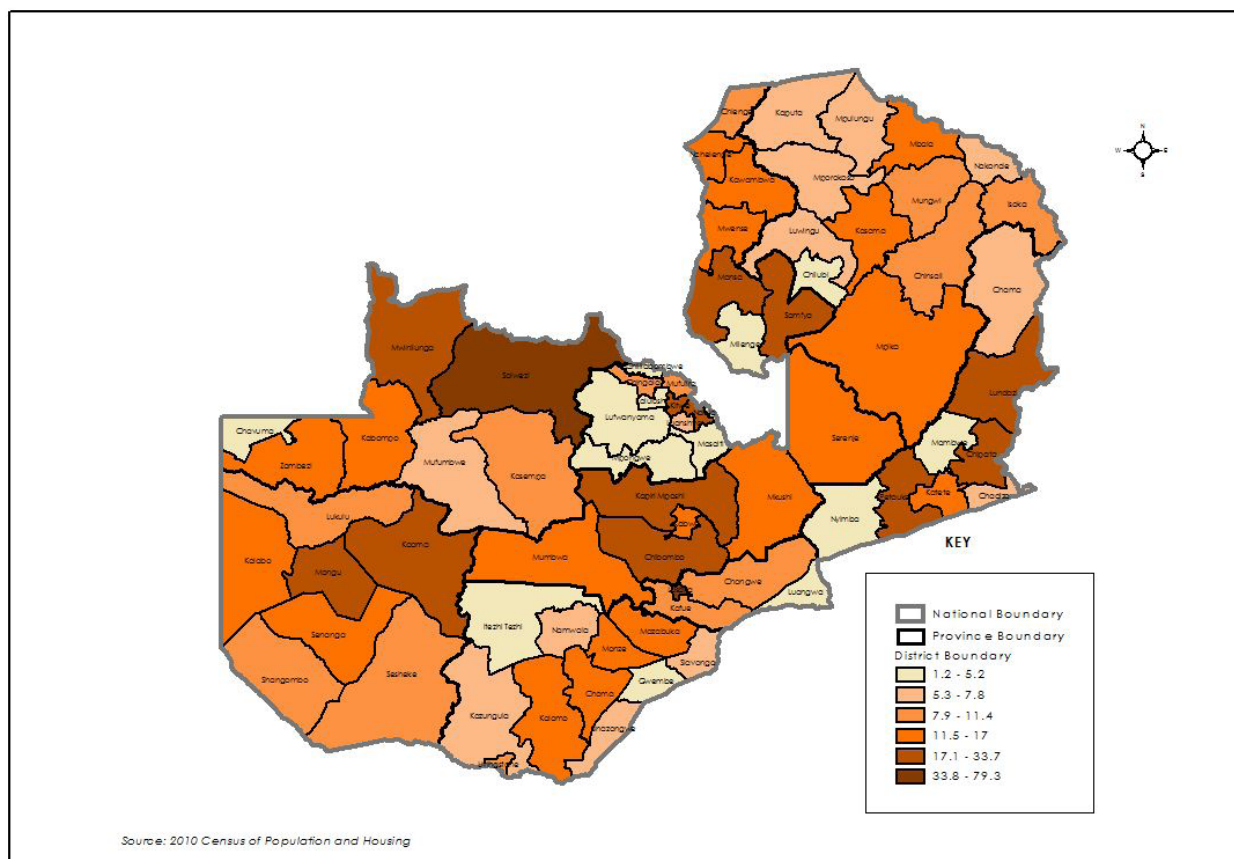
Kaoma had the largest share of population at 20.3 percent followed by Mongu 20.2 percent and Kalabo 15.1 percent. Lukulu District had the smallest share of population with 9.5 percent.

