Many rides at Worlds of Fun & Oceans of Fun are dynamic and thrilling. There are inherent risks in riding any amusement ride. For your protection, each ride is rated for its special features, such as high speed, steep drops, sharp turns or other dynamic forces. If you choose to ride, you accept all of these risks. Restrictions for guests of extreme size (height or weight) are posted at certain rides. Guests with disabilities should refer to our Ride Admission Policy available at Guest Relations. Participate responsibly. You should be in good health to ride safely. You know your physical conditions and limitations, Worlds of Fun & Oceans of Fun does not. If you suspect your health could be at risk for any reason, or you could aggravate a preexisting condition of any kind, DO NOT RIDE!

Guests of Larger Size

All passenger restraint systems, including lap bars, shoulder harnesses and seatbelts, must be positioned and fastened properly to allow guests to ride. Maximum recommended weight limits are posted at the rides and in this Guest Assistance Guide.

**Welcome to Worlds of Fun
and Oceans of Fun!**

We are glad you're here. We have plenty of exciting rides and shows for everyone. We are committed to providing our guests with a safe environment and we want our guests to have a safe and enjoyable day.

Many amusement park rides incorporate safety systems designed by the manufacturer to accommodate people of average physical stature and body proportion. These safety systems may place restrictions on the ability of an individual to safely experience the ride. Extremely large or small individuals, guests who have a history of heart, back, neck trouble or recent surgery, pregnant women, people with casts, braces, restrictive devices or disabilities may not be safely accommodated by these systems. For example, height requirements are based on the size needed for safety systems to function properly and the level of maturity usually associated with a certain height.

Our Ride Admission Policy has been developed in consultation with a biodynamics engineer and a rehabilitation specialist, based on the recommendations of the manufacturer, our past experience and our evaluation of each ride using our knowledge of the ride both in normal and emergency operating conditions. Our prime consideration is the ability of each person to endure the dynamics of each ride without risk of injury to that person or other riders.






Any guest who feels he/she may be affected by this policy is encouraged to visit the Guest Relations Office for more information.

Ride Rating System






A Ride Rating Program has been designed which provides a scale for rating the thrill factor of each ride. The intent is to provide a scale to guide Park guests in determining which attractions to ride based on their own experience level, physical condition, and abilities.

Each ride/attraction is placed into one of five categories:

















Worlds of Fun

CATEGORY	DESCRIPTION
Low Thrill Rides	 Rides that are generally calm and gentle in nature.
Mild Thrill Rides	 Rides that generally have low speeds with gentle motion and braking. Rides have smooth transitions with some changes in elevation and speed.
Moderate Thrill Rides	 Rides that generally have low to medium speeds and/or heights with moderate motion and braking. Riders may encounter unexpected changes in direction and/or speed during portions of the ride.
High Thrill Rides	 Rides that generally have medium to high speeds and/or heights with moderate to rapid braking. Riders may encounter unexpected changes in speed, direction and/or elevation.
Aggressive Thrill Rides	 Rides that generally have one or more of the following: high speeds and/or heights, aggressive and unexpected forces, and rapid directional or elevation change. Riders will encounter many unexpected rapid changes in speed, direction and/or elevation.

Oceans of Fun

CATEGORY	DESCRIPTION
Low Thrill Rides	 This is a low speed, and/or shallow water attraction.
Mild Thrill Rides	 This is a low to medium speed attraction, and/or water depth to 48 inches. Some rider control, maneuvering and/or swimming skills required.
Moderate Thrill Rides	 This is a medium speed attraction. Height and water depth may vary. Moderate or unexpected forces can be generated during the ride. This attraction may require rider control and/or strong swimming skills. Physical activity may be strenuous.
High Thrill Rides	 This is a fast paced ride experience. Riders will encounter changes in speed, direction, elevation, strong water currents, and/or depth of water, some of which is unexpected. This attraction requires rider body control and strong swimming skills.
Aggressive Thrill Rides	 This is a high speed and/or deep water attraction with turbulent turns, drops and/or strong water currents with changes in speed, direction, elevation and/or deep water, which may be unexpected. This attraction requires rider body control and strong swimming skills.

Rider Abilities

All riders should be in good health and free from any condition known or unknown that might be aggravated by participating in a ride or attraction. In most cases guests must be able to maintain an upright position including head, neck and torso and brace themselves with legs and arms for possible rapid accelerations or decelerations.

In order to ride independently, the guest must have: the ability to exhibit seated postural control under the dynamic conditions of the ride, appropriate center of gravity, control of upper torso including neck and head, minimum of two or three functioning extremities, ability to enter/exit ride within specified parameters without endangering self or others, and appropriate observed behavior indicating a willingness and ability to participate and/or follow rider requirements.

