



#### Lincoln

Set amongst the modern shops, bars, restaurants, waterside centre and market is the medieval centre of Lincoln City which is blessed with an abundance of original 14th and 15th century buildings and half-timbered tudor houses. Brayford Pool a natural harbour on the river Witham is within two minutes walk from the centre, here you can enjoy the river cruises in summer or relax in the riverside bars. The modern university and a nine screen cinema is also situated here. Take a challenging walk up Steephill, this is always an interesting part of the city to visitors, laced with unique shops, art galleries, and the well-known Browns Pie Shop. In the Bailgate at the top of the hill you will find cobbled streets with interesting shops and the magnificent Cathedral and Castle, which were built during the reign of William the Conqueror. This is also the site of the famous Lincoln Christmas Market.



# Gainsborough

A market town and river port which has retained some of its 18th century buildings and the Jewel of Gainsborough, The Medieval Manor House, where kings have dined. Once a port the Riverside area has been transformed with a promenade and leisure moorings creating an impressive setting. Visit the Model Railway a museum in miniature with a fine scale model layout of Kings Cross and other East Coast mainline stations, a nostalgic reminder of the steam railway era. Gainsborough's 15th century, immaculately preserved, Medieval Manor House is reputedly the best Baronial hall in the land with a magnificent Great Hall where Richard III and Henry VIII once dined and medieval kitchens that remain virtually unchanged recreate an historic atmosphere. Walk into this awesome past and take in the wonderful views of the Trent Valley, almost to the Humber, from the top of the tower.



## Scunthorpe

A vibrant garden town noted for its beautiful parklands, Scunthorpe evolved from five small villages with the development of the steel industry. On selected weekends you can take a tour of the Steelworks on a restored steam locomotive, learn how technology has changed since the first ironworks began production and glimpse red-hot steel being rolled in the mills. The Foundary/Parishes Shopping Centre is set in the heart of Scunthorpe with over fifty shops offering both modern and traditional retailers including Boots, New Look, Westgate, Dorothy Perkins and much much more. Get bargains galore in the varied and friendly indoor market, with everything from fresh produce, meats, fish, materials, books, clothing, house hold items and crafts. Market days are Friday and Saturday, however the food hall is open Monday to Saturday. Visit the Visual Arts Centre (Church Sq) with contemporary art and craft exhibitions and related events and activities. Whether you fancy playing some sport or enjoy quiet surrondings then try Central Park (Kingsway, Ashby Road) with its new Pods Lesuire Centre, a small woodland and a sports area is an ideal day out!