**Map 5: Percent Share of Population by District within Province, Zambia, 2010**





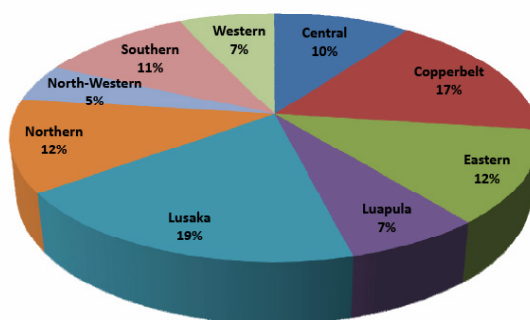
## 5. Electoral Information

In Zambia, the voting age is 18 years and above. Any person who is aged 18 years and above is therefore eligible to vote in any Presidential, Parliamentary and local government elections.

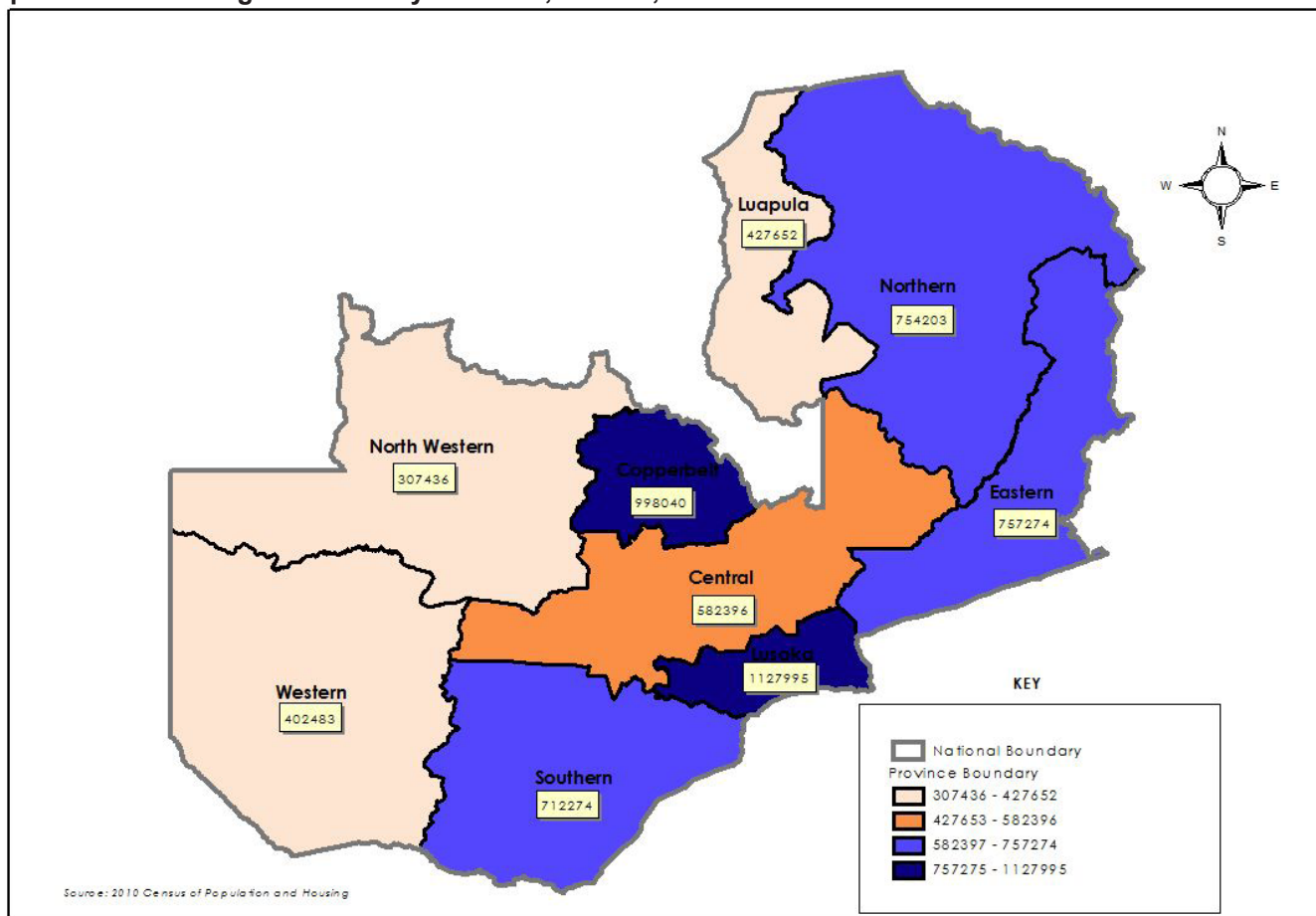
### Number of Eligible Voters

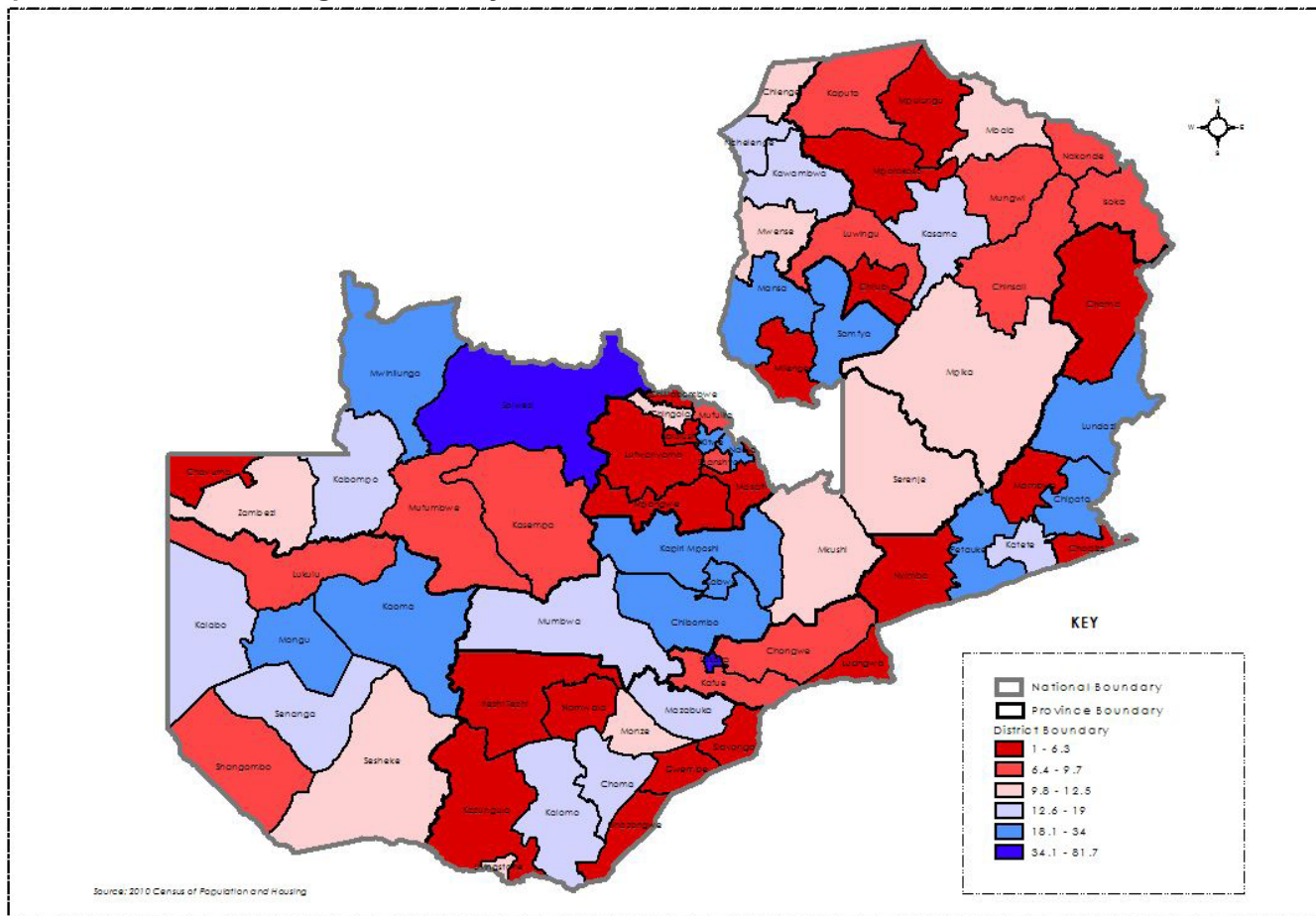
**Figure 3: Percent Share of Eligible Voters by Province, Zambia, 2010**