Depending on the specific dynamics of each ride, hand held infants as well as the following conditions may not be permitted: cervical collar or neck brace, broken collar bone, full arm cast, braced arm cast, brace between legs and full leg cast.

Evacuations

In case of an emergency such as weather conditions, mechanical problems, or power interruption, evacuations may be required. Guests may need to maneuver across catwalks at high points of a ride and may need to go down steeply inclined catwalks or stairs. At Oceans of Fun, guests may be asked to evacuate pools as quickly as possible using stairs or ladders.

If evacuation from a ride/attraction is required, for safety reasons, we may evacuate ambulatory guests prior to evacuation those guests using wheelchairs. If so, you accept any danger due to delayed evacuation or if we need to physically lift or lower you.

Before You Ride

If in doubt about your ability to safely experience a ride, we urge you to consult with our Guest Relations staff.

Entry through an Alternate Access should be limited to the guest requiring the access due to limited mobility restrictions and one escort. We ask that others in your party go through the standard entrance and join you and your escort at the loading area. Alternate Accesses are intended to accommodate wheelchairs and not to bypass others waiting in line. Guests will be asked to wait the length of the line prior to Alternate Access boarding.

On most rides guests must leave their wheelchair to board the ride unit. Worlds of Fun and Oceans of Fun personnel are not trained in transferring guests from wheelchairs to ride units and are not permitted to do so. You should plan your visit with someone who can physically help you when necessary.

Whenever a guest is required to be accompanied by a responsible person, the person must be able to safely ride the ride in addition to assisting the guest in and out of the ride. Due to rider restraint system requirements, guests of larger size may not be accommodated on some of our rides. This may apply, but not be limited to, guests who exceed 6'2" or those who exceed 250 lbs, have a 46" waistline or a 54" chest.

Only certain rides can accommodate Service Dogs. See "Special Services" #8 for more information.

Ride Safely

Safety First

People who jeopardize another person's safety, do not obey regulations and rules, behave in an unruly fashion, or give the indication of being under the influence of alcohol or chemical intoxicants will not be permitted to ride. For your safety and the safety of other guests, please fasten and tighten your seatbelt, lap bar, or shoulder harness and keep them fastened and tightened until the ride comes to a complete stop. Face forward on all rides keeping all parts of your body inside the ride unit and hold on at all times until the ride comes to a complete stop. Please read and observe all posted rules, regulations, instructions, and warnings prior to participation on the attractions.

State of Missouri Rider Responsibility Law: RSMO 316.230 Requires that riders must obey all warnings regarding this ride and behave in a manner that will not cause or contribute to injury to themselves or others. Failure to comply is a misdemeanor.



Loose Articles

For safety reasons large items such as strollers, large stuffed animals, basketballs, etc., are not permitted past the ride entrance. Other items such as umbrellas, crutches, large cameras, etc., may be taken past the ride entrance but will not be permitted on the ride. Eyewear and headwear must be secured. Headphones will not be worn on rides. Please store such items in lockers or leave them in your vehicle or with a non-rider. Ride operators will not be allowed to hold items belonging to guests. Worlds of Fun/Oceans of Fun are not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items. If you lose an item on a ride, we will search for the article as soon as is practical. In order to keep the ride in operation an immediate search may not be possible. Entry into restricted areas is prohibited and could result in personal harm; violators will be prosecuted. All found items will be taken to Worlds of Fun/Oceans of Fun Guest Relations. Found items will be donated or destroyed after 7 days, if not claimed.



Camera Policy

Picture and video taking on any ride is not permitted due to safety reasons. Small cameras may be taken onto a ride provided they are secured in a safe manner. Cameras of any kind are not permitted on any slides at Oceans of Fun. Cameras and/or cell phones should not be used while in restrooms or bathhouses.

Casts and Braces

Guests with full arm or leg casts or braces will be restricted from riding rides where the cast or brace may present a hazard to the guest or others. Please consult with the Guest Relations staff for information.

Pregnancy

It is recommended that pregnant women refrain from riding all rides with the exception of Le Carrousel, Grand Carrousel and the Worlds of Fun Railroad.

Prosthetic Devices

Guests with any type of prosthesis should not ride Detonator or Patriot unless they can ensure the device is properly secured and will remain in place during the ride. Prosthetic devices may be removed as long as the rider still meets the Ride Admission Policy requirements to ride. Guests with prosthetics which do not have any exposed metal parts are generally permitted on all waterpark attractions. Please consult with a member of management prior to riding to ensure that you have a safe riding experience.

