






Vitality Index Unemployment Domain (Gateshead quintiles)

JSA claimants – LLSOA's (Gateshead quintiles)



Jobseekers Allowance Claimants who have been out of work for at least 1 year



Incapacity Benefit and Severe Disablement Allowance




Incapacity Benefit and SDA claimants – LLSOA's (Gateshead quintiles)











Proportion of long term vacant properties (Gateshead quintiles)




Proportion of multiple Council Tax Liability properties (Gateshead quintiles)



% of 16-74 year olds in employment who travel to work using public transport (Gateshead quintiles)





IMD 2007 deprivation levels – Geographical Barriers (Percentages relate to all LLSOA's in England)



Planning applications for residential development on land allocated for housing would normally be permitted however this would be dependent on the proposal complying with other relevant planning policies contained within the plan and other material planning considerations such as density and design. All allocated sites have been approved by the Council through the adoption of the UDP 2007.
