

Deckham Ward Factsheet

Deckham ward is located in Central Gateshead along with three other wards – Bridges, Lobley Hill and Bensham, and Saltwell.

The ward sits just to the south and east of Gateshead Town Centre. It has a number of shops and services along Old Durham Road and benefits from regular bus services heading to and from the Town Centre.

The ward mainly consists of housing, with large numbers of Gateshead Housing Company and Housing Association estates. This ward has the largest Registered Social Landlord sector in Gateshead.



Neighbourhoods With The Most Acute Needs:

The Index of Multiple Deprivation 2010 indicates that in terms of overall deprivation, Deckham East, Sheriff Hill and Highfield Estate are within the 10% most deprived areas in England, and Shipcote area falls within the 20% most deprived.

Deckham East, Sheriff Hill and Highfield Estate all fall within the 10% most deprived in terms of income, employment, health, and education, skill and training. Shipcote and Carr Hill also fall within the 10% most deprived in terms of health, with Shipcote also in the 10% most deprived in terms of living environment.

Shipcote and Carr Hill are within the 20% most deprived for income and employment, and Shipcote is also in the 20% most deprived for education, skills and training.

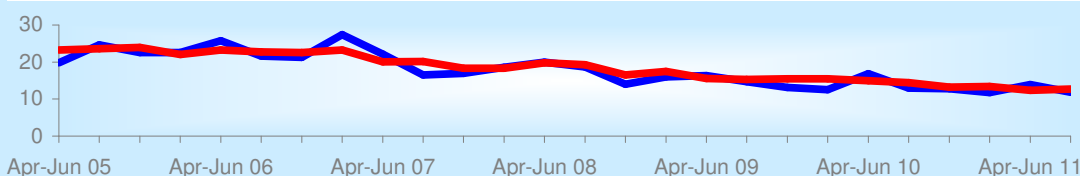

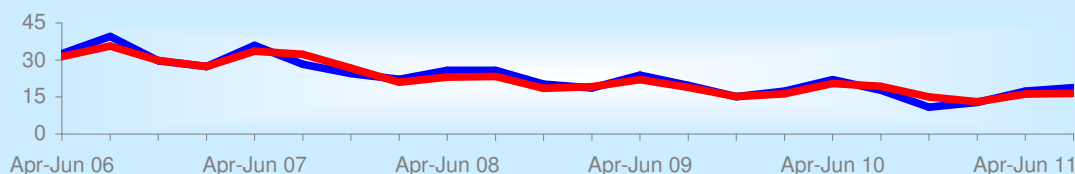

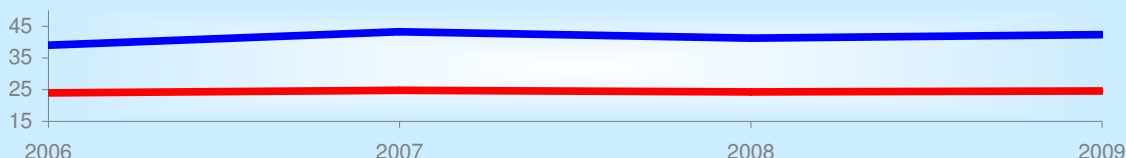

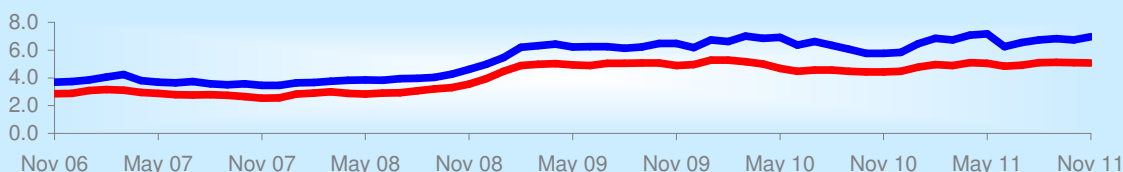

Youth Unemployment (JSA Claimant) Rate, DWP (Current data: Nov 2011)

