On Friday 30 March the Norfolk Island Government and community will bid a fond farewell to Owen and Bianca Walsh as they depart the island officially, at the conclusion of his term as Administrator of Norfolk Island.

"On behalf of all residents of Norfolk Island I extend our heartfelt thanks and admiration for the way in which Mr and Mrs Walsh have performed their official responsibilities firstly as Official Secretary and subsequently since 2nd October 2008 as Administrator," the Chief Minister said.

"In Mr Walsh's appointment as Administrator residents of the Island have had the benefit of a young and vibrant man in mid career who was determined to make a difference by bringing his enthusiasm and vitality to bear in everything he has achieved during his term of office," the Chief Minister said.

Mr Walsh is a barrister and solicitor in the Supreme Court of the Australian Capital Territory and will resume his legal career.