Recent Surgery, Heart, Back, Neck Problems and/or Pregnancy



Guests with a history of recent surgery, heart trouble/high blood pressure, neck trouble, or any other condition that may be aggravated by riding, or who are pregnant, should carefully heed all warning signs at each ride entrance. If you are in doubt about your ability to safely experience a ride or would like more rider information, please visit our Guest Relations building located at the main entrance to the park or request to speak with a Ride Operations Supervisor.

General Posted Safety warnings

- Face forward and remain seated in an upright position with your back and shoulders against the seat back and hold on until the ride comes to a complete stop.
- Attention Riders: Due to the nature of our rides, backpacks, purses, electronics, stuffed animals and other loose items are not permitted on most rides. Glasses must be secured. Smaller items may be secured in cargo pockets, waist packs, left in a locker or with a non-rider.
- All passenger restraint systems, including lap bars, shoulder harnesses and seatbelts, must be positioned, fastened and tightened at all times.
- No picture taking while riding or sliding.
- Keep all of your body inside the ride unit at all times.
- Shirts are required on all rides at Worlds of Fun.
- Finish food and drink before boarding.
- Smoking is only allowed in designated areas.


While all amusement attractions have associated risks, certain individuals are at increased risk for injury from these attractions. Please carefully evaluate each attraction to determine if you or members of your party can safely participate. If you would like more information about the abilities our attractions require, stop by Guest Relations at the main entrance of our parks.

Special Services



We are trying to make Worlds of Fun and Oceans of Fun as enjoyable and barrier free as practical. We offer several services to accommodate everyone. Should you find that you need assistance at any point during your visit, please do not hesitate to ask any one of our staff members. They will be happy to assist you in any way needed to make your visit more enjoyable.

1. Most rides at Worlds of Fun have an Alternate Access which are marked with an illustrated sign. Guests with mobility restrictions and one riding

companion may enter via the Alternate Access after their remaining party waits in the regular line. Guests will be asked to wait the length of the line prior to boarding.

2. We have a limited supply of wheelchairs available for rental on first-come, first-served basis at the Rental Center near All Stars Grill. Wheelchairs cannot be reserved in advance and we urge guests to bring their own wheelchairs.
3. The Worlds of Fun First Aid Station is located near the Main Entrance and the Oceans of Fun First Aid Station is located next to Surf City Wave Pool. Both stations are staffed by EMTs during park hours. Refrigeration for medication is available at First Aid.
4. Parking for guests with disabilities at Worlds of Fun is located in parking lot B on a first-come, first-served basis. Oceans of Fun's disabilities parking is located in the lower level parking lot near the Oceans of Fun Main Entrance. (Attendants at both Toll Plaza booths can give directions.)
5. Wheelchairs can be accommodated in all restaurants, gift shops, theatres, games and arcades.
6. All in-park restrooms are wheelchair accessible except for the Planet Snoopy and Boomerang restroom.
7.  TTY and wheelchair accessible pay phones are available outside the Worlds of Fun main entrance and at Guest Relations at Oceans of Fun.
8. Service dogs are welcome at Worlds of Fun/ Oceans of Fun. Service dogs must be physically controlled on a leash or harness at all times. Due to the nature of most rides, service dogs must remain with a non-rider. Park Ambassadors are not permitted to take control of service dogs. Guests whose service dog demonstrates aggressive actions toward our guests or employees will be directed to remove the dog from the park. Limit one service dog per guest. Service Dogs are permitted on the Worlds of Fun Railroad, Le Carrousel bench seat,

Le Taxitour backseat, Grand Carrousel bench seat and Peanuts Playhouse. Service Dogs are not permitted in the water at Oceans of Fun.

9.  If requested at least one week in advance, Worlds of Fun will provide American Sign Language Interpretation at the following locations: PEANUTS™ Showplace, Country Junction, Tivoli Music Hall, Moulin Rouge. To arrange for sign language interpreting services, please call 816.303.5115 or email us at wof@worldsofun.com.
10.  Assistive listening systems utilize a lightweight device that receives a signal from a transmitter at certain locations to amplify sound. These devices are recommended for guests with a mild to moderate hearing loss. Assistive listening devices can be checked out at Worlds of Fun Guest Relations for a refundable deposit of \$20. Locations that offer assistive listening include: Moulin Rouge, Tivoli Music Hall, Country Junction, PEANUTS™ Showplace and Heart of America Theatre.

Definitions

Every ride entrance lists height requirements and special instructions regarding the ride. Worlds of Fun/ Oceans of Fun uses the following terms:

Responsible Person

A responsible person is someone who meets all the requirements to ride the ride themselves, is 16 years of age or older, and demonstrates appropriate observed behavior.

