## Obama prevailing over Republicans in Florida

Raleigh, N.C. - Unsurprisingly, the picture has little changed since December, when PPP last took a look at the early 2012 presidential race in the crucial swing state of Florida. President Obama beat John McCain there by three points in 2008, and he now has similar leads over two possible GOP nominees, and tops the others by almost identical margins as three months ago.

Mitt Romney is the only likely entrant into the Republican fracas to equal or exceed McCain's performance. He trails 46-44, exactly the same as December's result. The state's former Governor Jeb Bush also does well, lagging 48-45, but he has so far denied any interest in seeking his father's and brother's old office. Rudy Giuliani, who staked his entire candidacy on the state's primary three years ago, performs next best, down 4842. Giuliani has flirted with another bid, but neither he nor Bush were tested in December. Mike Huckabee, who now makes his home in the Sunshine State, is behind Obama 50-43, just a hair worse than December's 49-44 deficit. Neighboring Georgia’s Newt Gingrich pulls the same $42 \%$ as in the previous poll, but Obama has inched up from $47 \%$ to $50 \%$ against him. And, as ever, Sarah Palin brings up the rear, trailing 52-39; she earned 38\% in December.

President Obama's overall approval rating is back above water, with $48 \%$ approving and $47 \%$ disapproving, versus December's 45-49 spread. He has improved dramatically with Democrats, jumping from a relateively weak 69\% approval from his own party to $81 \%$ now, a trend seen in other states as time has passed since the lame duck session of Congress. He is also now earning $80-86 \%$ of their votes against each of the Republicans, versus only $73-77 \%$ in December. But he has declined with independents, who approved by a huge 59-35 margin then and only barely 41-39 now. And while he won their vote by margins of 24 to 41 points previously, he now does by only two to 18 points. So declines with independents have balanced out his gains with Democrats. Luckily for him, Democrats are almost twice as numerous.
"It looks like Florida will as ever continue to be one of the closest states in the country next year," said Dean Debnam, President of Public Policy Polling. "The only way it becomes lopsided is if the GOP nominates a really weak candidate."

PPP surveyed 500 Florida voters from March $24^{\text {th }}$ to $27^{\text {th }}$. The survey's margin of error is $+/-4.4 \%$. Other factors, such as refusal to be interviewed and weighting, may introduce additional error that is more difficult to quantify.
