SIX NATIONS CHAMPIONSHIP MATCH PREVIEW

HEADLINES

- England have a total of eight uncapped players in their matchday 22 - the most for a Championship game since the 1972 game against Wales, which featured nine uncapped players.
- England's XV (233 caps) is their most inexperienced Championship selection since they played Ireland in 1990 (224 caps).
- ROSS FORD becomes Scotland's 111th captain and their 11th in Six Nations history.
- CHARLIE HODGSON wins his 37th cap and makes his first Six Nations start for England since appearing in a 31-6 defeat to France in 2006.
- KELLY BROWN makes his 50th appearance for Scotland, having never tasted defeat against England at Murrayfield (15-9 win 2008, 15-15 draw 2010).

SIX NATIONS HISTORY

- A win against England this weekend will give Scotland their first back to back wins in the Six Nations since 2001. Scotland beat Italy 21-8 in their last championship game in March.
- Scotland last beat England at Murrayfield in 2008 (15-9) while they drew 15-15 with their southern neighbours at the same venue in 2010.
- The only team to ever beat England in round one of the Six Nations is Wales - achieved in 2005 and 2008.
- Scotland have only ever been victorious in one opening game of the Six Nations - against France in 2006.
- David Duckham and John Spencer were the last centre partnership to make their debuts together for England, appearing in a 19-17 defeat to Ireland at Lansdowne Road in 1969.

HEAD TO HEAD

- There have been 129 matches between Scotland and England, the former winning 42 of those and England 69. There have been 18 draws, the most recent one being the 15-15 draw between the sides at Murrayfield in 2010.
- Chris Patterson holds the record for most appearances (12) and most points (84) against England while Jason Leonard holds the appearance record (14) for England. Jonny Wilkinson has scored more points (114) against Scotland than any other England player.
- Wilkinson also holds the record for most points scored by an England player against Scotland in a single game - 27 in their 42-20 victory at Twickenham in 2007.
- Scotland have beaten England three times in their last 12 Six Nations meetings between the sides.
- They've conceded an average of 27 points against England during the history of the Six Nations, scoring 14.

Facts & Figures

DEBUTANTS

- Edinburgh wing LEE JONES wins his first cap for Scotland while DAVID DENTON makes his championship debut. GREIG LAIDLAW will also make his Six Nations debut, should he appear off the bench.
- OWEN FARRELL, BRAD BARRITT and PHIL DOWSON all win their first caps for England while ROB WEBBER, GEOFF PARLING, BEN MORGAN, LEE DICKSON and JORDAN TURNER-HALL could all make their Test debuts if they come off the bench.

STARTING LINEUPS

- Scotland make eight changes to the team which went down to England 12-16 in the Rugby World Cup last October.
- There are a total of 499 caps in Scotland's starting XV, with another 214 caps on the bench, England have a total of 233 caps in their starting XV.
- The England team features 10 changes from the side that beat Scotland in the Rugby World Cup last October and nine from the RWC quarter-final defeat to France.
- OWEN FARRELL will be the youngest player on the pitch at Murrayfield, at 20 years and four months.
- Seven of England's starting XV have less than 10 caps.
- CHRIS ASHTON has scored six tries in six championship appearances for England but has yet to score against Scotland, Ireland and France.
- Saturday's match marks the 22nd time the front row combination of AILAN JACOBSEN, ROSS FORD and EUAN MURRAY have started for Scotland, thereby extending their record over Kenny Milne, Paul Burnell and David Sole.
- CHARLIE HODGSON is England's most experienced player with 36 Test caps.
- ROSS FORD has started 34 of Scotland's last 35 games.
- DAVID DENTON starts his first international Test for Scotland, having made his debut off the bench in the 10-6 win over Ireland in August.
- DAN PARKS has dropped a goal in each of his last three Scotland matches.
- CHRIS CUSITER will partner DAN PARKS for the 21st time against England, having won 5, drawn 1 and lost 14 as a combo for Scotland.
- Swindon-born JIM HAMILTON won the first of his 34 caps in the 42-20 defeat to England at Twickenham in 2007.
- Six of Scotland's 22 were born outside the country. JIM HAMILTON and MAX EVANS were born in England, DAVID DENTON in Zimbabwe and DAN PARKS in Australia, while replacements JOHN BARCLAY and GRAEME MORRISON were born in Hong Kong.
- CHARLIE HODGSON can overtake DAN PARKS on the all-time points scoring list this weekend if he outscores his opponent by two points. HODGSON has 259 points while PARKS has 260.

THE AGE FACTOR

- The average age of the Scotland starting XV is almost 28 1/2 while the replacements have an average age of nearly 29.
- The England starting XV have an average age of 26.
- England's forwards only have 133 caps between them despite having three of their pack over the age of 30.

SIZE MATTERS

- RICHIE GRAY (2.08m - 130kg) and JIM HAMILTON (2.03m - 124kg) are the heaviest and tallest second row combination in the Six Nations. Substitute MATT STEVENS is the heaviest England player at 122kg, with TOM PALMER the tallest at 2.00m.

DID YOU KNOW?

