Trolley Station Construction & Detours



32nd & Commercial Station

September – Mid-November 2012

Renovation work is underway at the **32nd & Commercial Trolley Station**. The station will remain open during construction, however there are currently detours in place to access the station. Please use extra caution during construction and follow the direction of the on-site flagging staff when crossing the tracks.

Station/Rider/Business Information

- The construction work began in late July and will continue through mid-November.
- Construction work for this project will include: new station boarding platforms, next-arrival electronic signs, shelters, track, overhead electric wiring, and more.
- The work will make trolley boarding safer and raise the platform to accommodate the new low-floor trolleys.
- Local businesses and pedestrian walkways outside of the station will remain accessible.
- Most work will occur between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday through Saturday.
- Limited night work may occur.
- The schedule may change with very little notice.
- Noise and dust is anticipated during construction.



Please use **extra caution** during construction and follow the direction of the on-site flagging staff when crossing the tracks.

The Trolley Renewal Project

The Trolley Renewal Project is a joint project with the San Diego Association of Governments and the San Diego Metropolitan Transit System. This work is part of a \$720 million project to renew the entire MTS Trolley network. Once complete, new low-floor Trolleys will operate throughout the system. Beginning in September, the Green Line will be extended through Old Town to downtown and terminate at 12th & Imperial via bayside stations (Seaport Village, Convention Center and Gaslamp Quarter). Also beginning in September, the Orange Line will travel from El Cajon to Santa Fe Depot and the Blue Line will travel from San Ysidro to America Plaza. All stations will be equipped with next-arrival signs, new shelters and seating. The end result will be easier access, quicker trips, a more comfortable ride, and an enhanced transit experience.