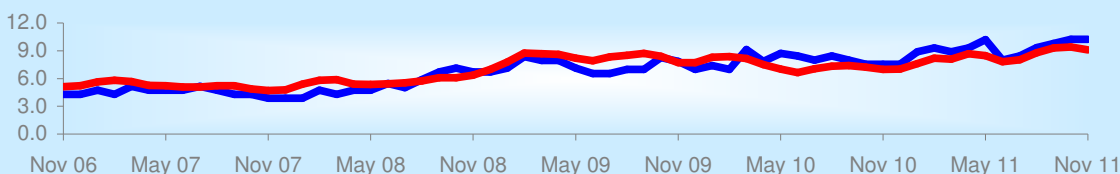

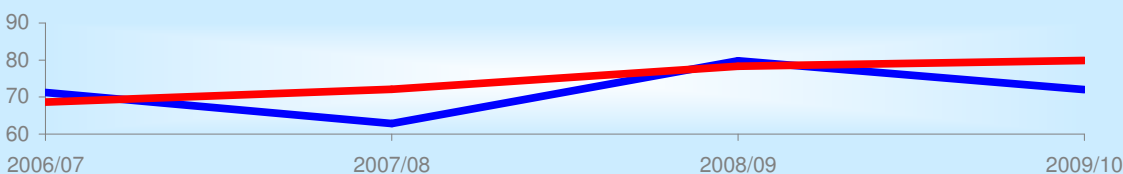

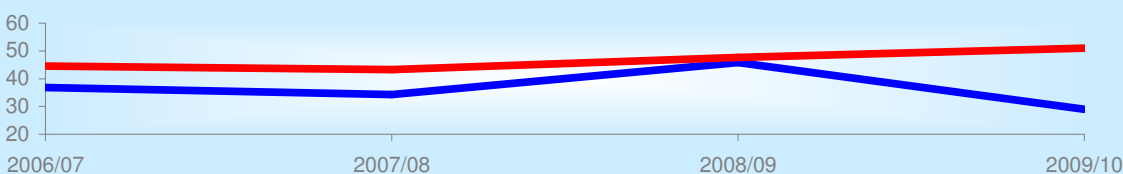

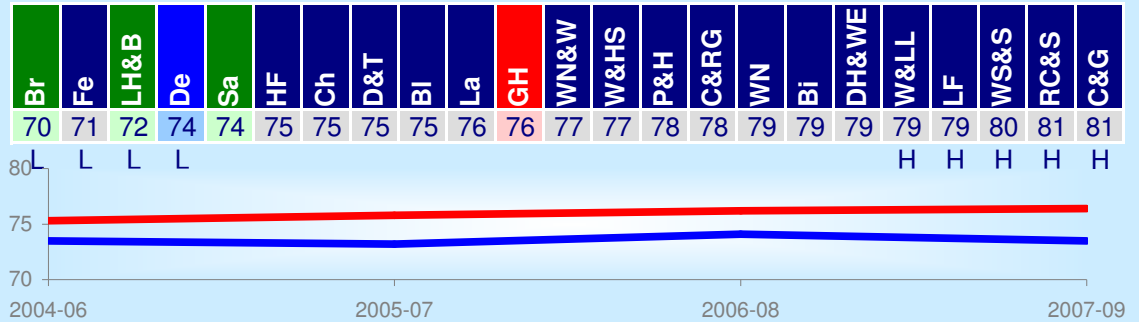

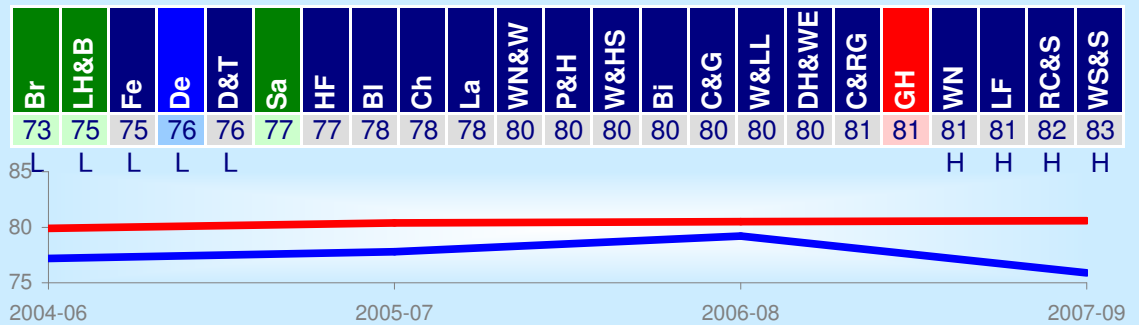

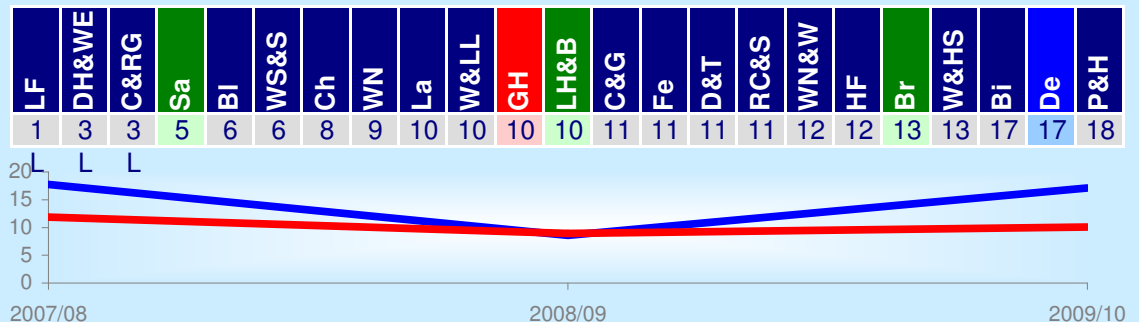

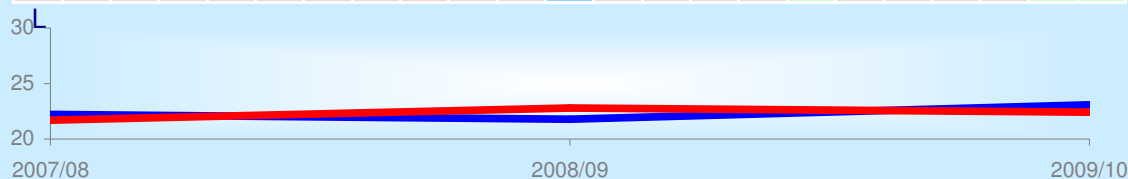