The total number of eligible voters from the 2010 Census was 6,069,753 representing 47 percent of the total population of Zambia. Figure 3 and Map 6 show the percent share of eligible voters by province. The figures show that Lusaka Province had the highest share of eligible voters at 19 percent followed by Copperbelt at 17 percent. Northern and Eastern provinces had 12 percent share of eligible voters each. Southern Province had a share of 11 percent, Central province had 10 percent while Luapula and Western provinces had 7 percent each. The province with the least share of eligible voters was North-western with 5 percent.

**Map 7: Percent Share of Eligible Voters by District within the Province, Zambia, 2010**

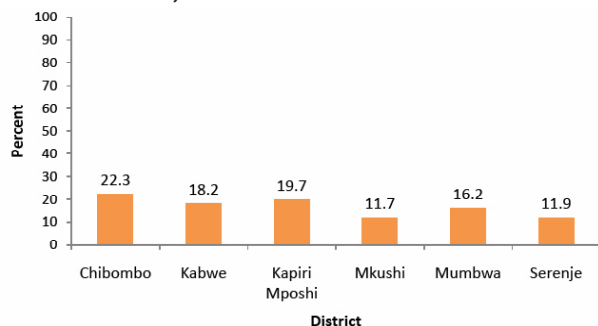


**Distribution of Eligible Voters by District**

**Central Province**

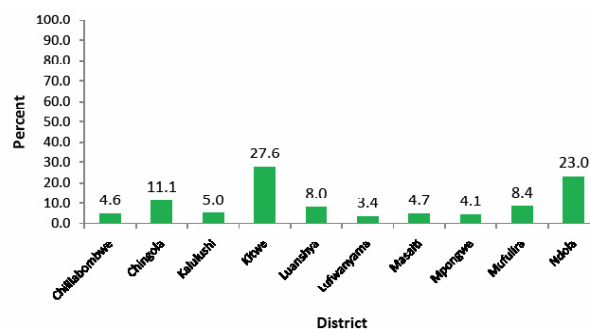
**Figure 4: Percent Share of Eligible Voters by District, Central Province, 2010**

Figure 4 below shows the percent share of eligible voters in Central Province. Of the total number of eligible voters in the province of 582,396, the largest share was in Chibombo District at 22.3 percent, followed by Kapiri Mposhi (19.7 percent) and Kabwe (18.2 percent). Sixteen percent of eligible voters were in Mumbwa district. Serenje and Mkushi districts had the least share of eligible voters in the province at 11.9 and 11.7 percent, respectively.

**Copperbelt Province**

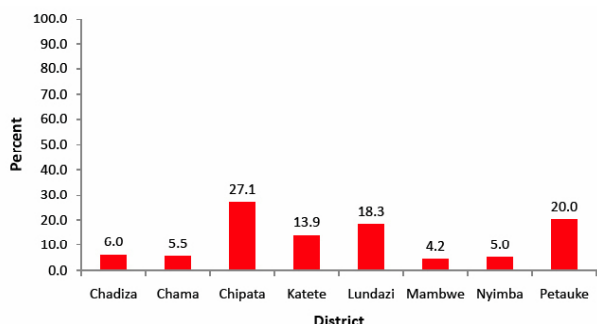
**Figure 5: Percent Share of Eligible Voters by District, Copperbelt Province, 2010**

Figure 5 shows the percent share of eligible voters in Copperbelt Province. Of the total number of eligible voters in the province of 998,040, Kitwe District had the largest share of eligible voters at 27.6 percent. This was followed by Ndola at 23.0 percent and Chingola at 11.1 percent. The rest of the districts in the province had less than 10 percent share of eligible voters each.