Accompanied By

Whenever a guest needs accompaniment, the accompanying person must meet all the ride requirements, as well as assist the guest. This includes helping the guest in the boarding and exiting of the ride and assisting the guest in case of possible evacuation from the ride.

Hand-Held Infants

A hand-held infant is a child who is unable to walk to the ride unit independently or maintain independent seated postural control. At Worlds of Fun hand-held infants may ride the Le Carrousel in the bench seat only, Grand Carrousel in the bench seat only, the Le Taxitour rear seat only and the Worlds of Fun Railroad. At Oceans of Fun handheld infants may participate in the Captain Kidds, Crocodile Isle, Caribbean Cooler, Coconut Cove and the shallow end of the Surf City Wave Pool. Hand-held infants must always be accompanied by a responsible person.

Functioning Extremity

A functioning extremity is a limb over which a person has control. A prosthetic device is considered a functioning extremity.

Ability to Hold On or Brace

Ability to use one's arms to maintain a grasp on an assist bar and support one's body during normal and emergency procedures on a ride and to use one's legs to brace to maintain a seated position during the forces of the ride.

Full-Arm and Full-Leg Casts

Any cast that prevents the arm from bending at the elbow or the leg from bending at the knee is considered a "full" cast.

Criteria

The following eleven (11) criteria, which may be required to ride a particular ride safely, were considered in the evaluation of each ride.

1. Ability to exhibit independent seated postural control under the dynamic conditions of the ride. Explanation: The guest must have the body and spinal control to sit upright without the aid of other people or devices and be able to maintain the proper riding posture even during bumping or other characteristic movements of the ride. Certain ride units such as carrousel horses require the ability to form a saddle posture with the guest's thighs.

2. Appropriate center of gravity.
Explanation: The guest's body must have the appropriate weight distribution for that ride.
3. Control of upper torso including neck and head.
Explanation: The guest must have sufficient muscle control to support his/her head, neck and upper torso during the course of the ride, including the dynamic motion of the ride.
4. Ability to hold on with one functioning arm.
Explanation: A functioning arm is an upper extremity or prosthesis exhibiting good grip control and the ability to brace, and strong enough to allow the guest to maintain the proper riding position throughout the duration of the ride.
5. Ability to hold on with two functioning arms.
Explanation: Ability to hold on with two functioning arms as described above.
6. Ability to brace self with one functioning leg.
Explanation: Guests must have one functioning leg to be used for bracing the body during the course of the ride. A functioning leg may be a normal leg or a prosthesis which can be used for bracing.
7. Ability to brace self with two functioning legs.
Explanation: Guests must have two functioning legs as described above.
8. Minimum of two functioning extremities.
Explanation: Guests must have a minimum of two functioning extremities (two legs, two arms, or one arm and one leg) to brace themselves during the ride and assist in entering and exiting the ride unit.
9. Minimum of three functioning extremities.
Explanation: Guests must have a minimum of three functioning extremities (two legs and an arm or two arms and a leg to brace themselves, with tripod bracing) during the ride.
10. Ability to enter/exit ride within specified parameters without endangering self or others.
Explanation: Guests must be able to enter and

exit the ride without jeopardizing themselves or others and to assist with their own evacuation if necessary. This may include special arrangements such as entering through the exit or having someone aid them in boarding. If a guest has to be lifted in and out of a ride unit, this must be accomplished by a responsible person who is accustomed to doing this. For the safety of our operators and guests, our ride operators are instructed not to perform this function, except in children's ride areas.

11. Appropriate Observed Behavior: Guest demonstrates appropriate observed behavior indicating a willingness and ability to participate and/or follow rider requirements.
Explanation: Appropriate observed behavior may include but not be limited to maintaining proper riding position, attention and compliance to safety instructions, proper use of all ride or safety equipment and willingness to participate.

In addition to the basic physical and mental requirements defined above, each ride was evaluated relative to specific temporary conditions which may prevent a guest from safely riding a particular ride. Specific conditions evaluated were:

- Cervical collar or neck brace
- Broken collar bone
- Full arm cast
- Braced arm cast
- Full leg cast
- Bilateral abduction leg casts (brace between legs)

The suitability of safely carrying hand-held infants on each ride was also evaluated.

Guests with temporary physical conditions, as listed above, should stop by Guest Relations for a list of available attractions that they can ride.

WORLDS OF FUN RIDE DESCRIPTIONS

The following descriptions are designed to give you information on the type of actions caused by various rides. Guests who are unable to use the regular entrance may use the Alternate Access. Do not enter the ride area while the ride is in motion.

