Winners of the World Human Rights Moot Court Competition 2010

The second World Human Rights Moot Court was held on 8 and 9 December 2010. The competition was presented by the University of Pretoria's Faculty of Law, with the support of the Regional Office for Southern Africa of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights (ROSA). All law faculties have been invited to submit heads of argument on the basis of a hypothetical case. Based on the assessment of the heads of argument by a panel of experts, three teams from each of the five UN regions were invited to participate in person in the semi-finals and final round in Pretoria on 9 and 10 December.