### Eastern Province

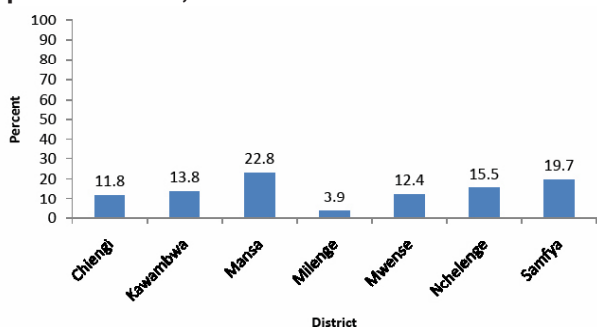
**Figure 6: Percent Share of Eligible Voters by District, Eastern Province, 2010**

Figure 6 shows the percent share of eligible voters in Eastern Province. Chipata District had the largest share of eligible voters of the total number (757,274) in Eastern Province at 27.1 percent. It was followed by Petauke (20 percent), Lundazi (18.3 percent) and Katete (13.9 percent). The rest of the districts in the province had less than 10 percent share of eligible voters each i.e. Chadiza (6 percent), Chama (5.5 percent), Nyimba (5 percent) and Mambwe (4.2).

### Luapula Province

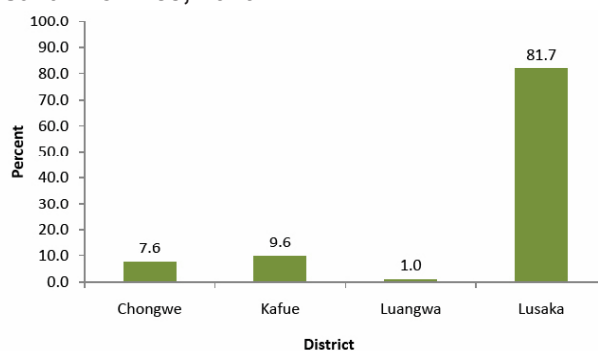
**Figure 7: Percent Share of Eligible Voters by District, Luapula Province, 2010**

Figure 7 below shows the percent share of eligible voters in Luapula province. Mansa district had the largest share of the total number of eligible voters of 427,652 in the province at 22.8 percent followed by Samfya district at 19.7 percent. Milenge had the least share of eligible voters in the province at 3.9 percent.

### Lusaka Province

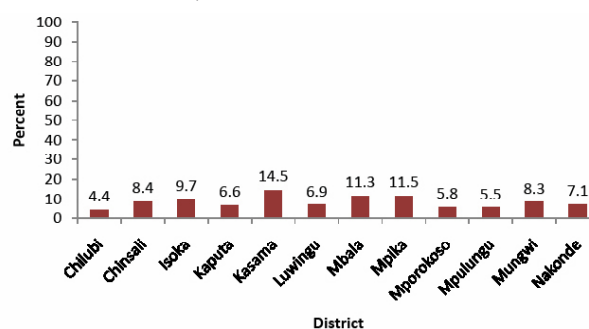
**Figure 8: Percent Share of Eligible Voters by District, Lusaka Province, 2010**

Figure 8 below shows the percent share of eligible voters in Lusaka province. Of the total number of eligible voters in Lusaka province, Lusaka district had the largest share at 81.7 percent. The other districts in the province shared the remaining 18.2 percent share of eligible voters. Kafue had 9.6 percent, Chongwe had 7.6 percent while Luangwa district had 1 percent.