Autobahn 4



Bumper car ride. Avoid head-on collisions at all times. If guest cannot steer and depress accelerator while seated normally, another individual must accompany the guest to drive. The safety mechanism is a shoulder harness designed to secure across the chest and under the arm of each rider. Alternate Access is located at the exit, to the right of the entrance. Ride access requires stepping down onto floor and stepping into car.

Bamboozler 3



Guests stand in a high speed circular ride which raises to a tilted position while rotating and produces strong accelerations and centrifugal force. Alternate Access is located at the exit, to the left of the entrance. Ride access requires climbing stairs and standing.

Boomerang 5



A high speed looping roller coaster that goes forwards and backwards, turning riders upside down six times. The restraint mechanism is a shoulder harness designed to secure across the chest. Guests need to have sufficient lower extremities to ensure they are properly restrained by the restraint mechanism. Alternate Access is via the exit to right. Riders may transfer with the use of a transfer device. Do not use the ride restraints for entering or exiting as they will move.

Camp Bus 3



A children's ride located in Planet Snoopy that lifts off the ground and rotates in a vertical, circular motion in two different directions. Maximum combined weight of 440 lbs per row. Access via the entrance. Ride access requires stepping into a narrow bench seat area.

Charlie Brown's Windup 1



A circular children's swing ride located in Planet Snoopy. Guests need to be able to walk to a ride unit and climb aboard. Access via the entrance. Ride seats hang freely above the ground.

Cosmic Coaster 3



A children's roller coaster located in Planet Snoopy. Guests need to be able to walk to a ride unit and climb aboard. Alternate Access via exit, to right of entrance. Riders may transfer with the use of a transfer device.

Cyclone Sam's 5



A high speed dark circular ride with strobe lighting, wind and sound effects, which raises to a tilted position while rotating and produces strong accelerations with changing force and elevation. Larger riders must be seated in outside seat. Guests need to have sufficient lower extremities to ensure they are properly restrained by the restraint mechanism. The restraint mechanism is a lap bar and an individual seatbelt designed to hold guests in the ride by securing across the lap. Maximum combined weight per seat should not exceed 384 lbs. Alternate Access is located at the exit, located behind the Bull Pen. Ride access requires stepping up into unit.

Detonator 5



The rider sits on a chair lift-type seat and is propelled straight up reaching a speed of 45 mph in one second with significant force. Guests need to have sufficient lower extremities to ensure they are properly restrained by the restraint mechanism. The restraint mechanism is a shoulder harness which is designed to secure across the chest. Guests with any type of prosthesis should not ride unless they can ensure the device is properly secured and will remain in place during the ride. Alternate Access is located at the exit gate, to the right of the entrance. Access via Planet Snoopy entrance. Ride access requires stepping up into unit. Do not use the ride restraints for entering or exiting as they will move.

Finnish Fling 4



A high speed circular ride in which guests stand against the interior wall of a circular drum. As the ride spins rapidly, the floor drops slowly and guests are held in by centrifugal force. Open-heel foot wear or bare feet are not permitted. Ride access requires climbing steep entrance ramp and standing.

Fjord Fjarlane 3



A high speed circular ride with 14 arms that raise and lower while the ride spins and produces strong acceleration and forces. The safety mechanism is a lap bar and individual seatbelt designed to secure across the lap. Alternate Access is located at the exit gate, to the right of the entrance. Ride access requires stepping up into unit. Do not use the ride restraints for entering or exiting as they will move.

Flying Ace Balloon Race 2



A 32 passenger family tower ride that will take riders 28' into the air while rotating at 360 degrees. The restraint mechanism is an individual seatbelt designed to secure across the lap. Maximum of one adult per cab. Maximum combined weight per cab is 550 lbs. Access via the entrance. Ride access requires stepping up into unit.

Flying Dutchman 2



A circular ride with moderate speed in which the guests sit in boat-shaped cars suspended by cables which raise in the air while the ride is spinning. The safety mechanism is a seatbelt secured across the lap. Alternate Access via exit, to left of entrance. Ride access requires transferring into ride unit.

Fury of the Nile 4



A six (6) person river rafting ride. Rafts float down high speed rapids, often rotating rapidly after impacting with the bank of the ride. Strobe lighting effects used on this ride. The safety mechanism is a seatbelt secured across the lap. Alternate Access is located at the exit of the ride via steep entrance/exit ramp. Ride access requires stepping down into boat on a moving turntable.

Grand Carousel 1



An antique carousel built in 1926 with 64 hand-carved horses and 4 chariots that move in a circle. Maximum weight per horse should not exceed 170 lbs. Alternate Access is located at the exit. Ride access requires stepping up to bench seat or stepping up and straddling horse.