- England's five game winning run was brought to an end with defeat to France in the Rugby World Cup quarter final between the two sides.
- England have scored 20 tries in their last five matches, conceding just three while Scotland scored six and conceded six.
- There are five Saracens players named in the England XV - BRAD BARRITT, OWEN FARRELL, MOURITZ BOTHA, CHARLIE HODGSON AND DAVID STRETTLE.
- Defending Six Nations Champions England lost just one game last season - their final game against Ireland.

HEAD COACHES

- England coach Stuart Lancaster takes charge of his first Six Nations game. Lancaster was Director of Rugby at Leeds before becoming head of Elite Player Development at the RFU.
- Since taking the reigns in November 2009, Andy Robinson has a 50% winning record with Scotland. He was head coach of England from October 2004 to November 2006.

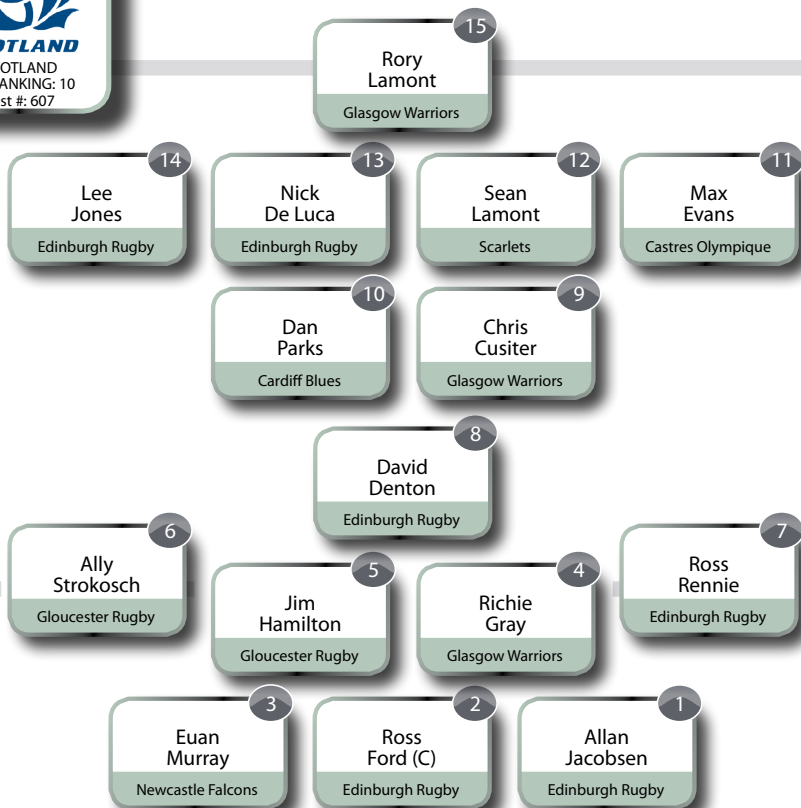
MAN IN THE MIDDLE

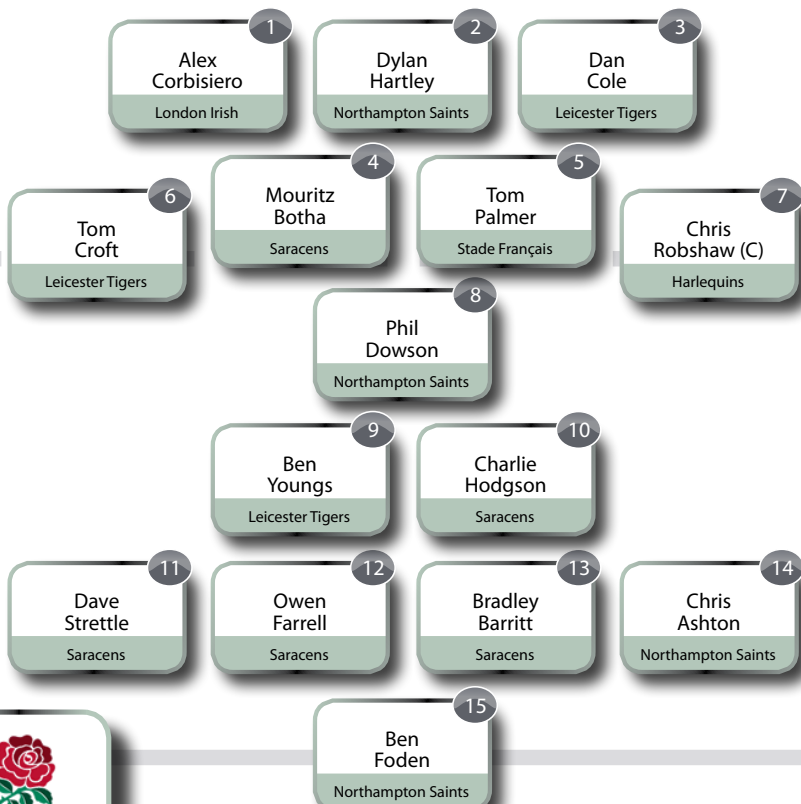