### Northern Province

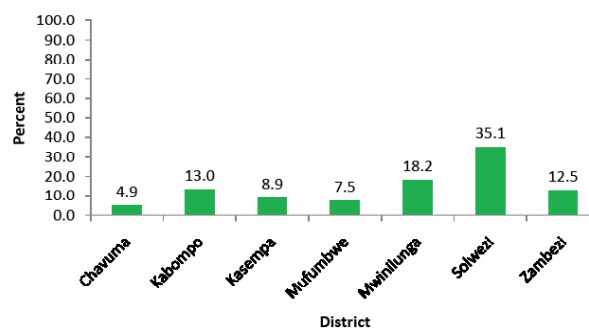
**Figure 9: Percent Share of Eligible Voters by District, Northern Province, 2010**

Figure 9 below shows the percent share of eligible voters in Northern Province. The figure shows that of the total eligible voters of 754,203 in the province, Kasama had the highest percentage at 14.5 percent followed by Mpika (11.5 percent) and Mbala (11.3 percent). The District with the lowest percent share of eligible voters was Chilubi District at 4.4 percent.

### North-western

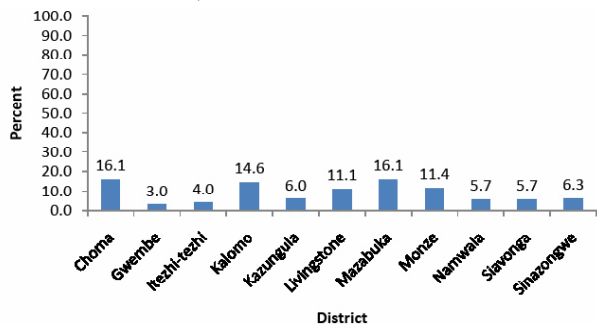
**Figure 10: Percent Share of Eligible Voters by District, North-western Province, 2010**

Figure 10 below shows the percent share of Eligible voters in North-western Province. The figure shows that of the total number of eligible voters of 307,436 in the province, Solwezi District had the highest percent share at 35.1 percent, followed by Mwinilunga at 18.2 and Kabompo at 13.0 percent. Chavuma had the least percent share of eligible voters at 4.9 percent.

### Southern Province

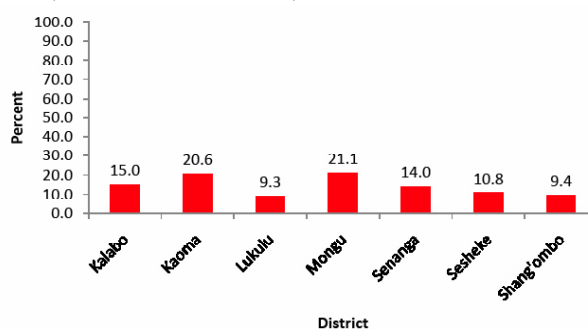
**Figure 11: Percent Share of Eligible Voters by District, Southern Province, 2010**

Figure 11 below shows the percent share of eligible voters in Southern Province. The figure shows that of the total number of eligible voters of 712,274 in the province, Mazabuka and Choma had the highest share of 16.1 percent each, followed by Kalomo at 14.6 percent, Monze (11.4 percent) and Livingstone (11.1 percent). Gwembe District had the lowest percent share of eligible voters at 3 percent.

### Western Province

Figure 12 below shows the percent share of eligible voters in Western Province. The figure shows that of the total eligible voters of 402,483 in the province, Mongu District had the highest percent share of 21.1 percent. This was followed by Kaoma at 20.6 percent, Kalabo (15 percent) and Senanga (14 percent). Lukulu had the lowest percent share in the province with 9.3 percent.

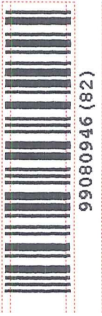