Grand Prix Raceway 4



Drive your own go-karts, located in Americana. If a guest cannot steer and depress gas and brake pedals while seated normally, another individual must accompany the guest to drive. The safety mechanism is a seatbelt designed to secure across the chest and the lap of each rider. This attraction has an additional fee. Alternate Access via exit, to the left of the entrance. Access requires stepping into car.

Kite Eating Tree 2



A children's ride located in Planet Snoopy that takes guests up to a height of 20 feet and then slowly bounces them back down. Guests need to be able to walk to the ride unit and climb aboard. Maximum of one adult per ride. Access via entrance. Ride access requires stepping up into unit.

Krazy Kars 2



A children's bumper car ride located in Americana. Guests need to be able to walk to a ride unit and climb aboard. Access via Entrance. Ride access requires stepping down onto floor and stepping into car.

Le Carrousel 1



A traditional carousel with bench seating and old fashioned style horses. Maximum weight per horse should not exceed 170 lbs. Maximum combined weight per chariot should not exceed 680 lbs. Alternate Access for wheelchairs via ramp, to left of exit.

LeTaxitour 3



Guest operated replicas of antique Taxis. If guest cannot steer and depress gas pedal while seated normally, another individual must accompany the guest to drive. Alternate Access via exit, up steep ramps to the right of the entrance. Access requires stepping up into car.

Linus' Beetle Bugs 2



A children's circular ride located in Planet Snoopy. Guests need to be able to walk to the ride unit and climb aboard. Access via the entrance. Ride access requires stepping up into unit.

Lucy's Tugboat 2



A 24-passenger tugboat that rotates as it glides back and forth on a u-shaped track. The safety mechanism is a lap bar that secures across the lap. Guests need to be able to walk to the ride unit and climb aboard. Maximum of eight adults per ride. Maximum combined weight should not exceed 440 lbs. per row. Access via the entrance. Ride access requires stepping up into unit.

Mamba 5



A 205 foot tall high speed steel roller coaster. Strobe lighting is used for picture taking. Alternate Access is located at the exit, to left of entrance. Riders may transfer with the use of a transfer device. Do not use the ride restraints for entering or exiting as they will move.

Monsoon **4**



A water flume ride with a large 20 passenger boat. The boat travels up a lift and splashes down to produce a wall of water. Attraction available to guests of both parks. Alternate Access via steep exit ramp. Riders may transfer with the use of a transfer device.

Octopus **3**



A circular ride in which the arms move clockwise while the cars move up and down in a counter clockwise direction. Maximum combined weight per seat should not exceed 400 lbs. Alternate Access is located to the left of the entrance. Ride access requires stepping up into unit.

Patriot **5**



An inverted (ski-lift, hanging style), looping roller coaster that will turn riders upside down four times by way of loops, twists and turns. The restraint mechanism is a shoulder harness that comes down over the head and secures across the chest just above the thighs. Larger guests should try out the test seat at the entrance to ensure that all restraints fasten before waiting in line. Guests with any type of prosthesis should not ride unless they can ensure the device is properly secured and will remain in place during the ride. Strobe lighting is used for picture taking. Alternate Access via elevator next to ride entrance. Ride access requires stepping up into unit. Do not use the ride restraints for entering or exiting as they will move.

PEANUTS™ 500 **2**



A set of NASCAR style race cars that whip around an oblong track. Restraint mechanism is a seatbelt that must be secured across the lap. Maximum of one adult per car. Maximum combined weight per car is 275 lbs. Access via the entrance. Ride access requires stepping into unit.

PEANUTS™ Playhouse **1**



An interactive foam ball play arena designed for children, located in Planet Snoopy. Children must have the appropriate observed behavior in order to participate. No hand-held infants permitted. Access via the entrance. Upper level requires climbing stairs.

PEANUTS™ Road Rally **1**



Miniature 4X4 trucks that follow an electric track. Restraint mechanism is a seatbelt that must be secured across the lap. Maximum of one adult per car. Maximum combined weight per truck is 440 lbs. Alternate Access via the exit. Ride access requires stepping and pulling up into ride unit.

PEANUTS™ Turntyke **1**



A children's circular car and motorcycle ride located in Planet Snoopy. Guests need to be able to walk to the ride unit and climb aboard. Access via the entrance. Ride access requires stepping into ride unit or straddling motorcycles.

Prowler 4



A wooden roller coaster with steep banked curves and fast transitions. This ride may not accommodate guests of a larger size. All arm and leg casts are prohibited. The restraint mechanism is a lap bar and seatbelt designed to secure across the thighs. Strobe lighting is used for picture taking. Alternate Access via elevator next to ride exit stairs. Riders may transfer with the use of a transfer device.

