

Number of children aged 0-4 (Gateshead quintiles)






% of children aged 0-4 in households dependent on workless benefits (Gateshead quintiles)

Children Aged 0-15 in Households Dependent on Workless Benefits





Educational Attainment

School Achievement and Attainment tables are published annually by the Department for Children, Schools & Families (DCSF). This profile presents this information in a different way, looking at attainment across the Key Stages of the National Curriculum in relation to where pupils live. Where necessary, geographic units containing data on less than 5 individuals have been excluded to prevent disclosure.




KS3 average point scores (Gateshead quintiles)

Proportion of pupils achieving 5+ GCSE's A*-C (Gateshead quintiles)