RipCord A Skycoaster® Experience 5



RipCord is a Skycoaster® attraction that features the effect of skydiving and hang gliding combined. Guests need to be able to hold their head upright and must possess two arms sufficient to be contained and restrained by the shoulder pads. Guests' lower extremities must be of sufficient length to allow proper fitting of flight suit leg straps and support against the foot bar. This attraction has an additional fee. Maximum combined weight per flight should not exceed 850 lbs. Access via the entrance. Flyers will need to stand prior to cable attachment.

Sally's Swing Set 2



A bench seat that faces forwards and backwards which swings back and forth. Guests need to be able to walk to the ride unit and climb aboard. Maximum of two adults per side. Access via the entrance. Ride access requires stepping up into unit.

Scrambler 3



Rotating cars mounted on counter rotating arms which produce strong accelerations, changing force and direction rapidly. Small children must be seated to the inside of the ride. The restraint mechanism is a lap gate and seatbelt design to close and secure across the lap. Maximum combined weight per seat should not exceed 510 lbs. Access via the entrance. Entrance and Exit have steep ramps. Ride access requires stepping up into ride unit. Ride unit may shift during loading/unloading.

Sea Dragon 3



A swinging boat ride. Produces a feeling of weightlessness. Safety mechanism is a lap bar designed to secure and lock across the thighs. Maximum combined weight per row should not exceed 680 lbs. Alternate Access via exit gate, to the right of the entrance. Ride access requires stepping into a narrow bench seat area. Do not use the ride restraints for entering or exiting as they will move.

Skyliner 2



Guests ride in one of 16 Ferris wheel carriages suspended from the outer rim of the wheel. The safety mechanism is a lap bar and seatbelt design to secure across the thighs. Maximum combined weight per seat should not exceed 450 lbs. Alternate Access is located at the exit. Entrance and Exit have steep ramps. Ride access requires climbing steps. Ride units swing freely.

Snoopy vs. Red Baron ²



A children's airplane ride located in Planet Snoopy. Guests need to be able to walk to a ride unit and climb aboard. Ride access via the entrance. Ride access requires stepping up into ride unit.

Snoopy's Moon Bounce ²



A children's inflatable bounce area, similar to a moonwalk, located in Planet Snoopy. Guests need to be able to walk to the ride and climb into the bounce area. Children must be able to independently maneuver through the play area. Access via the entrance. Entrance and Exit have steep ramps.

Snoopy's Rocket Express ²



A rocket car ride that follows an electric track 18' above the ground around Planet Snoopy. Restraint mechanism is a seatbelt that must be secured across the lap. Maximum of two adults per car. Maximum combined weight should not exceed 550 lbs. per car. Alternate Access is via an elevator to the left of the entrance. Ride access requires transferring into ride unit.

Snoopy's Yacht Club ¹



A children's circular boat ride located in Planet Snoopy. Guests need to be able to walk to the ride unit and climb aboard. Ride access via the entrance. Ride access requires stepping down into ride unit.

Spinning Dragons ⁵



Individual four (4) seat roller coaster cars that traverse a steel track while rotating freely 360°. The restraint mechanism is a lap bar and seatbelt designed to secure across the thighs. Maximum combined weight of 660 lbs. per car. Alternate Access is located at the exit, to the right of the entrance. Ride access requires transferring into ride unit. Do not use the ride restraints for entering or exit as they will move.

The Rock ⁴



Rock climbing wall where guests need to be able to use arms and/or legs to pull and climb along various protrusions on the vertical surface. Guests need to have sufficient lower extremities to fit securely in the leg harness. Maximum weight of 310 lbs. per climber. This attraction has an additional fee. Access via steep entrance ramp.

ThunderHawk ⁵



After being lifted to a height of nearly 60 feet, ThunderHawk's gondola will invert, while rotating in a circular motion both forwards and backwards. The automatic dual restraint mechanism is both an individual shoulder harness and an individual lap bar. Riders must be at least 10 years old. Alternate Access is located at the exit, to the right of the entrance. Ride access requires climbing steps.

Timber Wolf 5



A high speed wooden roller coaster. All arm and leg casts are prohibited. This ride may not accommodate guests of a larger size. The restraint mechanism is a lap bar and seatbelt designed to secure across the thighs. Alternate Access via elevator next to the exit stairs. Riders may transfer with the use of transfer device.

Viking Voyager 4



A water flume ride. Strobe lighting is used for picture taking. Boats will bump and move during loading and unloading. Alternate Access via elevator to the right of entrance. Ride access requires stepping down into the boat.

Woodstock Whirlybirds 2



A junior tea cup spinning ride. Restraint mechanism is a seatbelt that must be secured across the lap. Maximum of two adults per car. Maximum combined weight should not exceed 550 lbs. per car. Guests need to be able to walk to the ride unit and climb aboard. Access via the entrance. Ride access requires stepping up on platform and stepping into ride unit.

Worlds of Fun Railroad 2



A steam engine that travels throughout the park. Guests requiring assistance from a responsible person must sit in the middle of the bench seat, not on the outside edge. Alternate Access is located at the exit, on either side of the entrance. Guests not utilizing wheelchairs will need to step up into a narrow bench seat area.

Zulu 4



A high speed circular ride which raises to a 90° angle and turns guests upside-down before returning to ground level. To enter ride, guests must maneuver into free swinging cars suspended 1-2 feet above the ride floor. Alternate Access via steep exit ramp to left of entrance. Ride access requires stepping into the free swinging unit.

HALLOWEEN HAUNT

Sept. 15 – Oct. 28

Worlds of Fun Halloween Haunt has Extreme Haunts that are designed to scare and startle. These attractions and the park in general will have areas of low lighting, loud sound and dense fog. Please adhere to all posted and verbal warnings and directions. Some attractions may require Guests to transfer from their motorized wheelchairs to a non-motorized wheelchair located at the attraction. Strobe lighting may also be in effect at some attractions. Guests with respiratory sensitivities, history of seizures or epilepsy, or sensitivities to loud music and sound effects are advised not to participate in these attractions. Characters inside our Haunt attractions will not touch you; please do not touch them in any manner. Those that do so will be removed from the park without refund. Rowdy behavior and profanity are also cause for removal from the park. For safety reasons, Guests may not wear their own face paint, costumes or masks.

Castaway Cove 1



A 21 years and over adult pool and bar. Water depth 5 feet. Access to the pool via stairs or chair lift.

Coconut Cove 2



A 4 1/2-foot deep pool with different play elements. Contains 6 short body slides and floating animals. Guests may need to be able to hold onto ropes and walk over floating elements. Access via zero depth along pool edge.

Crocodile Isle 1



A water playground for children with slides and floating animals. Maximum water depth is 2 ft. Access via zero depth along pool edge.

Diamond Head 5



A complex of 3 separate body slides ending in a 4-foot deep splash pool. Required riding position is lying flat on back with arms locked behind head and legs crossed at the ankles, keeping your body straight throughout the ride. Maximum weight of 225 lbs. per person. Access to the tower requires climbing stairs.

Hurricane Falls 5



A family tube ride which rises 72 feet above the ground, winding and twisting to the splash pool. Each tube holds a maximum of 4 riders. Guests need to hold themselves in an upright position and hold onto one handle. Splash pool is 2 1/2 feet deep. Maximum combined weight per tube should not exceed 800 lbs. Access to the tower requires climbing stairs.

Paradise Falls 2



Interactive play structure with various play elements including a giant tipping bucket, tipping pails, net crawls, rope bridges, and seven body slides. Pool depth is between 0"-6" deep. Some slides have varied height requirements anywhere between 36" to 48" depending on slide. Required riding position on slides is lying flat on back with arms locked behind head and legs crossed at the ankles, keeping body straight throughout the ride. Maximum weight of 300 lbs. per person. Access to upper levels requires climbing stairs.

Surf City Wave Pool 4



A large wave pool with depths ranging from zero to 8 feet. Waves run on a "10 minutes on, 10 minutes off" cycle. Only strong swimmers are recommended in deep water. Please note depth markers. A life jacket is required for anyone who is less than 48" tall in bare feet or is an inexperienced or nonswimmer. Guests under 42" are required to wear life jackets and be accompanied by a responsible person. Only Coast Guard approved life jackets are allowed as flotation devices. Life jackets are provided free of charge for guests who require one. Access to pool via zero depth entry.

Typhoon 4



Two high speed straightaway hump-backed slides ending in a 3 foot deep pool. Required riding position is lying flat on back with arms crossed over chest and legs crossed at the ankles, keeping your body straight throughout the ride. Maximum weight of 300 lbs. per person. Access to tower requires climbing stairs.

Height Requirements

At Worlds of Fun and Oceans of Fun, height requirements have been developed for safety and to maintain the ride manufacturer's recommendation. Some children under the height requirement may be able to ride certain rides with a responsible person. Shoes are required on attractions at Worlds of Fun, shoes are not allowed on slides at Oceans of Fun. Height requirements are enforced respectfully.
